**ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY  
LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA**

Through Liaison channels, the Department of State furnished the FBI a copy of a memorandum dated June 19, 1968, captioned "Alleged Accusations Made Against Kennedy Family," which dealt with information furnished by a Mrs. Naomi Gross, 13 Russel Street, Toorak, Australia, concerning one Clifford Flitty, allegedly an American industrialist with the Amaerada Petroleum Company, Queensland, Australia. A copy of this memorandum is attached.

Investigation in the United States has failed to locate Flitty, who may be identical with an individual named Clifford Flittie, who was a passenger on board Qantas Airline, Flight 530, from Sidney, Australia, to New York City, on June 5, 1968.

Accordingly, it is requested that inquiry be made in Australia through State Department channels in an effort to identify this individual. If he is located in Australia, it is requested he be interviewed in order to determine if there was any significance to statements attributed to him by Mrs. Gross.

**Alleged Accusations made against Kennedy Family.**

On June 12, 1968, Mrs. Naomi Gross, 13 Russel St., Teorak, Australia, (presently vacationing in London, England) appeared voluntarily at the American Embassy London, and furnished the following information:

Mrs. Gross stated she boarded Qantas Flight 530 in Sydney, Australia at 7:00 PM, June 5, 1968, in route to London. Further, she said she was traveling first class and had sat next to a man who said his name was Clifford Flitty, an American industrialist with Amerada Petroleum Co. in Queensland, Australia, (the company is supposedly an American Canadian venture) who worked out of the company's head office in Brisbane. Mrs. Gross said Flitty also stated he was soon to become the new Vice-President of Union Carbide. Source described Flitty as a man of about 40 to 47 (he told her he was born in 1924), 5 feet 10 inches tall weight about 170 pounds, Gray hair, medium build, and wore glasses. Source reported the flight en route to London stopped at Fiji Island, Honolulu, San Francisco, New York, then London. She said before the plane landed at Fiji Island, Flitty stated "I wish someone would put a bullet between Bobby Kennedy's eyes, and I would wish I could pull the trigger myself." Further, source stated that prior to their landing at Honolulu, the announcement of the Kennedy shooting was announced to the passengers by the captain.

Source advised that when the plane landed in San Francisco, there was to be a four hour layover, and it was at this time the death of Robert Kennedy was announced. Further, she said Flitty stated he was going to send a telegram to Ted Kennedy which was to read "After two how about you?" and said he may even sign it, and further stated "we will be rid of this trash forever." According to source Flitty talked about ordering champagne to celebrate the tragedy. (attached as exhibit # 1 is the alleged note to be sent to Ted Kennedy in Flitty's own handwriting).

Mrs. Gross reported Flitty disembarked at New York. She said he was traveling alone, and appeared to be in complete control of his faculties during the flight.

Mrs. Gross declined to give her London address, stating she did not wish to involve the people with whom she was staying.

It is the opinion of the reporting agent, that Mrs. Gross is a completely stable individual, was articulate in her speech, and gave every impression of being a highly intelligent woman.

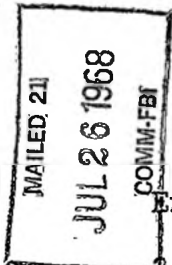

3. We are making no further inquiry into the matter at this time.



**SYNOPSIS**

Investigation requested by Commander, Athenai Airport Greece, 7 June 1968 to determine circumstances surrounding receipt prior to 5 June 1968 of telephone calls relating to the assassination of KENNEDY. Armed Forces Radio Station (AFRS) announcer reported receiving two inquiries prior to 5 June 1968 asking if information regarding the assassination would be broadcast. Telephone switchboard operator reported receiving telephone call prior to 5 June 1968 from Greek national asking about the assassination of KENNEDY. Greek national's call switched to Security Police office and same information was requested by the person calling. As the assassination had not occurred at the time of the calls, all of the above advised the caller that they had no information related to his inquiries. Caller could not be identified by name.

