Re interview of LOWELL J. BEAN, Assistant Professor of Anthropology at California State College, Hayward, California, and Los Angeles airtel to San Francisco, dated 6/13/68.

BEAN interviewed and the following is a summary of the results:

Subject SIRHAN was student in Cultural Anthropology class which he taught at Pasadena City College approximately Spring, 1964. There were many foreign students in the class. He recalls Subject as pleasant, polite, reliable, and a good student except for two emotional outbursts during discussions with other students on the Israeli-Arab Conflict.

At the request of BEAN, Subject gave an informal report to class on Arabic culture. Subject discussed Pan-Arabanism, a joining together of all Arabic nations into a dominant cultural and political block which will become a major political power in the Near East. An American-Jewish student in class either asked Subject a controversial question or made a negative remark about the Arabs involved in the conflict which caused Subject to become very emotional, almost to the point of violence in his defense of the Arabs. The eruption almost became a fist fight before it was stopped by BEAN.

Either after this incident or on another occasion within a short time later, Subject again became involved in a very heated discussion in the hall at school with a student on the Arab-Moslem-Israeli Conflict. He had almost an uncontrollable temper in defense of Arab National Unity.

On two occasions in 1965, after Subject had left Pasadena City College, he stopped in to see BEAN at school and had lunch with him on one visit and dinner with him on the other visit. BEAN was teaching night school during the latter visit. BEAN cannot recall any of their conversation during these two visits. Neither can he recall identity of other student in his class with whom Subject argued, but may be able to identify this student if he saw a roster of the class.

On 6-18-68, Mrs. PHILLIP L. WOOD, 4036 Hurley Court, Toledo, Ohio, telephonically furnished the following information to the Toledo Resident Agency:

Since the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY she has recalled a former Toledo, Ohio resident who had the reputation of being bitterly anti-Semitic and was considered by her to be the most anti-Semitic person she has ever encountered. In view of the fact that this person has now moved to California, she wanted to bring his name to the attention of proper authorities. She has no reason to believe that he is in any manner associated with captioned matter but did feel that he would be the type who would become very emotional about the Israeli-Arab situation.

The person she referred to is MICHAEL WALENTINE, white, male, about 40 years of age, wife - UNANDA, two children, of 250 North Mountain Trail, Sierra Madre, California. As of 1964, this was VALENTINE's address; however, she has had no correspondence with the family since that time. VALENTINE was employed by Sears-Roebuck in Toledo and left this area in 1963 to secure employment with Sears in California.

Subject has an aunt, Mrs. MARY PRINCE, 61 West State Street, Pasadena, California, who should know the current location of the VALENTINE family should this become necessary.



Mrs. KITTY BLAIR. 3327 - 26th Street, San Francisco, California, telephone 282-1891, telephonically advised on 6/17/68 that she/is a reporter on TV Channel 44. She was a guest on the PAT MICHAEL Show on TV Channel 2, KTVU, during the afternoon of 6/17/68, along with JEREMY ETS-HOKIN, a San Francisco businessman. At the end of the show, MICHAEL made a rather explosive statement calling the attention of several local newspeers to his statement. He remarked that the "girl in the polka-dot dress" being sought in the KENNEDY case is an EOC worker at Delano, California. Mrs. BLAIR further recalled that MICHAEL gave the initials of this girl but she was unable to remember the initials stating they may have been "RS".

Shortly after receipt of the above call, Mrs. ELIZABETH HARDING, Daly City, California, who is the subject of a previous memorandum in this case concerning the PAT MICHAEL statements, telephonically advised that she had just listened to the show and also heard MICHAEL's statement about the "girl in the polkadot dress" being located in Delano, California. It was her recollection that he stated the girl was employed by a contract agency for the Federal Government. She further related that officers from the LAPD were now in Delano seeking her, and if she is found "the whole conspiracy will then come to light." According to Mrs. HARDING, she listened to the PAT MICHAEL show on Radio Station KNEW where she heard these statements.

K8, K14, and K16, wrote the hand printed address in the lower portion of page one of Q1; the hand printed address and names "SIRHAN SIRHAN" in the upper portion of page 32 of specimen C1; and the English writing on the front of specimen Q5-F.

The available writing of SIRHAH BISHARA SIRHAH is too limited and not sufficiently comparable with the remaining questioned handwriting on the specimens previously submitted in this matter, for the purpose of determining whether SIRHAH BISHARA SIRHAH wrote any of the remaining questioned handwriting. Similarities in handwriting characteristics were found in the writings of SIRHAH BISHARA SIRHAH and a number of the remaining questioned writings, including certain questioned writings on pages 28, 35, 39, 47, 51, and 53 of specimen Q1; pages 123 and 124 of specimen Q3, and the writing on Q4.

The signatures appearing on K15 are too limited to permit adequate comparison of these signatures with the questioned writings.

Specimen Kla is being returned to FBI, Sen Francisco. Specimens Kla and Kla are being returned to FBI, Los Angeles. These specimens have been photographed. The pamphlet described as "ALSO SUBHITTED" is being retained.

IRVIN S. OLSEN, Complaint Clerk, on 6/5/68, advised that FREDI J. JENNINGS had telephoned this officee on 6/5/68, and advised that she had visited Jordan and Palestine for approximately 4-5 months in 1967, after the Israeli-Arab War. She indicated that she would like to come into the office and furnish information regarding an individual whom she met in Jordan and had seen on two occasions in San Francisco.

