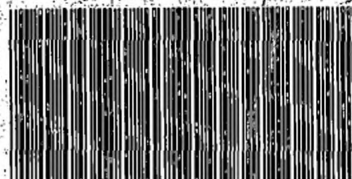

Numbers 1 through 73 were from an envelope containing six strips of negatives, which was captioned "GOOD SAMARITAN HOSPITAL and ITALIAN REPORTER at ASSASSINATION SPOT. FRANK MANKIEWITZ and PIERRE, ETC."

Numbers 74 through 113 were from an envelope containing six strips of negatives, which was captioned "SAN DIEGO (night before assassination), silhouettes of KENNEDY, ETC. AMBASSADOR HOTEL before assassination KENNEDY".

Numbers 114 through 191 were from an envelope containing six strips of negatives, which was captioned "LOS ANGELES AMBASSADOR HOTEL BEFORE ASSASSINATION. KENNEDY. AT GENERAL HOSPITAL AFTER SHOOTING (OUTSIDE) AND AT GOOD SAMARITAN HOSPITAL ( OUTSIDE)".

Los Angeles reports of 6/9/68, 6/15/68 and 7/1/68 have been reviewed at the Bureau in order to insure that all aspects of our investigation into the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy have been completely handled.

With that in mind the following leads, all pertaining to the background of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, are being set forth for your consideration:

Report of 6/9/68.

1. During interview with Mrs. Nell Goris, Theodora Van Amersfoort, a Mrs. Winsink, and a David Hendrickson were identified as being friendly with Sirhan or members of his family. Van Amersfoort, Winsink, and Hendrickson should be located and interviewed. See Page 859.

2. During an interview with Mauf Mohammad Bedran an individual named Mistig last name unknown was identified as having been with Sirhan Sirhan on the evening of 6/4/68 at the Pasadena City College Coffee Shop. Identify, locate, and interview Mistig. See Page 876.

3. Edward Van Antwerp allegedly resided with Sirhan during the Summer and Fall of 1966 in the Highlander Motel, Norco, California. Although Van Antwerp is an alcoholic and while his wife and other relatives have been interviewed, Van Antwerp should be interviewed. See Page 882.

4. Raymond Sichter, former gardner at the Grange Vista Del Rio Ranch, Corona, California, advised Sirhan on 4/20/68 made inquiry concerning Frank last name unknown, former head waiter at ranch. Locate and interview Frank. Conduct inquiry on Cota Street in an effort to identify couple with whom Sirhan resided according to Sichter. See Page 905.

5. Locate and interview Rex Ellsworth, 3985 Schaefer Avenue, Chino, California, by whom Sirhan was allegedly employed in 1965. See Page 900.

Specifically no interviews could be located for the following: Dr. Paul Nilsson, Dr. Robert G. Greeman, Dr. John T. Garner, and Dr. Samuel W. Weaver. Locate and interview Earl H. Laffoon, Investigations, 1933 West 8th Street, Suite 210, Los Angeles, who conducted a surveillance of the subject on at least two occasions.

7. Locate and interview Ray Loza, 416 Lola Avenue, Pasadena, who was allegedly employed by the Campus Ball and Cue on June 4, 1968. See Page 318.

8. Locate and interview Abdul Majed DeBass, a former acquaintance of Sirhan. See Pages 215 and 216.

9. Marcia Girouard, 73½ Fairview, Arcadia, California, was identified as a co-worker of Sirhan at the Organic-Pasadena, a health food store. Locate and interview Marcia Girouard. See Page 212.

10. Cheryl Pierce, 8757 East Guess, Rosemead, California, was identified as a co-worker of Sirhan at the Organic-Pasadena, a health food store. Locate and interview Cheryl Pierce. See Page 212.

11. Sirhan allegedly worked part-time at Peak's Hamburger House (now known as Taco Treat). Verify employment, interview fellow workers and conduct other appropriate investigation. See Page 193.

12. Sirhan allegedly studied mysticism with an individual named Paul last name unknown. Locate and identify Paul. See Pages 184 and 185.

13. Attempt to determine if Sirhan had a bank account. Review of past salary checks may provide pertinent information with respect thereto.

