

For the assistance of WFO, there is attached a translation from Serbian of a communication dated June 11, 1968, Paris, France, from "an anonymous Serbian." There is also attached a copy of a letter from Legat, Paris dated 8/29/68 and enclosures thereto dealing with this matter.

It is requested that Secret Service be contacted and a determination made as to whether the photograph contained in the 1/22/68 letter to President Johnson from Djuro Stokic is identical with the photograph that apparently was enclosed in the 6/11/68 anonymous communication. It is noted that Secret Service did not furnish a photograph in its referral to the Bureau.

Copies of the above-referred-to material are likewise enclosed for the information of the Los Angeles Office.

An examination is being conducted by the FBI Laboratory of the handwriting in both communications and you will be advised of the results.

ReBulet to Paris 8/16/68, enclosing copies of anonymous communication dated 6/11/68 at Paris, France, addressed to Senator EDWARD KENNEDY, and the translation of this communication.

By referenced letter, Paris was requested to attempt to identify the author of the above-mentioned letter.

For information of the Bureau and Los Angeles, the Paris Office recently received from CIA, Paris, a photograph and letter in the Serbo-Croatian language (Cyrillic script). A partial translation of this letter identified the writer as DJURO STOKIC. As the letter alluded to a threat to President JOHNSON, the original letter and the photograph were furnished to the Paris office of the Secret Service.

Enclosed for the information of the Bureau and Los Angeles is one copy each of Paris letter dated 8/7/68 to ALS, (CIA), with copies to Secret Service and Visa Section, American Embassy, Paris. Enclosed for the Bureau is one copy of the Serbo-Croatian letter dated 1/22/68 at Paris, with photograph of DJURO STOKIC.

It is to be noted that there are numerous similarities between the letter written to Senator KENNEDY and the STOKIC communication. Both of these letters were written in the Cyrillic script of the Serbo-Croatian language and both enclosed photographs. Both lepters alluded to the fact that

the writer had been refused a visa to immigrate to Chicago and both letters ended with the words "long live" (ziveo). In the letter to Senator KENNEDY, the author stated he had been born in the same year as the Senator. It is to be noted that Senator KENNEDY was born 2/22/32, while STOKIC, according to information contained in Paris Secret Service file, is listed as having been born at Dolovo, Yugoslavia.

Enclosed for the information of the Bureau and Los Angeles is one copy each of Secret Service, Paris, report and American Embassy, Paris, Visa Section memorandum dated 5/26/66 pertaining to STOKIC. It is to be noted that the source of the Secret Service report is the Police Judiciaire (Criminal Police), Surete Nationale, Paris, and that it denotes that STOKIC had been placed in a psychiatric hospital in France in 1965. This same report also states that STOKIC appears to have very strong leanings toward writing letters to certain heads of foreign states.

STOKIC's visa file at the American Embassy, Paris, reveals that his application for an immigrant visa to the United States was rejected as he was found medically ineligible, class "A." According to the Visa Section, classification "A" is a classification given on the basis of mental or physical inability seldom overcome.

Based on the information set out in this letter, it is believed that the author of the letter to Senator KENNEDY may be possibly identical with DJURO STOKIC.

The Bureau is requested to have the FBI Laboratory make a comparison of the handwriting between the letter addressed to Senator KENNEDY, dated 6/11/68, with those written by STOKIC, dated 1/22/68, and the one STOKIC wrote in 1966 on the front and back of a World Council of Churches letter dated 5/24/66. Copies of these three letters are enclosed.

It is to be noted that the original STOKIC letter of 1/22/68 was furnished to the Paris Office of the Secret Service on 8/7/68 and they have, in turn, forwarded this letter to their headquarters in Washington. The original STOKIC letter of 1966 is located in the American Embassy, Paris, visa file.

In addition to the Laboratory comparison, the Bureau is requested to determine from Secret Service headquarters in

Washington, D. C., if the photograph or picture enclosed with the letter to Senator KENNEDY (see page three, next to last line of translation letter) was that of the author. In the event this was the case, the Bureau is requested to compare the photograph of STOKIC with that contained in the letter to Senator KENNEDY.

A copy of the translation of the letter to Senator KENNEDY has been furnished to the Ambassador's office in view of information that the author plans to contact Mrs. SHRIVER in the future. Copies of this same communication were also furnished to the Secret Service, Security Office and the Visa Section of the American Embassy, Paris.

