A search in the Bureau's records does not disclose the receipt of Sacramento airtel dated 6/7/68, with attached certified copy of California driver's license M238847 of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

Sacramento will search its files to determine whether referenced airtel actually has been mailed to the Bureau.

Past experience of the FBI Laboratory reveals that copies of driver's licenses frequently are not clear enough for adequate handwriting examination. In submitting the copy of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN's driver's license, Sacramento should obtain a clear photograph made normal size, properly certified, so that suitable document examination may be conducted.

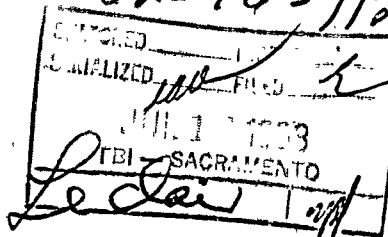

On 7/12/68, ROBERT LEAMAN, Regional Coordinator, John Birch Society, 2627 Mission Road, San Marino, California, advised that one of their members, DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, had telephoned him to advise that he thought the photograph on page 4 of the referenced booklet written by GARY ALLEN looked a lot like SIRHAN SIRHAN.

LEAMAN furnished the address of the author, GARY ALLEN, as 2812 Tigertail Drive Roosmoor, California, telephone number 430-2282.

On 7/12/68, ALLEN advised he wrote the referenced article for the June 1966 issue of American Opinion, an informal monthly review edited by ROBERT WELCH, head of the John Birch Society. He advised that he submitted the article to Belmont, Massachusetts, and thereafter, had nothing to do with it being printed or the final form in which it was presented. He further advised that photographs in the article were inserted by the editor and he was unaware of them until he saw the article in print.

ALLEN stated that he heard the photograph in question on page 4 of his article which was presumed to be SIRHAN SIRHAN

The San Francisco Office is requested to recontact Mr. DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, to ascertain if he knows the identity of one DICK (LNU), who is or was a student at San Jose State College, San Jose, California.

The Sacramento Office is requested to contact Sergeant JERRY DODD, Kern County Sheriff's Office, at Bakersfield, California, who has conducted extensive investigation concerning the Delano Grape Strike, to ascertain if he can establish the identity of one DICK (LNU), who may have been the photographer taking the photograph on page 4 of the article "The Grapes - Communist Wrath in Delano". It is also requested that the date of the State Labor Commission meeting held in Delano be established if possible.

If San Francisco or Sacramento is able to establish the identity of DICK (LNU), interview him concerning the circumstances surrounding the meeting in which he took the questioned photograph and ascertain if he can identify the person on the far left, adjacent to the edge of the photograph as being identical with SIRHAN SIRHAN.