16. Buddy Ebsen and Dale Robertson, prominent television and screen personalities, have been interviewed concerning their knowledge of Sirhan who was employed as exercise boy during period these individuals boarded horses at the Granja Vista Del Rio Ranch. Desi Arnez also named, has not been interviewed. Handle. See Page 535.

17. Locate and interview Omar Ramzi possibly associated with the Arab Students Association. Sirhan was allegedly in attendance at a meeting at Ramzi's house during the Fall of 1966. See Pages 550 - 552.

18. The following, all teachers at the John Muir High School, have not been interviewed: Keith McKay, Dr. Natalie Gunkel, Mrs. Velma Marlow, Carl Hedeon, and Joseph Zeronian. Locate and interview. See Pages 486 and 487.

If the above leads have been covered the Bureau should be advised. If additional investigation is necessary appropriate leads should be set forth by the Los Angeles Office.

HASER on 7/26/68, disclose that CLIFFORD GILLILAND FLITTIE was last issued passport Z-772869 at Consulate, Brisbane, Australia, on 1/8/68, for proposed continued indefinite travel abroad. No specific travel plans mentioned in his application dated 1/4/68, at Brisbane. This passport was valid for three years' travel to all countries except Cuba, Mainland China, North Korea and North Vietnam.

Under current passport regulations, this individual may use this passport for lawful travel within period of its validity whenever and as often as desired without further notification to Department of State or other Government agency. Passport Office does not receive info as to whether or when a passport is used for foreign travel.

In the event of death or accident, he requested that either Mr. E.G. FLITTIE, Box 3002 University Station, Laramie, Wyoming, or Mrs. C.G. FLITTIE, Flat 7c Torbrek (?), 182 Dornoch (?) Terrace, Brisbane, Australia, be notified. He listed his father as THEODORE I. FLITTIE, born Medelia, Minnesota, [REDACTED] deceased, and mother as GRACE E. GILLILAND, born Fairfield, Iowa, [REDACTED] deceased.

FLITTIE stated he was last married 5/22/54, to DAWN LEE (FLITTIE), born [REDACTED] at New York City, residing with him, marriage not terminated.

This individual was previously issued passport [REDACTED] at New York City on 4/1/63, but application for this passport was not available at this time. This 1963 passport was renewed at Brisbane, date not given, but probably in 1966, to expire 4/1/68, at which time he had same foreign address as above. He gave his United States address on this occasion as c/o HOWARD LEE, 15 Jacobus (?) Place, New York City 10463. He stated his plans for return to United States were indefinite and his reason for being abroad was as manager of oil exploiting company.

JOHN A. SWEDE has been interviewed at Los Angeles and states he and his wife were at the Ambassador Hotel in Baghdad during the evening of 5/17/68. While they were in the dining room, a waiter said ROBERT KENNEDY had been shot in the head. The waiter said he heard this information over the Arabic radio. The waiter commented that the trouble with the world is the "Jew" and the U. S. is dominated and motivated by Zionists.

Mr. SWEDE is unable to explain why the waiter made comment regarding the shooting of Senator KENNEDY about three weeks before he was actually shot. He felt the information was important enough that it be brought to the attention of someone, and he notified the American Embassy in Singapore, shortly after the actual shooting of KENNEDY. *J*

Enclosed herewith are five copies and one original of a letterhead memorandum regarding one, JOSE A. PEREZ QUESTA.

The information contained in the letterhead memorandum was furnished to SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, JR., on 7/19/68 by Chief GEORGE STONER, of the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office, Bureau of Investigation, 524 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, California.

Mr. STONER explained that the Honorable EVELLE J. YOUNGER, District Attorney for Los Angeles County, received a letter from Mr. THOMAS C. LYNCH, Attorney General for the State of California, dated 7/15/68. In his letter to Mr. YOUNGER, Mr. LYNCH included a letter bearing a date of 6/16/68 from one, JOSE A. PEREZ QUESTA of Calle Maria B. Sanchez, Number 46, Enriquillo, Dominican Republic. In the letter, PEREZ sets forth a personal desire in his part to personally confront SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN in personal combat for the purpose of killing him.