1. This investigation was requested by the Commander, Athenai Airport Greece, 7 June 1968 to determine the circumstances surrounding the receipt of telephone call(s) by Athenai Airport personnel prior to 5 June 1968 concerning the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

2. On 7 June 1968, JAMES CRAIG BARNES, A1C, AF [REDACTED] 2140th Communications Squadron, radio announcer with AFRS at Athenai Airport advised that he had received two telephone calls prior to 5 June 1968 which were related to the assassination of KENNEDY. BARNES reported the information to CONSTANTINOS KOLLINZAS Captain, Air Force Liaison Office, Athens, Greece who in turn notified the OSI. *AKA CRAIG BARNES*  
*U.S. GREECE*

3. On 8 June 1968, BARNES was interviewed by SA SHERMAN A. ROE and the writer. BARNES furnished a signed sworn statement regarding his receipt of the telephone calls. The text of BARNES statement is set forth verbatim as follows:

I am a radio announcer assigned to AFRS at Athenai Airport, Greece. I was on duty the evenings of 30 and 31 May and 2 June 1968 at the radio station between the hours of 1745 and 0100. As best I can recall, between the hours of 1830 and 2300, I received two telephone calls. Both calls had to be plugged into extension 5625 by the base operator. The first of these calls was not received directly by me but was taken by the operator who asked me the information. I did not talk to the party making the first call. The operator was the military operator who inquired as to an assassination attempt on Senator Kennedy somewhere on the West Coast of the United States. I answered the operator that nothing to that effect had been broadcast by AFRS and that if they would wait one moment I would check my UPR and APR lines. I did such and found no information concerning any attempt of that sort on Kennedy. The operator thanked me and terminated the call. I received a second call later that evening that was put directly into my extension, 5625. The party calling made a similar inquiry and asked about an assassination attempt on Senator Kennedy. If memory serves me correctly, this party asked about a specific city which may have been Los Angeles or San Francisco. It would be my guess that the party calling did not speak English as a native tongue. Although it was a short conversation I think I can say the party spoke English in an educated manner. This person, a male, did not seem to be a Greek. Again I asked the party to wait while I checked my news sources and again there was no information concerning an assassination attempt on Senator Robert Kennedy. I returned to the telephone and informed the caller that no information of that sort had been received by the station and that something like that would be broadcast as soon as it was received. I did not know the exact time of either telephone call and can only say that both were received during the period 1830 to 2300 on one of the three mentioned nights. I am uncertain of which military operator was on duty at the base telephone switchboard on the evening in question.

I did not report these calls to anyone here at the radio station since there did not seem to be a reason at that time to report them. I did note them, however, as a matter of personal curiosity. The only person I have mentioned these calls to apart from the OSI investigators is Julie Swaner, an American citizen who has been



studying here in Greece and is now getting ready to return to the States. I mentioned these calls to her either the night I received the calls or the following day. She didn't think anything of these calls when I mentioned them to her. On 6 June 1968, after the shooting of Senator Kennedy, I sought out advice from a Captain at the JUSMAGG building as to whom I should report these incidents. He informed me that he was in the intelligence business and advised me immediately that anyone I should talk to further about this matter I should ask for identification. He identified himself through the usual military identification card and told me that I would be contacted probably that evening at work.

In reading the above paragraph I believe I should indicate that Julie Swaner did not think anything about the calls I mentioned to her at the time I mentioned them to her. However, since then, she has become aware of the fact I was concerned about the calls due to the actual assassination and due to the fact that upon being advised by an OSI investigator I have inquired of her when I actually mentioned the calls to her. She is aware that this subject has been reported. I have personally cautioned her against any mention of the calls and not to worry about the incidents.

I further certify that I requested Mr. Sherman A. Roe, Jr. to type this statement for me.

The original statement is being retained in the files of this district and will be released to proper authority upon request.

4. On 10 June 1968, SA ROE requested JULES E. COCHOIT, Captain FV [REDACTED] 2140th Communications Squadron to furnish the names of the USAF military switchboard operators who covered the swing shifts at the Base Telephone Switchboard the evenings of 30 and 31 May and 2 June 1968. Of the two airmen, investigation revealed Sgt LARRY LuVERNE TOENCES, AF [REDACTED] was subsequently found to have knowledge of one telephone call. u.s.