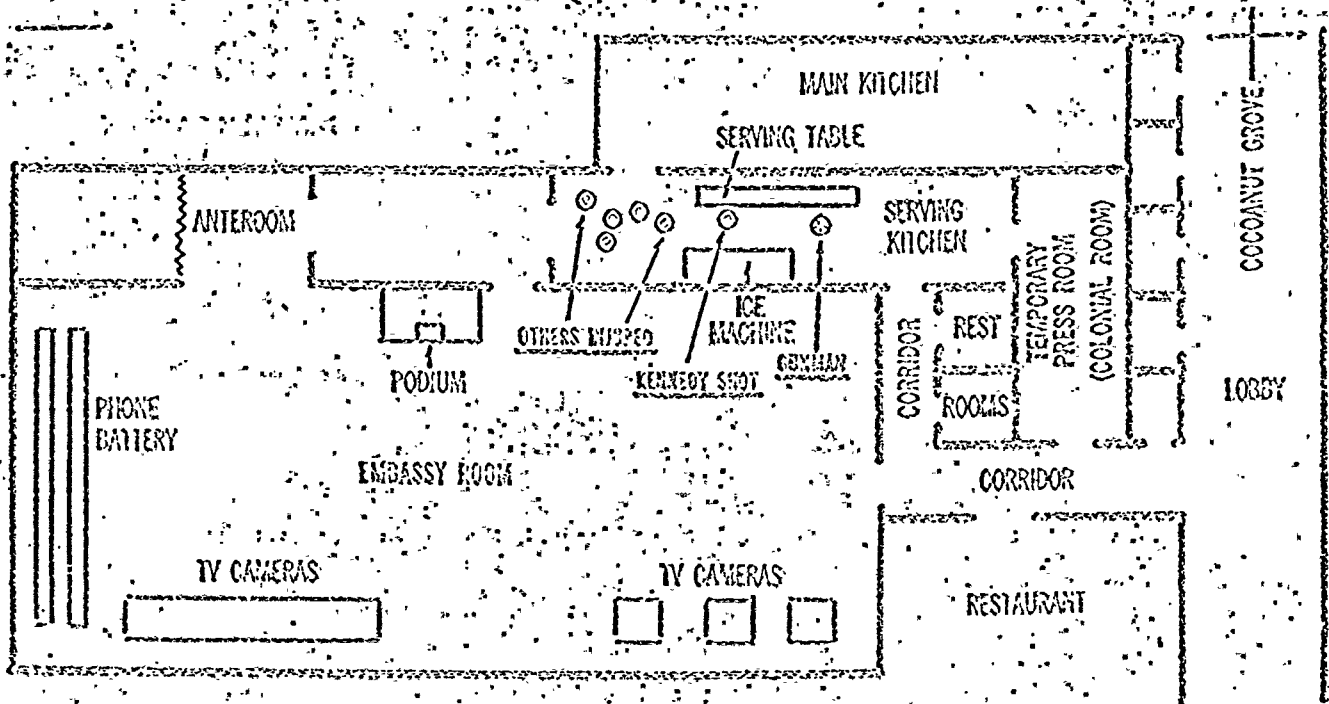


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

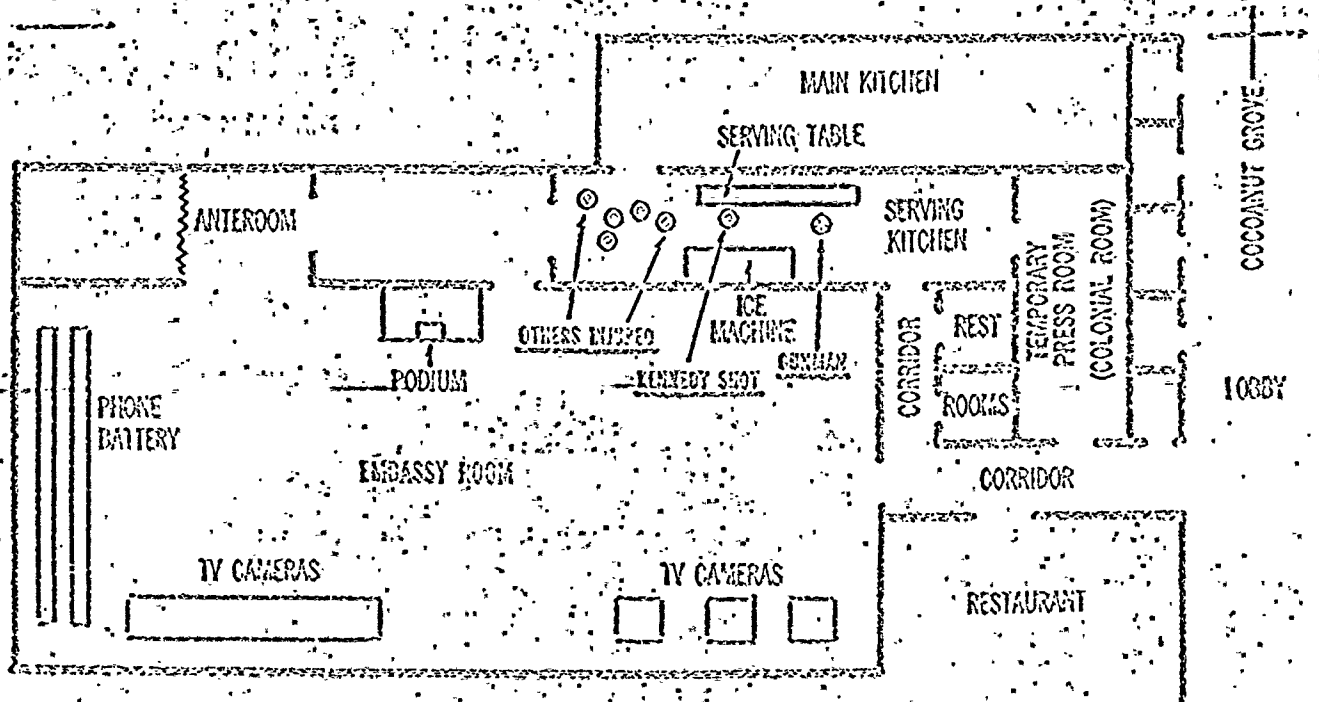


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

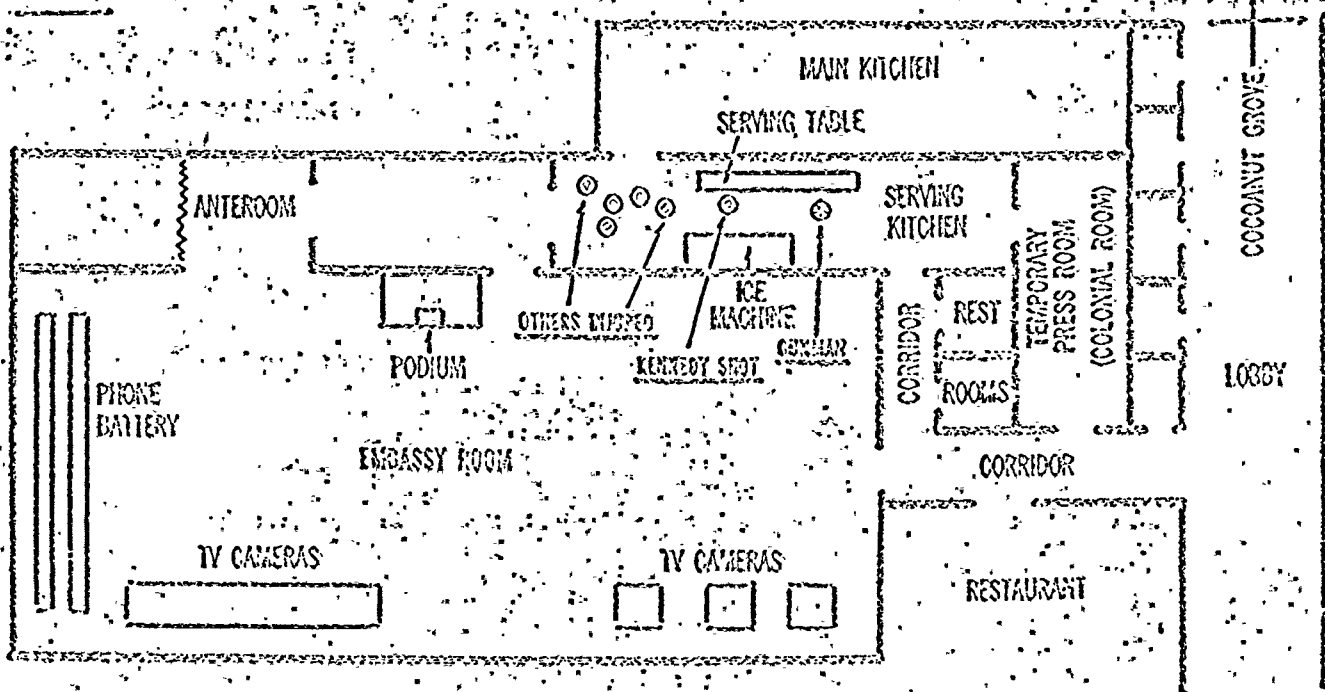


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium of Embassy

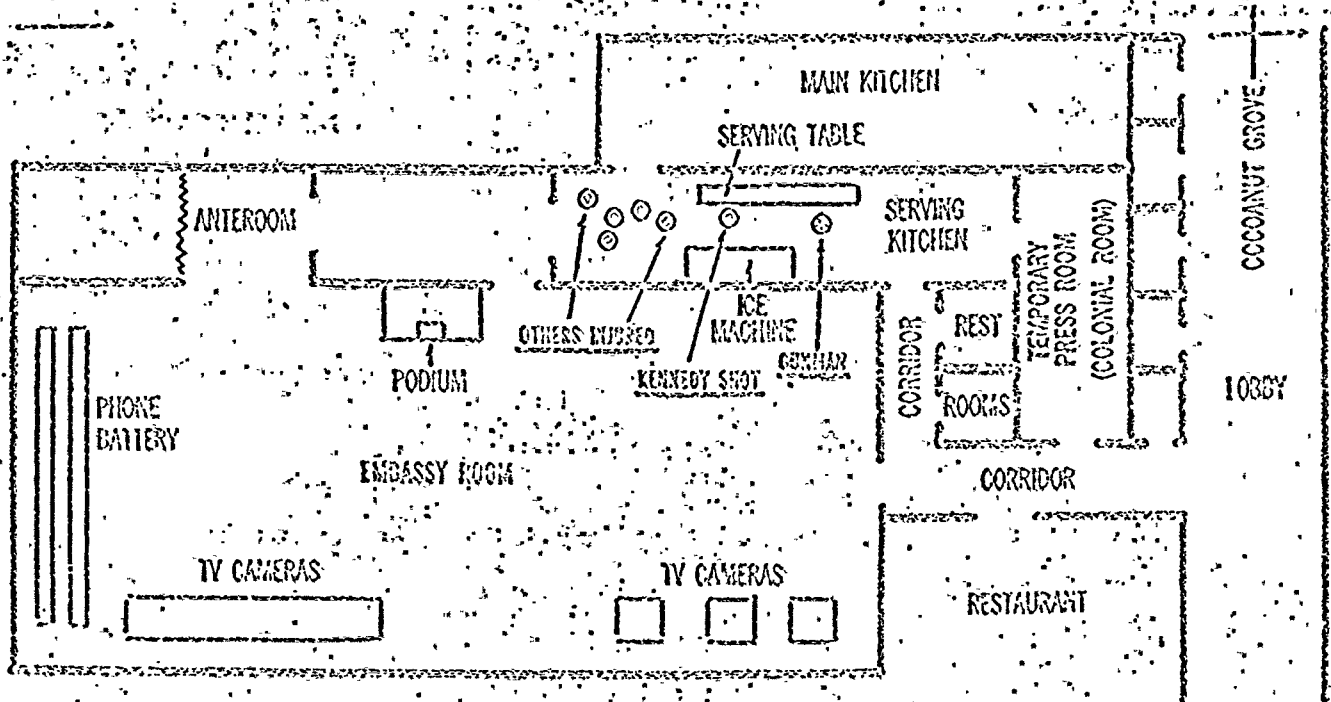


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

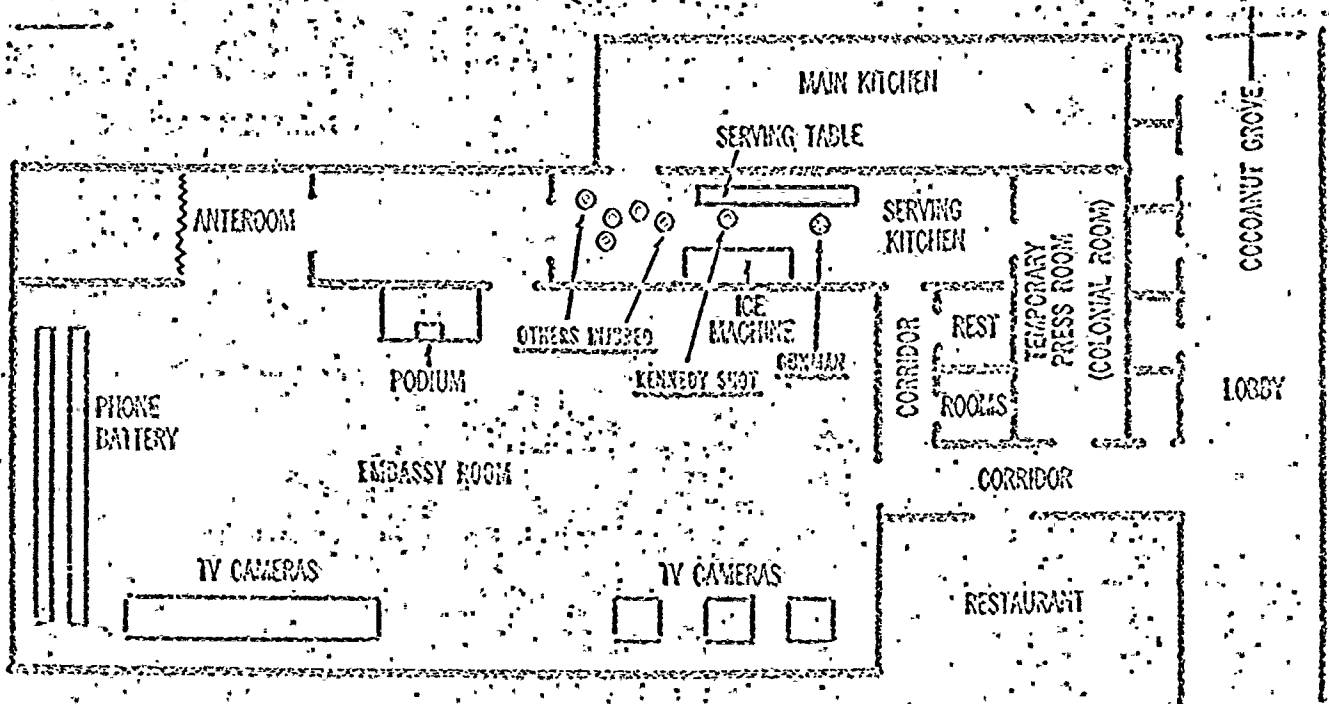


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

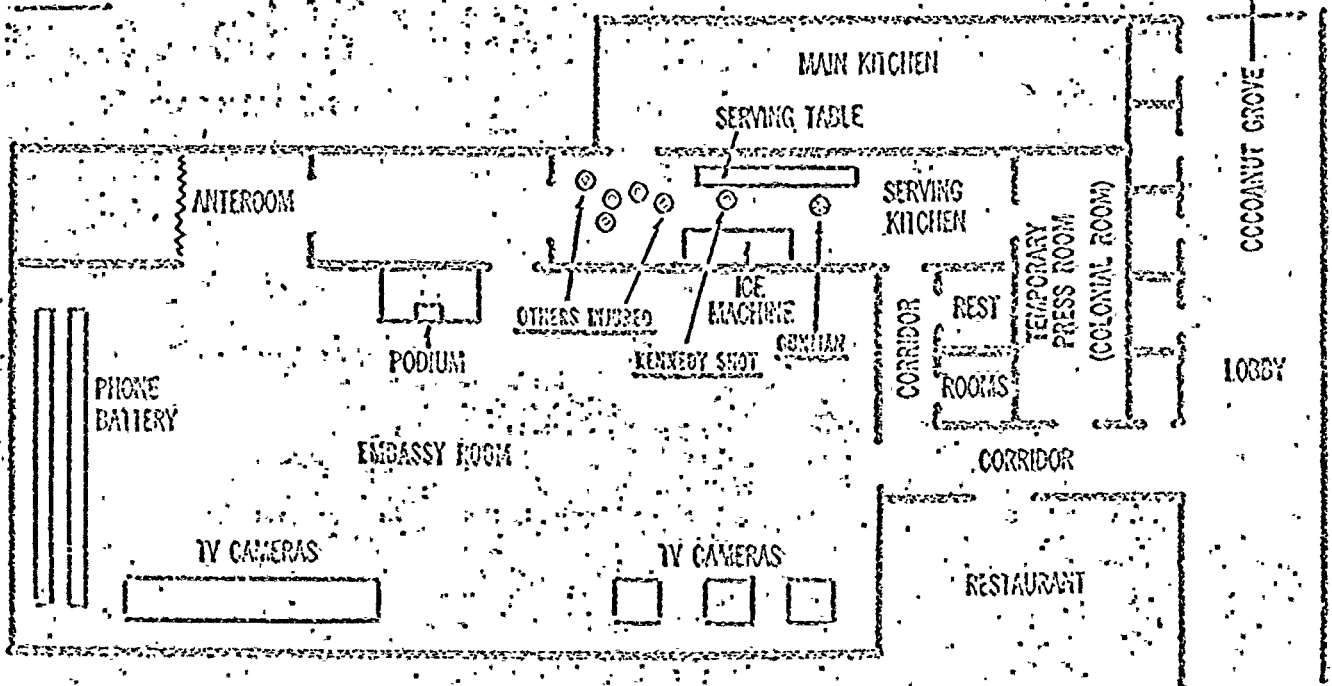


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium of Embassy