Mr. STONER advised that the letter was referred to the Office of the Los Angeles County District Attorney because SIRHAN will be prosecuted within the jurisdiction of that agency. In view of the Dominican Republic residence of PEREZ, this office does not anticipate conducting any investigation with respect to this letter. He advised, however, that it was desirable that the Bureau be advised and that perhaps appropriate authority to the Dominican Republic could be alerted, in the event PEREZ attempted to obtain permission to enter the United States.

Chief George Stoner of the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office, Bureau of Investigation, 524 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, California on July 19, 1968 advised his office had received a letter from the Honorable Thomas C. Lynch, Attorney General for the State of California dated July 15, 1968.

Mr. Lynch forwarded to the Office of the Los Angeles County District Attorney, a letter handwritten in Spanish, dated June 15, 1968 from Enriquillo, Dominican Republic. The letter states that the writer, Jose A. Perez Questa extends his greetings to the Attorney General of California and requests his assistance in "something very important which must be said". The writer of the letter states, "I want to kill Sirhan Bishara Sirhan. I want to fight hand to hand with this Jordanian devil". The writer of the letter goes on to state that he desires an opportunity to "give what he deserves to this cowardly assassin". The letter continues stating that the writer would like to "confront him on the battle field, fist to fist with this dirty assassin in order to hit him strongly with my fist and after killing him to take him apart piece by piece with my teeth and if it is possible to eat him also because this dirty Jordanian does not deserve a different death since Sirhan Bishara Sirhan took the life of an idealistic man and humanitarian as Robert F. Kennedy".

The writer of the letter again repeats his desire as set forth above and requests the assistance of Mr. Lynch in helping him to ask the authorities of the Government of the United States, "to see if they can authorize such a thing". The writer of the letter closes by saying,

Chief George Stoner of the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office, Bureau of Investigation, 524 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, California on July 19, 1968 advised his office had received a letter from the Honorable Thomas C. Lynch, Attorney General for the State of California dated July 15, 1968.

Mr. Lynch forwarded to the Office of the Los Angeles County District Attorney, a letter handwritten in Spanish, dated June 15, 1968 from Enriquillo, Dominican Republic. The letter states that the writer, Jose A. Perez Questa extends his greetings to the Attorney General of California and requests his assistance in "something very important which must be said". The writer of the letter states, "I want to kill Sirhan Bishara Sirhan. I want to fight hand to hand with this Jordanian devil". The writer of the letter goes on to state that he desires an opportunity to "give what he deserves to this cowardly assassin". The letter continues stating that the writer would like to "confront him on the battle field, fist to fist with this dirty assassin in order to hit him strongly with my fist" and after killing him to take him apart piece by piece with my teeth and if it is possible to eat him also because this dirty Jordanian does not deserve a different death since Sirhan Bishara Sirhan took the life of an idealistic man and humanitarian as Robert F. Kennedy".

The writer of the letter again repeats his desire as set forth above and requests the assistance of Mr. Lynch in helping him to ask the authorities of the Government of the United States, "to see if they can authorize such a thing". The writer of the letter closes by saying,

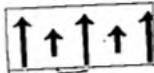

Gentlemen:

As I listened to the news of the assassination of Senator Kennedy and heard the name Sirhan, my thoughts reflected on an experience that I had at UNESCO-Paris during the first and second week of February.

This morning I purchased the Daily Star, a Beirut paper, and found the name Sirhan has a family name of Sar'han and that this assailant's family lived near Jerusalem. This rang a bell!

During my briefing in Paris, I was interviewed by a Miss Sar'han from the outskirts of Jerusalem who told me in a nervous manner, almost in tears that I would not be accepted in Jerusalem and Ramallah because I was an American and that the people there were bitter against Americans. After our conversation, I reported the remarks to a member of the American Delegation to UNESCO who immediately knew her name without my announcing it. He stated that this lady was a real fanatic. I have since quoted her to people in UNRWA Headquarters who also agreed that this lady was a fanatic.

It might be worth while to investigate this lady's background and connection with the assailant. It appears that her villa contains an office for UNRWA Headquarters for refugees, or perhaps I could be mistaken about this but it looked like the same place that was pointed out to me as "the villa of Miss Sar'han of UNESCO," (to which I made no reply because I was sure it was meant to bring on some statement concerning my meeting her) and later I stopped in to see an official who was out. The place looked the same as the one pointed out the day before, but I refused to ask if it were the same.