5. On 11 June 1968, TOENCES was interviewed and furnished a signed sworn statement which is set forth verbatim as follows:

I work as a telephone operator at Athenai Airport telephone exchange. I have been here since August 1966. For approximately the past two months I have been working the following shifts - On Sunday and Monday I work midnight shift from 2300-0700 hours. On Thursday Friday and Saturday I work the swing shift from 1500-2300 hours.

I cannot recall the exact date or which shift I was on but approximately 2 weeks to one month ago I received a telephone call on the base line 982-101. I was in the exchange by myself when I received the call. The call came from a person who gave his name, which I do not recall but I am sure was a foreign name. He said he was a Greek national and he spoke good English. He didn't sound drunk or anything like that but sounded like a normal intelligent person. He mentioned he had been in the United States. He told me he heard Kennedy had been shot and asked if there

would be coverage on the radio that night or if it would be on the next morning. I told him I didn't know anything about it but to wait a minute and I would connect him with someone else. I plugged in the line to the Security Police so he could talk to them. From what I heard of the conversation, he told the security police approximately what he had told me. The Security Police then told me to connect him with the radio station. While I was making the connection and before the connection was made, the person calling hung up his phone. I talked to the person at the radio station whom I do not know by name, and he seemed like he was in a hurry, said he didn't have anything at the time but if he did get something he would put it on the air.

I called Adana Turkey AFRTS and asked if they had heard anything about Kennedy being shot. They said they hadn't but would call back if they heard anything.

Either that same night or the next day I told Sgt Larry Hurd, of the Communications Center about the phone call. I also told other persons in my section about the call.

On 6 June HURD told me that I should call the OSI and tell them about the phone call. I called the Staff duty officer to find out who the OSI Duty Agent was. I didn't call the OSI as I didn't want to bother the duty agent at his home. I called the Security Police also and talked to the Flight Supervisor, who said he recalled something about the phone call and that the Flight Supervisor who was on duty the night of the phone call would be on day shift the "day after tomorrow" which should have been 8 June, Saturday. He said they got a lot of calls like that which didn't amount to anything and he didn't think it was necessary to call the OSI. I asked him to contact the man who had been on duty and see if he felt it was important to call OSI about it. I didn't hear anything more about this until today. There is no way I can recall which day I received the call. I believe it may have been on a week end as things were pretty slow that night. The call came while I was in the exchange alone which is normally on the midnight shift and it came in before the radio station goes off the air for the night which I believe is at 0100.

I can't recall anything more about the incident at this time.

The original statement is being retained in the files of this district and will be released to proper authority upon request.

6. On 11 June 1968, Miss JULIE CLAIRE SWANER, U.S. Passport [REDACTED] was interviewed by SA RAYMOND J. REINER and the writer. SWANER furnished a signed sworn statement which is set forth verbatim as follows:

I have been in Greece approximately 14 months with a couple of trips to other parts of Europe. Since July 1967 I have been residing at #17 Lycavittos St., and then at #42 Xenocratos St. in Athens. I have been attending "College Year in Athens"



school which is a one year college. I am due to depart Greece on 13 June going to Rome then to Amsterdam and then to New York with a departure date from Amsterdam on 24 June. My address in the United States is 555 - 13th Ave., Salt Lake City, Utah. I have known JAMES CRAIG BARNES since approximately October 1967.

Sometime during the week May 26-30, I was informed by CRAIG BARNES of his having received a telephone call or calls at the AFRTS Station. I believe a period of one or two days elapsed before I was informed of the calls. He said the calls were inquiring as to whether the Radio Station had information on the alleged assassination of ROBERT KENNEDY. I responded rather negatively to this piece of information due to the fact it was not an actuality. We were then informed of KENNEDY's assassination on the evening of June 6. Several hours later CRAIG mentioned whether there was a possible connection with the phone calls and the incident. We could not decide on a precise date of his telling me about the calls.

