

the farmers. But now a beginning attempt at forcing the growers to sell their land has been made by the federal government—this in their attack on the large DiGiorgio Vineyards. Chavez and the N.F.W.A. and their behind-the-scenes backers see the handwriting on the wall. In the next few years they expect to make increased demands to force the growers to sell their "excess lands" in a program in which the federal government, probably through the War on Poverty, will loan money to the "unions," or their members, to purchase the lands and set up the type of "cooperatives" that Sargent Shriver is already encouraging in the cities. The farmers will be forced, because of the government's monopoly position in water, to submit to having their lands taken from them with their own tax money.

While two growers have now surrendered to the "union," the majority continue to refuse. One of the two that did surrender, Christian Brothers, was Church run and was never picketed, but surrendered because of Church pressures. The second, Schenley, was the target of a nationwide boycott by Leftists; and, since less than one percent of that company's holdings are in California grape fields, Schenley Industries may have figured the fight was not worth it. Or possibly government bureaus mentioned the magic word, *anti-trust*. Still, nearly every grower in Delano we talked to maintained that the

Kennedy family owns a large block of Schenley stock.

Meanwhile, Walter Reuther's "Citizens Crusade" continues to demand federal legislation with all kinds of welfare guarantees, on threat of stepping up the revolution in the streets; right now one of its primary objectives is to force our farmers to accept a union shop. The implications of such control of agriculture are phenomenal. First, it would give the union revolutionaries like Reuther full-circle control over the U.S. economy and, second, it would place a loaded gun at the growers' heads. A ripe crop is not like a production line. You can't shut it down for a month and then come back to it. When a crop is ripe it has to be picked now, not next week. A threatened strike at harvest time would offer an annual opportunity for blackmail. The loss of one crop could break a farm, and no law could protect the farmer from a phony "wildcat" strike.

If you live in the city you can expect to hear more of the "Grapes of Wrath" that exist for the farm workers. You will be told that only massive federal legislation, poverty grants, and unionization will end the terrible situation—just as you have heard a similar tune concerning "Civil Rights." The charges are phony. They come from the same source. And you can count on the fact that the Communists are continuing to run the show. ■ ■

At 10:40 a.m., this date, SA NORMAN P. LeCLAIR telephonically advised that California Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (CII) had just identified SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN as the person who shot Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. CII advised that this identification was based upon a telephonic description by the Los Angeles Police Department of the fingerprints of the suspect they had in custody.

CII stated that the Los Angeles Police Department had received a telephone call from a person who stated he was SIRHAN's brother and that he was certain that the assailant was SIRHAN.

CII records reflect that SIRHAN is a white male, born 3/19/44, in Jerusalem, Jordan, and as of 1965, was a citizen of Jordan. He was fingerprinted on 12/16/65, by the State Horse Racing Board, 107 South Broadway, Los Angeles, California, as an exercise boy.

CII records reflect that these fingerprints were sent to the FBI Identification Division and returned on 12/28/65, marked "No arrest record."

SIRHAN was described as:

Mr. SCHUTZ stated that they desired that copies of SIRHAN's fingerprints be given for hand delivery to an airline pilot en route to Washington, D. C.

Subsequently, SAC WILLIAMS advised SA JONES and I advised SA LeCLAIR that Mr. Schutz at the Bureau had requested that a copy of SIRHAN's fingerprints be transmitted to Washington as soon as possible by wirephoto.

SA LeCLAIR made arrangements for the transmittal of a wirephoto of these fingerprints to Washington, D. C., over UPI wire and when the transmission had been made Supervisor ROBERT C. RIEDEL telephonically advised Mr. SCHUTZ at the Bureau.

Copies of SIRHAN's fingerprints and copies of the Bill of Sale for the revolver used in the assault on Senator KENNEDY were placed aboard PSA Flight #182 in the custody of Captain JIM GORE. The Los Angeles Office was telephonically advised that this flight was to arrive in Los Angeles at 1:50 p.m. and Los Angeles was requested to meet the flight to obtain their copies of the prints and to transfer the Bureau copies to TWA Flight #98, which was to depart Los Angeles at 3:00 p.m., and arrive at Dulles Airport at 10:40 p.m.

A teletype confirming the above arrangements has been previously dispatched to the Bureau and Los Angeles.