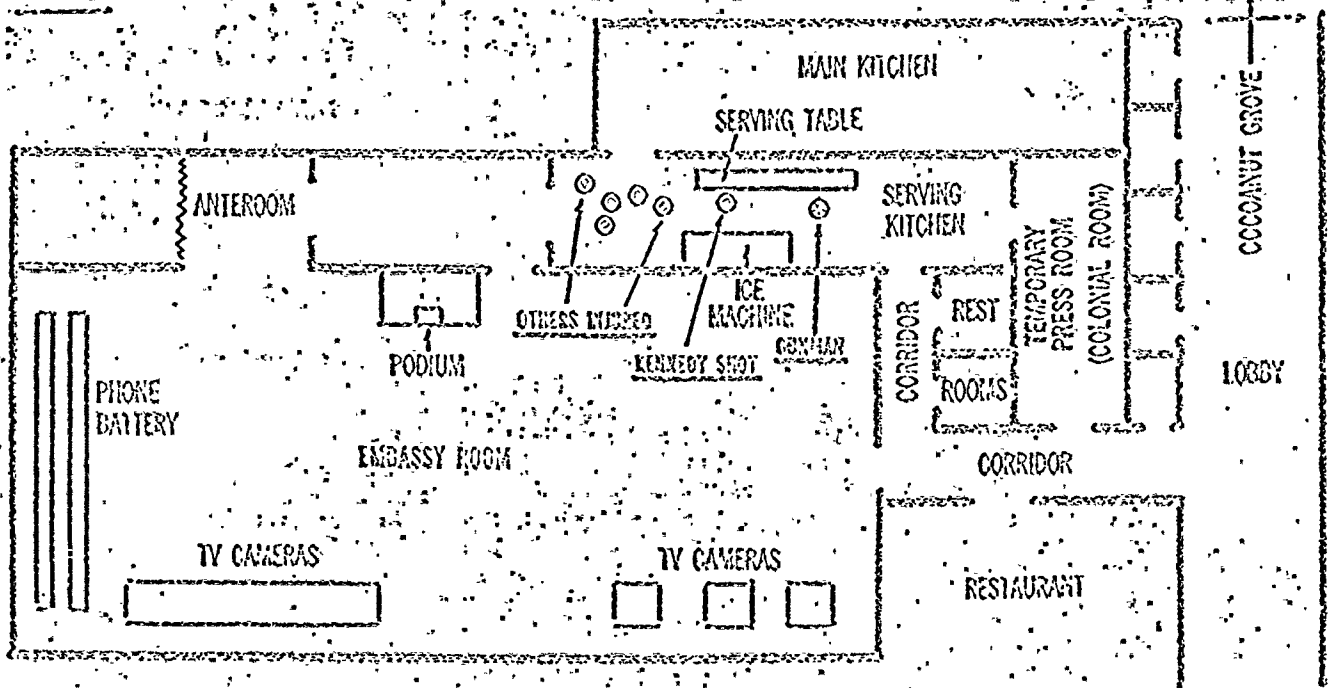


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

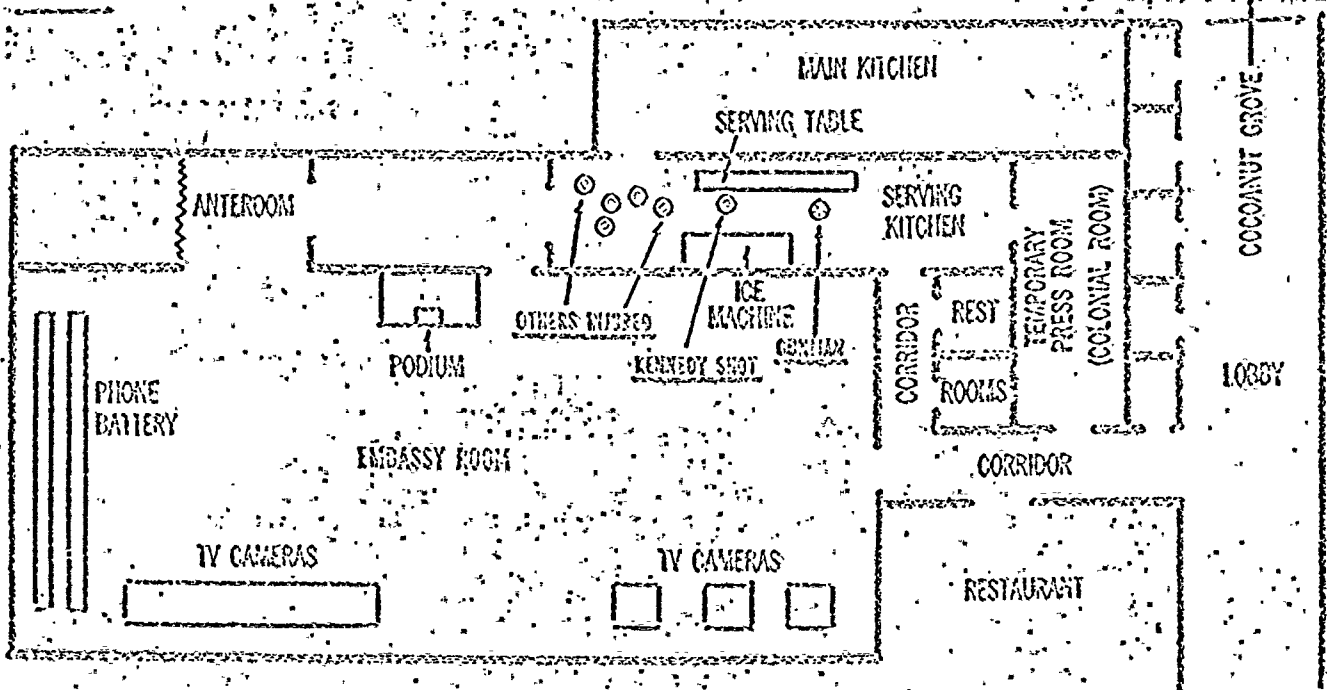


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

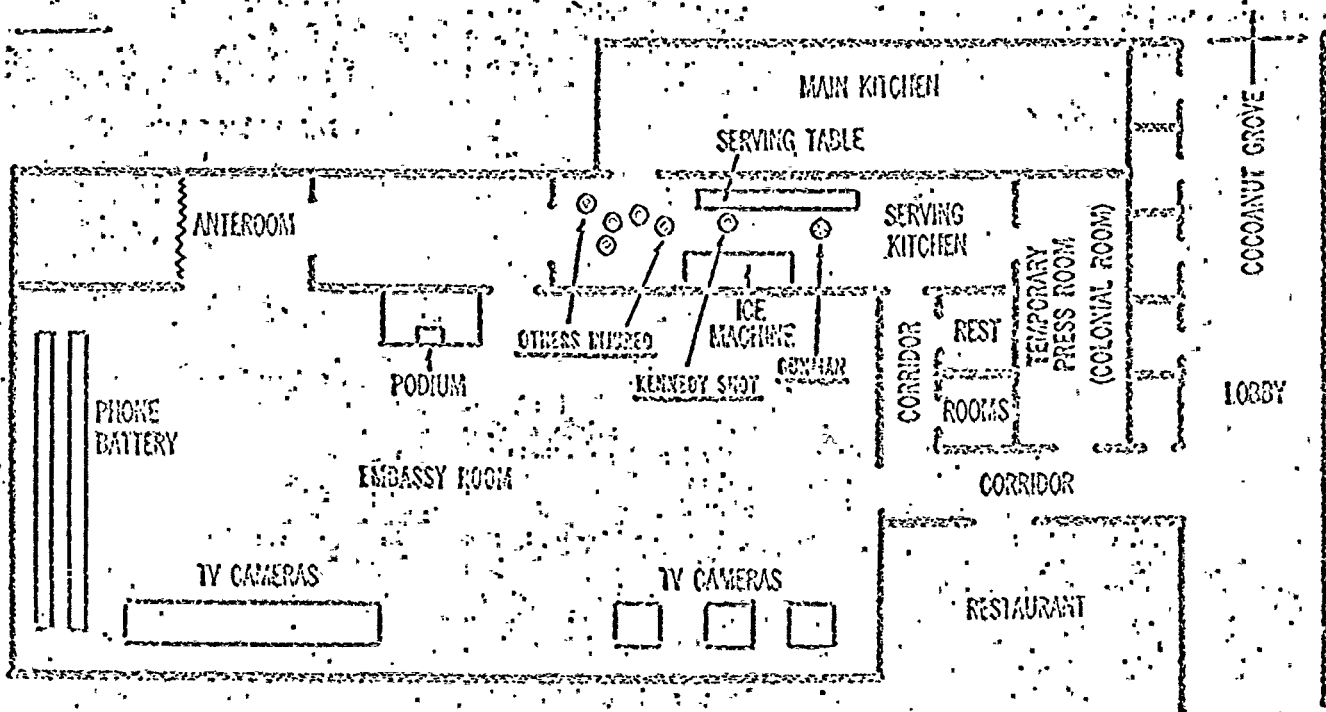


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

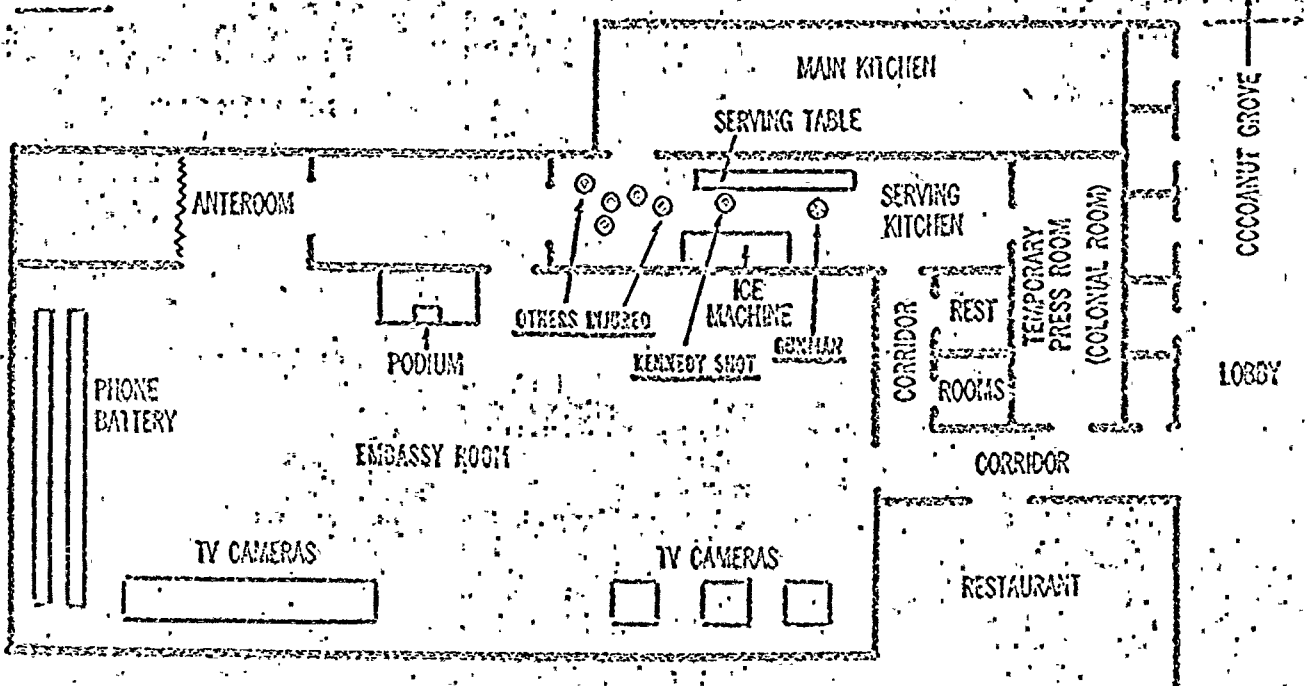


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium of Embassy

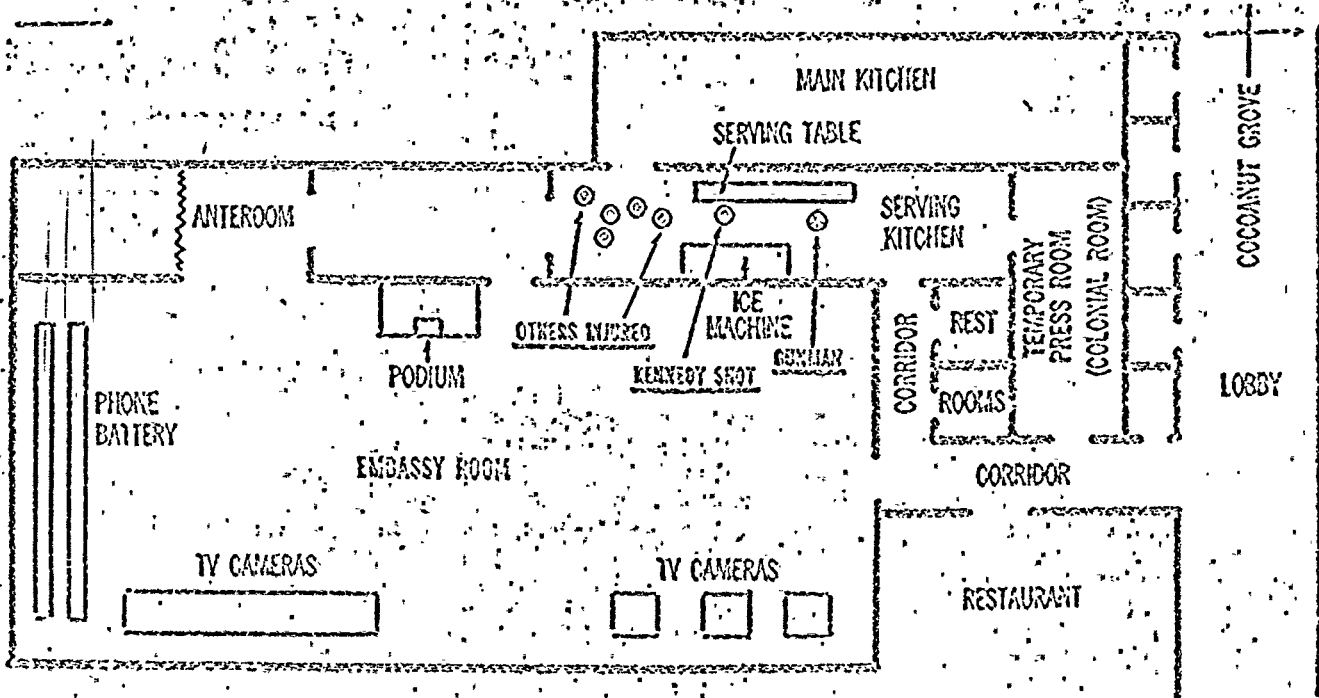


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

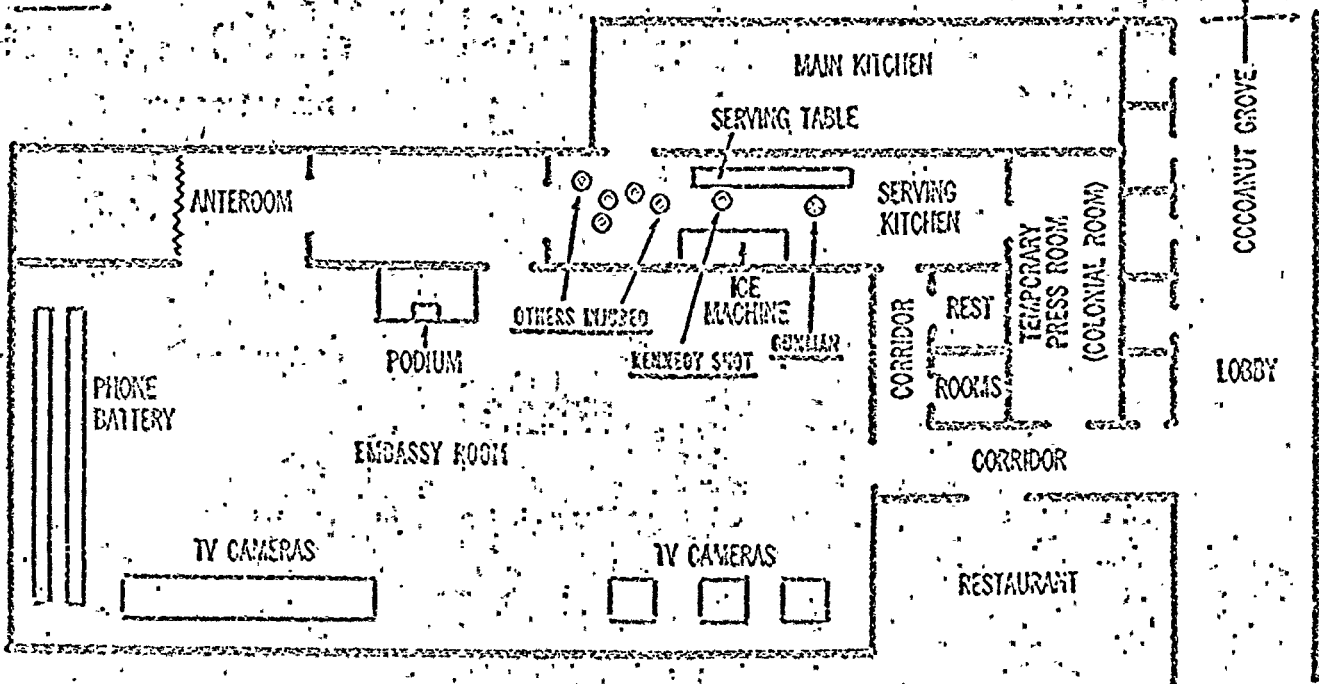