On Friday morning June 7 in the Tameion bldg in Athens, CRAIG encountered a man with whom he desired to have a private conversation. I surmised it was some person with whom he was relaying the incident of the phone calls.

I have nothing else to add at this time.

7. On 11 June 1968, NORMAN DUFRESNE, MSgt, AF [REDACTED] Operations Sergeant, Security Police furnished the names of the Flight Sgt and Desk Sgt of each Security Police Flight. MICHAEL A. GYOKERES, A1C, AF [REDACTED] stated that prior to the KENNEDY assassination he had, while on duty, received a telephone call during which an unknown person inquired about a rumor that Senator KENNEDY had been assassinated. GYOKERES furnished a signed sworn statement relating to his receiving the telephone call. The text of his statement is set forth verbatim as follows:

U.S.  
ATHENS AIRPORT, GREECE

I was assigned to duties as "D" Flight Desk Sgt on 11 May 68. I received a call while working a swing shift a couple of days there after possibly 15, 16 or 17 of May. From a man who identified himself as "a Greek who had been in the United States" and he asked whether or not rumors he had heard in downtown Athens concerning Senator Kennedy being assassinated were true or not. I told him I had no knowledge as to whether it was true or not. I can't remember or not whether we called the Radio Station to confirm or deny this. Mr. Dozis, Flight Interpreter, was also listening in on the call. TSgt Gogola was also in the office at the time of the call and he was immediately notified. No entry was made in the desk blotter due to the fact that it was only a rumor. The caller did not identify himself, anymore than saying "He was a Greek who had been in the United States". No other calls of this nature had been received prior to or after this one call.

The original statement is being retained in the files of this district and will be released to proper authority upon request.



8. On 12 June 1968, LARRY W. HURD Sgt, AF [REDACTED] 2140th Communications Squadron was interviewed concerning his conversations with TOENGES about the matter being investigated. HURD stated that he was on duty in the Communications Center the evening TOENGES told him he received a telephone call inquiring about KENNEDY being assassinated. He had no first hand knowledge of the conversation and could only recall that TOENGES told him the telephone call was from a Greek national inquiring about KENNEDY being shot. He believes he was told about this by TOENGES on 17 May 1968.

The day after KENNEDY was shot he contacted TOENGES and advised him he should contact the OSI with his information but that TOENGES called the Security Police instead. HURD could add nothing more that he felt pertinent to this investigation.

9. On 12 <sup>June</sup> ~~May~~ 68, SA ROE telephonically contacted 71-CIS-1 and inquired as to whether that activity had any information relating to this inquiry. SA ROE was informed no similar reports had been received locally by that activity.

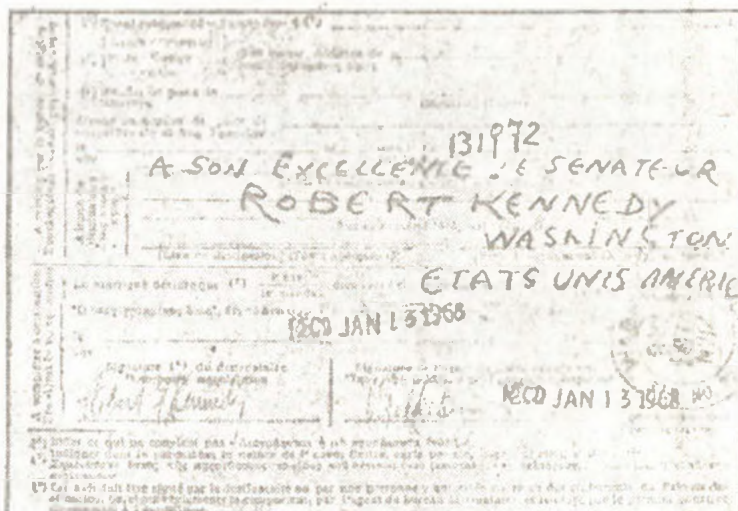

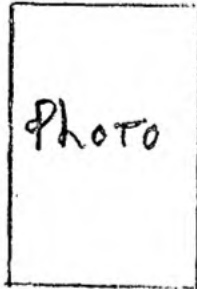



When call returned, KHAN related he was out on \$4,000.00 bail and the INS hearing had been continued until 7/19/68 at Los Angeles. KHAN's Los Angeles attorney was not familiar with the deportation case, and INS, Los Angeles, did not appear to have all the facts here. KHAN's attorney at the INS hearing will be DAVID CARLINER, 902 Warner Building, Washington, D. C.