Reference is made to your memorandum of July 24, 1968, enclosing a photograph and letter in the Serbo-Croatian language - Cyrillic script, received by the Embassy in Paris.

THE PARTY TO A STATE OF THE STA

Due to the handwriting, a complete translation cannot be made; however, portions of the letter indicate subject to be possibly a mental case. The photograph attached to the letter is that of the subject. It is to be noted that the letter is dated January 22, 1968, at Paris, and signed "Long live Djuro Stokic, the Jew."

The first sentence of the letter indicates that subject plans to get even with President Johnson by stealing his wealth. He also claims to have a list of names of 13 American millionaires, the first being President Johnson and the 13th Governor Nelson Rockefeller. Subject claims he has been forced to this action because President Johnson is responsible for his being turned down a thousand times for a visa to enter the United States. Subject also claims that women and other people are always looking at him and following him. Subject states that, although he likes women, he loves money, "dollars," more.

Our Paris records contain no information identifiable with the subject.

In view of the threat against President Johnson, the original letter and photograph are being furnished to Mr. John H. Hanly, U. S. Secret Service, Paris.

A copy of the letter and photograph are also being furnished to the Visa Section in view of the statement by

HEHOLDSURE

subject of having applied for a visa to enter the United States. The Visa Section is requested to advise the Secret Service office in the event they have any information pertaining to the subject.

A copy of the letter and photograph are also being furnished your office for completion of your records.

STOKIC, Djura.

Official French police records reflect that STOKIC, Djura born at Dolovo, Yugoslavia is ummarried.

A Serbian Nationalist, STOKIC claims to be supporter of the reestablishment of the monarchy in his homeland.

Manifestly obsessed with Yugoslav political problems, he often reads to his compatriots some letters which he is advessing to the high dignitaries of the actual Yugoslavian regime, even to the Yugoslavian Ambassador in France. In these letters, STOKIC, dencunces with violence the "Regime Concentrationnaire de la Yougoslavie".

These letters are oft-times incoherent with vague threats.

Concerning his private life, this foreigner is unfavourably noted in the Records of the Prefecture de Police. He is generally reported as unstable in his job, hot-headed and poses as a homosexual, He lives with a Russian citizen ARESKO, Michel, born at Tchenscokoff, a butler, well-known for his peculiar morales ("mocurs speciales").

Your attention is directed to the fact that while this report bears no security classification its contents are of a personal nature and should be handled on a nocd-to-know basis and must be secured accordingly.

SUBJECT: Information concerning the Yugoslav national, Djura STOKIC.

Djura STOKIC, born on a state of at Dolovo, Yugoslavia, son of Zarco and Julijan Tivator, Yugoslav national, is employed with the "Bar Cleaning" establishment, 18, Rue Chausse d'Antin, Paris 9. He resides at 28, Ray Guillaum Tell. Paris 17. FRANCE

STOKIC entered France on January 21, 1963. He is considered to be of good repute by his circle of friends. He is the holder of a residence pormit valid until 3-18-67 and of Political Refugie Card No. 142-460/5636.

STOXIC is very well thought of by his employer; he is a hard worker, sober and honest.

However, following a demonstration, he was taken to the Psychiatric Institution of the Prefecture de la Seine in May 1965 and was then transferred to the Psychiatric Hospital of Perray-Vaucluse, Seine et Olso, where he stayed for two menths.

STOKIC shows temporary signs of abnormanilty, relating that his uncle is a minister; that his father was a superior officer in the National Yugoslav army, but compatriots from the same district confirm that he comes from an agricultural family. However, STOKIC is widely knowledgeable. He can read but not write French. He appears to have a rather strong leaning towards writing to cortain Heads of Foreign States.



In general, Djura STOKIC is not subject of bad information and despite his occasional mental deficiency, is not considered as a dangerous person.

POLICE FILES CHECK

STOKIC. Djuro, the subject of the attached memorandum from Mr. Philox, Loral Attaché, was identified as being STOKIC, Djura or Djuro, born in Dolovo, Yugoslavia, son of Zarko and Juliana Zizanov STOKIC.

He came to France on January 21, 1963, bearer of Yugoslavian passport issued in Fuzia, Yugoslavia, on June 22, 1962.

Since his arrival in France SUBJECT has worked from time to time in large cencerns such as the Simea Automobile Works, with cleaning contractors, and even at the Prefecture de Police Smack Bar as dishwasher. However, it can be said that he las lived mostly from his wits, only keeping a regular job during short periods when he could not do otherwise.