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

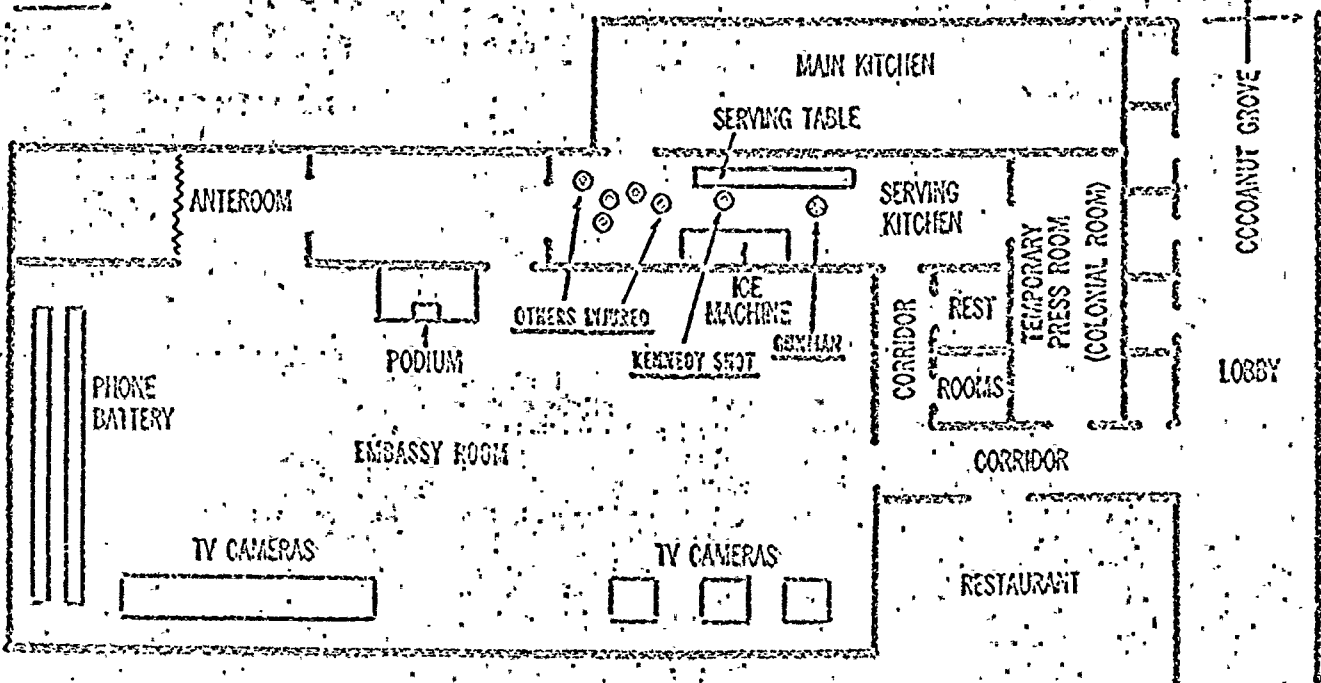


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

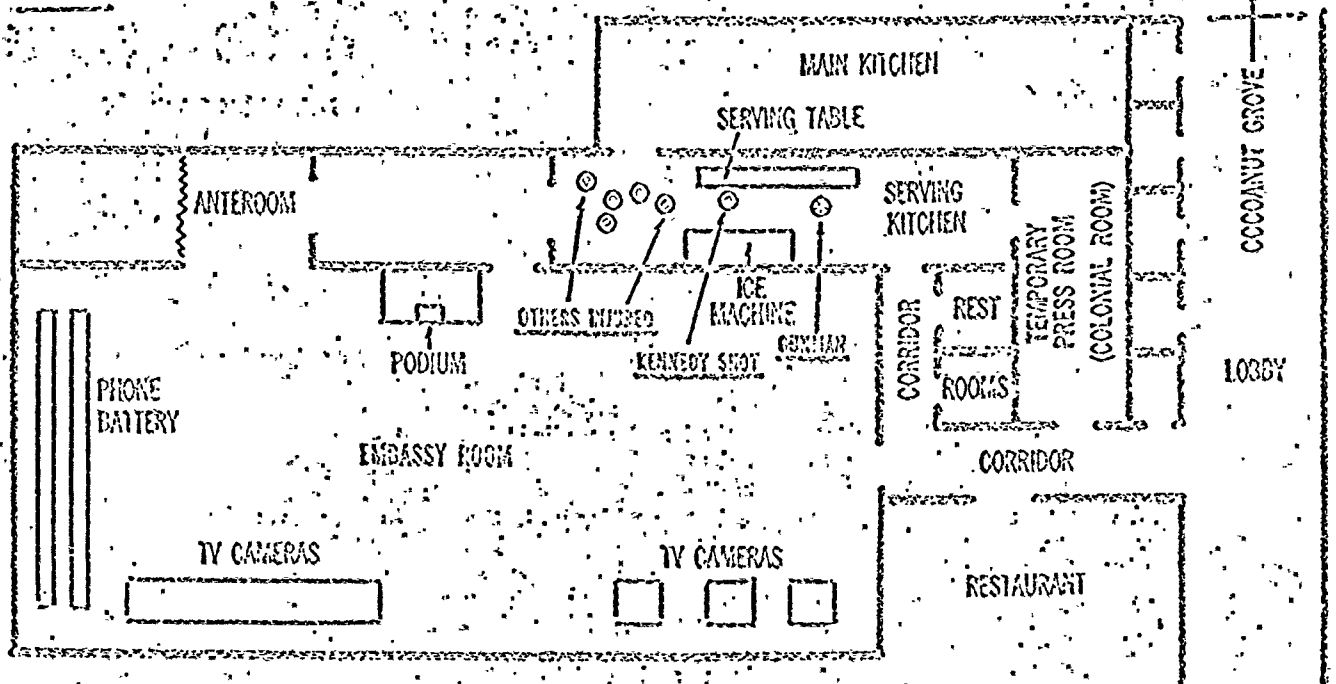


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

FLOYD E. THORNTON, Post Office Box 1073, Coalinga, California, was contacted at his residence, Monterey Avenue, Coalinga, California.

THORNTON advised that he was checked into the Ambassador Hotel, at Los Angeles, California, on the night of June 4, 1968, when the late Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY was shot. He stated