KHAN continued that INS Agents arrested him about an hour after he was interviewed by detectives of the Los Angeles Police Department concerning the KENSALT case. KHAN claimed the Los Angeles Police Department wanted him to take a lie detector test when he told them he, on basis of a photo identification, thought he had seen SIRHAN SIRHAN at the Senator KENNEDY campaign headquarters 6/4/68. By memorandum A. Rosen to DeLoach 6-12-68, it was recommended and approved by the Director that certain procedures be followed in reporting results of examinations by the FBI Laboratory or Identification Division in captioned case. Reports of results of examinations of evidence submitted by FBI field offices are to be addressed to the Los Angeles County Prosecuting Attorney, E. J. Younger, with copies to pertinent FBI Divisions and Offices. Administrative data and other information of special Bureau interest would not be sent to Younger.

The attached Laboratory report relating to a voice comparison examination contains information showing handling of evidence only. The questioned materials consisted of a tape recording of an unknown caller to the Hilly Rose Radio Show, Station KNEW, Oakland, California. The known material consisted of recordings of S. B. Sirhan made by the Los Angeles Police Department. The transmittal page contains administrative data for investigative guidance revealing that the voice of Sirhan differs in significant characteristics from the voice of the anonymous caller to Radio Station KNEW, and it is not likely they are the same speaker. It is, therefore, felt that since no purpose would be served by submitting this report to the Los Angeles County officials, the report should be sent directly to the contributor, the Los Angeles FBI Office, in accordance with normal procedures.

On the evening of June 19, 1968, Karl Uecker, Waiter, Ambassador Hotel, 3400 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, California, advised he received an unsigned, anonymous, handwritten, air mail letter earlier in the day. The letter and envelope were written in the German language. The envelope was addressed to Karl Uecker, Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, and was postmarked Frankfurt, Am-Main-June 16, 1968. It contained German postage stamps. The return address on the envelope was given as the German Arabic Committee.

Mr. Uecker is a former German national. He said the letter contained a threat to his life and also contained a threat to murder Senator Edward Kennedy and the children of the late Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

The facts of this matter were presented to U. S. Attorney W. Matthew Byrne, Jr., on June 19, 1968, who said he would withhold prosecutive opinion pending discussion with the Department of Justice in Washington, D. C. Mr. Byrne said he would notify the Los Angeles Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) of his opinion at the earliest possible date.

The previously described letter and envelope were forwarded to the FBI Laboratory in Washington, D. C., for examination.

This will confirm the information furnished to U. S. Secret Service Special Agent Thomas Nagle on June 20, 1968.

THE GUN STORE OWNER, BEN HERRICK, WHO REPORTEDLY SOLD AMMUNITION TO SIRHAN SIRHAN, WHICH WAS USED IN ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR KENNEDY, IS CIRCULATING PETITION<sup>S</sup> AGAINST PROPOSED GUN CONTROL LEGISLATION. HERRICK IS DISPLAYING THE PETITIONS AT HIS STORE, EIGHT NINE SEVEN TWO HUNTINGTON DRIVE, SAN GABRIEL, IN COOPERATION WITH COMMITTEE FOR THE PRESERVATION OF FIREARMS OWNERSHIP. HERRICK INDICATED HE COLLECTED FIVE HUNDRED SIGNATURES LAST WEEK.

HERRICK QUOTED AS SAYING "WE HAVE DONE WHAT WE CAN TO GET THE PUBLIC AROUSED IN ORDER TO TRY TO STOP THIS HYSTERICAL LEGISLATION AGAINST GUN CONTROL."