The following investigation was conducted this date by the writer and SA ROBERT E. JONES:

Mrs. BRITTON MCFETRIDGE, aka Mrs. MIRJANA MCFETRIDGE, 610 27th St., Sacramento advised that on 5/31/68 she went to the Coin-O-Matic Laundry, 2030 H St and while reading magazines at a picnic table type bench inside the laundromat, she observed a statement about captioned matter written by a ball-point pen on the wooden surface of the table. At that time she attached no significance to it. Following the assault on Sen. KENNEDY she went back to the laundromat, wrote down the message on the back of an envelope and gave it to her husband. She mentioned that she is the sister-in-law of Calif. Assemblyman GEORGE N. ZENOVICH (D), who was also advised of the matter. She did not know any other persons who patronize the laundromat.

The above-mentioned writing was observed and found to read as follows: "Killed by Assassin 12:15AM June 5, 1968 He wanted to follow the footsteps of his brother. to BAD!" The writing was in printed form with indicated misspellings in a space about 1 1/2 inches by 2 inches done by ballpoint pen.

Mr. ORVILLE WOODYARD, Co-owner of the Coin-O-Matic Laundry, 2030 H St., advised that he is medically blind and could not see above printing.

Mrs. JULIA WOODYARD, Co-owner of the Coin-O-Matic Laundry advised that she cleans the bench table top and restrooms of that laundromat every morning at about 8:00AM and first observed the above writing on the morning of 6/5/68. She stated that her cleaning is specifically directed toward removing obscene writing that customers of the laundromat regularly perform during the night. She said that any new writing or defacing of the tabletop is immediately discernible and that the writing about Sen KENNEDY was positively not present prior to the morning of 6/5/68.

Since it appears that the above matter has no connection with person or persons involved in captioned case, no further action is being taken.

On 6/5/68, Lieutenant ED COMBS of the Delano, California, Police Department, was interviewed regarding ROY DONALD MURRAY, who resides at Route 1, Box 3, Earlimart, California. COMBS advised that he has known MURRAY for a period of several years and at one time was working undercover for the Delano Police Department and associated with MURRAY on many gambling expeditions to Las Vegas. He was present at the Elks Club Bar in Delano about five or six weeks ago with the Chief of Police and several other unrecalled individuals. At that time MURRAY was quite intoxicated and was bragging to the group in general what a big man he was and what a big time gambler he was. COMBS stated MURRAY was a gambler and does sometimes when winning gives waitresses \$100 tips just for bringing drinks. He has observed this done by MURRAY on at least two occasions. MURRAY is, however, the type of individual who is a braggart and a loudmouth but usually can be relied upon to pay off gambling debts. COMBS feels that there is a possibility that when MURRAY was claiming he had been called by the Mafia he was possibly only attempting to brag to the local group. He personally does not feel that if something like this did take place MURRAY would discuss it in public. He cannot recall the names of any of the other individuals who were in the area at the time but the Kern County community is definitely anti-KENNEDY and it is quite probable that MURRAY was only attempting to raise himself in the eyes of his associates.

Chief AILES of the Delano Police Department has been unavailable for interview to this point but will be interviewed as soon as possible.

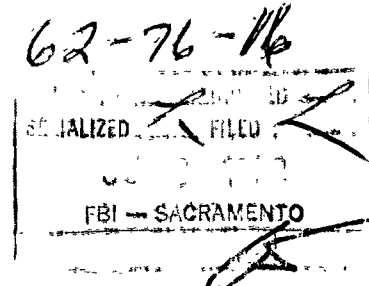

The following will confirm the information furnished to Special Agent Roger G. Grunwald of the U.S. Secret Service, Sacramento, California, on June 5, 1968, by a representative of the FBI:

Mrs. Nadia J. Morales, 915 15th Street, Apt. B, Modesto, California, on June 5, 1968, advised representatives of the FBI that she had been employed as the only Arab at the hospital of the Good Samaritan Medical Center, 1212 Shatto Street, Los Angeles, California, for about a year ending April 26, 1968. Mrs. Morales stated that she resigned because of a "conspiracy" against her. She furnished the names of hospital employees, all of whom she indicated she strongly dislikes, as being in this conspiracy against her.