that after the shooting, he became aware of all of the excitement as did most of the guests, but he did not know SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, had no recollection of ever having seen him in the hotel on the night of June 4, 1968; and has no information whatsoever concerning a possible conspiracy.

On September 23, 1968, Mr. HARLYN ROBINSON, also known as Mr. W. H. ROBINSON, 1008 Rutledge, Modesto, California was interviewed at Modesto City Hospital, 730 17th Street, Modesto, California, where he is employed as Hospital Administrator. Mr. ROBINSON furnished information as follows:

He registered at the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California at about 8:00 p.m. or 9:00 p.m., June 4, 1968. He was at the hotel to attend a Hospital Administrator's seminar sponsored by the American College of Hospital Administrators. Only after arrival in Los Angeles did he determine that Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY was at the hotel. After checking into his room, Mr. ROBINSON went to the lobby of the hotel and sat in a chair facing the corridor leading to the Embassy Room. The corridor and the lobby were very crowded with people. He sat in the lobby from shortly after his arrival until about 11:30 p.m., June 4, 1968, when he went to his room and went to bed. During the early morning hours, exact time not recalled, he was awakened by a number of persons apparently "running" television cable somewhere outside of his room and outside of the building. He attempted to call the desk, but was unable to get a response. The following morning, at about 8:00 a.m., Mr. ROBINSON walked out of the hotel and attempted to buy a newspaper. He could not locate any. He went back into the hotel and was stopped at the door by two policemen. They asked to see his room key, which he exhibited. He was then allowed to re-enter the hotel. In the hotel, he picked up a newspaper from a table in the coffee shop; only then did he determine that Senator KENNEDY had been shot.

During the aforementioned time, Mr. ROBINSON can recall seeing no one resembling the photographs that he has seen of SIRHAN B. SIRHAN. He has never at any time met, or known SIRHAN B. SIRHAN. During the time that he was in the lobby, he noticed and heard nothing to indicate that Senator KENNEDY would later be shot.