UNRWA is the savior of millions of refugees and yet, they

over

hate it and the Americans like a plague.

I am leaving Beirut on Saturday morning and will mail this in Chicago when I deplane. From Chicago I plan to go to Norman, Oklahoma to attend the University after stopping for a day or so with my sister, Mrs. Jesse Carter (2538 Massachusetts) of Gary, Indiana.

My address in Norman will be P.O. Box 189, if you care to reach me for any reason.

I also know that several UNRWA folk had been mentioning the fact that Senator Kennedy spoke of giving more aid to Isreal recently. If Sirhan loved his country that much, he would be here with his arms trying to protect it.

Dear Mr. Clark:

On arriving from Beirut, Lebanon in Dallas June 9th, I mailed three letters which I had planned to mail from Chicago, but due to baggage problems, transfer of airlines, etc., I did not venture to locate a mail box.

The letters were sent to the F.B.I. in Chicago, New York, and Washington. Since I have not heard from any of them, I still do not know if they were intercepted at some point or other, or if they have been received.

Before leaving Beirut, I talked with the Security Officer at the American Embassy and told him that a lady by the name of Miss Sar'han, stationed in UNESCO HEADQUARTERS, PARIS, informed me during my orientation activities at UNESCO that I "would not be accepted in Jerusalem, because I was an American, and that the Arabs there were bitter against the Americans because they had helped Israel to crush them...." This same lady lives near Jerusalem, - on the outskirts, as did Sirhin Sirhin. The day following the assassination of Senator Kennedy, the Daily News, published in Beirut, carried the story and stated that this man (the killer) had a family name, also known as Sar'han with about 150 kinsmen, etc. just outside Jerusalem. I enclosed this clipping in the Washington letter.

During the last two weeks in March, this same paper, The Daily News of Beirut, ran a column on the right-hand side of one page with a headline to this effect: Jordan Intelligence Mute Plan to Oust Westerners. The article stated that doctors, lawyers, teachers, etc. planned to oust the westerners, especially the AMERICAN IMPERIALISTS. On the same page, left side, there was an article stating that the United States was sending \_\_\_\_\_ million dollars worth of food, etc. to the Arab nations. This was just prior to my visit to Jordan, and I jokingly mentioned the two

articles to an education officer FROM Jordam who was in the UNRWA Headquarters office in Beirut where I worked until leaving there the week-end after the Senator was killed. This officer laughed and asked, "Will the U.S. give us the money before we put them out, or after?"

These incidents are trite, but there may be some connection between the UNESCO lady and Sirhin.

You will kindly send a postal card to me acknowledging receipt of this letter as I plan to mail it today, which means I cannot INSURE IT.



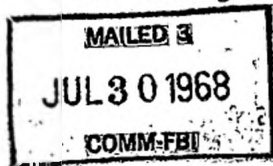

Gentlemen:

This is a follow-up to my letter sent to you which was dated, I believe, June 14, 1968 (I kept no copy of this letter, therefore I'm not positive about this date). This letter was concerning scenes that were taken probably at the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles right before the shooting of Senator Robert Francis Kennedy which were shown on a TV channel in my area on the night of either Wednesday, June 5, or Thursday, June 6, 1968. This letter told of a particular man in one of these scenes, with either his back or profile to the TV camera, who was moving through the large crowd, in a direction that was away from the camera, at what appeared to be a fast pace, as if with some special purpose or destination in mind, while the rest of the crowd appeared to be moving about rather slowly.

When I received an acknowledgment several days later from Mr. J. Edgar Hoover of the receipt of his copy of this June 14 letter, I was surprised to learn that my letter had been delivered so fast as I didn't have complete addresses for any of the people to whom I sent a copy of this letter. I believe that I put my return address on all of the envelopes for these letters when I mailed them and none of them were returned to me; therefore, I am hoping that they arrived at their proper destinations. However, to make certain that these letters have been received, and were not misplaced or lost, would you please sign the attached extra copy of this letter acknowledging receipt of this June 14 letter and return the signed copy to me at your earliest convenience in the stamped and self-addressed envelope which is also attached so that I can dismiss this entire matter from my mind.