An ulta-Serbian nationalist, partisan of the re-establishment of the monarchy in Yugoslavia, he for that reason joined the Mouvement National Yougoslave RAVIN GORA, of monarchist trend, with premises at 123 Bld. Davout, Paris 20. He also is a member of the National Serbian Committee in Exile, an extremist organization with headquarters at Chicago, but which is forbidden to operate in France by Order of the Minister of the Interior dated August 2, 1962.


However, the violence of his speech, his continual threats and provocation toward many political personalities, has resulted in STOKIC being kept at a distance by most of his compatriots who fear the consequences of a too boisterous action. STOKIC in fact shows himself above all to be an exacerbated anti-communist to the point where he is considered not to be in his right mind.

He was interpollated by the bolice on the Champs Elysees, Paris, on April, 24, 1965, when waving a placard representing de Gaulle, Potain, Goldwater, and Brigitte Bardot.

Examined by a psychiatrist, he was intermed as schizophrenic paranolae and politically delirious in an asylum at Vaueluse, near Epinay-sur-Orgo. He came out of that asylum on April 16, 1966.

He then continued to send numerous letters to Chief of State and known international personalities.

During 1965 he adhered to the extreme right-wing movement called "Occident" ("West"), which was created during 1964 and operated by Pierre SIDOS, ex-protagonist of "Le Jeune Nation" ("Young Nation") mouvement.



Briefly, his violent anti-communist opinions, added to his unbalanced mental state, make this foreign liable to a more or less outstanding hostile act at the time of international political events.

He is looked-upon most unfavorably in his private life. Well-known as a homosexual, he 'cohabits' with a Russian refugee named Higher YARESKO, born on the the Technology of the Paris Police.

STORIC was interpollated on February 22, 1967 for public exposure (when exhibiting his sexual organs in a public place). Brought before the 24th Chamber of the Seine Tribunal, Faris, on February 23, 1967, he was sentenced to 3-months' imprisonment.

An Expulsion Order was issued by the Ministry of the Interior on January 19, 1968. However, it appears that on intervention of the French Office for Refugees and Stateless Fersons, Paris, a new Order was issued on May 13, 1968 revoking the previous Order.

On June 7, 1968 STOKIC was granted temporary permission to stay in France (four months) enabling him either to find work, to quiet down more normally, or to leave France.

On August 5, 1968 he applied for a visa to go either to the USA, to Japan or to Israel. When making that application he stated he was domiciled at 28 rue Guillaumo Tell, Paris 17, where he shares a room with the above-mentioned Yaresko.

The attached summarizes the present prosecutive status with respect to Sirhan Sirhan, the accused assailant of the late Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

With respect to the Friar's Club prosecution referred to herein, this is the case investigated by FBI Los Angeles involving electronic cheating devices at the Beverly Hills Friar's Club where well-known industrialists and show business people were victimized John Roselli, Cosa Nostra hoodlum and four others have been standing trial in U. S. District Court since June. 1968.

Grant Cooper is attorney for one of the hoodlums involved. Recent investigation indicates Cooper as well as others had access to Grand Jury transcripts and it is conceivable Cooper himself may be subject to Federal prosecution for Obstruction of Justice at the trial's conclusion.



At approximately 12:15 A.M., June 5, 1968, Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, born at Jerusalem, was observed in the kitchen area of the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California, to shoot and kill U.S. Senator Robert F. Kennedy and to wound five other persons, using a .22 caliber revolver.

Sirhan Bishara Sirhan was taken into custody by the Los Angeles Police Department and was indicted by the Grand Jury of Los Angeles County for murder on June 7, 1968, and is presently awaiting trial. A photograph of Sirhan is attached.

On June 4, 1958, the primary elections for the State of California were held to indicate a preferential selection of candidates for the forthcoming national elections in November 1968. Senator Kennedy was one of several candidates for the office of the President of the United States representing the Democratic Party and was given a majority of votes, following which he addressed members of his campaign group and well-wishers in the Embassy Ballroom of the Ambassador Hotel. Following his speech, he departed the ballroom via the rear exit of the stage and turned to his right to pass through the kitchen area en route to the Colonial Room, where he was to meet members of the press. The shooting occurred between these two points. A diagram of the area is attached.

The Los Angeles Police Department has requested assistance in the location and interview of various persons who were guests at the Ambassador Hotel on June 4, 5, 1968, to determine if they are in possession of any information regarding the assassination of Senator Kennedy or knowledge of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan.