Mrs. BOLTEN JENNINGS (FREDI J. JENNINGS), 898 Steiner St., San Francisco, telephone 922-5550, and her girl friend VICTORIA ANGELA FLOUAYEN, same address and telephone number, visited the San Francisco Office in the morning of 6/6/68.

Mrs. JENNINGS advised that she was born 7/1/44 in Champaign, Illinois and that she is a graduate of Maryland University, having graduated in 8/66 and moved to San Francisco in 9/66; is employed part time and takes dancing lessons both at the San Francisco Ballet School, 378 18th Avenue, San Francisco; that her husband is attending the San Francisco Institute of Art and she is Jewish and that her father, name not mentioned, is a scientist employed by NASA, "Greenbelt", Maryland.

Miss VICTORIA ANGELA ELDUAYEN advised that she was born 3/27/45, Orange County, Los Angeles, Calif., is a sophomore attending San Francisco State College, San Francisco, enrolled in the study of the humanities and employed by Toyota Motors Distributors, Ferry Building, San Francisco.

Re AZZAM R. ENNAZAR - (S.F. Indices negative - 6/4/65)

Mrs. JENNINGS and Miss ELDUAYEN were interviewed by SAs STANLEY F. FEWSTER and CHARLES P. MONROE on 6/6/68, and both advised that they were reporting information regarding the above individual due to the fact that he is an Arab; that he had told them many lies when they were in Jordan and that Mrs. JENNINGS

had seen him in San Francisco on two occasions, namely at the end of February of 1968 or the beginning of March, 1968, and again at 4:55 PM, 6/4/68, on 18th Avenue near Geary at Joe's Hamburger Restaurant. Both indicated that they also were furnishing the information due to the fact that they had listened to the news on the radio and on television regarding the assassination of Senator ROBERT KENNEDY, whose assassin was indicated to be SIRHAN SIRHAN.

Mrs. JENNINGS advised that Subject was embarrassed when seen on 6/4/68, as he apparently realized that he had been caught in many lies in their conversations in Jordan. When Mrs. JENNINGS and her friend were questioned about any possible connection between ENNAZAR and SIRHAN SIRHAN, both stated that they had absolutely no evidence or information to indicate any connection between the two and stated that they had no specific information re ENNAZAR and had no reason to assume there was any conspiracy between ENNAZAR and SIRHAN SIRHAN or any other individual.

Mrs. JENNINGS was of the opinion that Arabs never worked independently of each other, having obtained this opinion from residence in Jordan for a period of 4 months in 1967 and gave the impression that she thought that she was an authority.

Mrs. JENNINGS advised that she and her husband and VICTORIA left the U.S. at New York, 8/3/67, at 6:00 PM via Flight 120 on ELAL Airlines for Israel and arrived in Israel, 8/3 or 4/67. She said that they were volunteers who were sponsored by a Jewish agency in San Francisco, who has offices in Washington, D.C., specific name not states, and were placed by the agency in a group to do refugee and rehabilitation work in Mt. Scopus, located approximately one kilometer from the Damascus Gate. They left Israel for the U.S. on 11/20/67.

On arrival in the Holy City, Mrs. JENNINGS said she went shopping during the first week to purchase a dress and was waited upon by a young male named "SAID" in the old city of Jerusalem. Through him she met AZZAM R. ENNAZAR, a resident of Jerusalem, who JENNINGS mentioned going to Amann who was a friend of SAID and whom she claimed was pro-Arab and anti-Israeli. She claimed he was a political activist who had stated that the Americans had won the 1967 Israeli-Arab War.

JENNINGS indicated that she wanted to learn as much as possible about the Arabs in general and therefore attempted to cultivate the Subject and was, therefore, friendly with him for the duration of their stay in the Middle East. Subject reportedly told JENNINGS that he would have to go to the U.S. and secure employment to earn sufficient money to send to his family, place not indicated; that he would attend the University of Texas and would enter the U.S. as a student, but indicated that he had flunked out of high school, it being claimed that he had shown JENNINGS a high school transcript which he claimed that he had forged; that he had no money, however, JENNINGS stated that he was always well dressed in a herringbone suit; that he couldn't obtain a U.S. visa in order to come to the U.S. and, therefore, was going to Italy in 1967.

On leaving Jordan, JENNINGS told the Subject to look them up if he ever visited San Francisco and was advised that he didn't know anyone in San Francisco and was going to Texas. (Note inconsistencies)

JENNINGS advised that she saw the Subject in San Francisco for the first time at the end of February, 1968, at which time he appeared embarrassed and again saw him at 4:55 PM on 6/4/68. On the latter date he appeared tired, with bloodshot eyes and appeared rather unkempt in contrast to his appearance in Jordan. On 6/4/68 he wore sandals, blue jeans and needed a shave and claimed he had been earning \$54 a week from an undisclosed source on Market St. in San Francisco and had been recently fired. He claimed that he was living with a Negro and some Arabs, none of which were identified.

JENNINGS indicated that she was afraid of the Subject as he had once told her he had a fight with his friend SAID and reportedly had cut him with a knife and indicated that if anybody ever crossed him or his friends that they would be harmed.

Miss ELDUAYEN aadvised that at no time during the 4 months that she had known the Subject had he ever made any political statements in her presence.

Both of the above complainants advised that Arabs often visit or congregate at an Arab store operated by an Arab from Jericho, which they identified as being on the southwest corner of Fulton and Fillmore Streets, San Francisco.

Both stated that a considerable amount of anti-Jewish literature had been openly distributed on the San Francisco State Campus in the Spring of 1967, which school they claimed had a large Arab student enrollment. Both stated that violence was never advocated, but described the material as "hate literature". None of the literature was retained by either JENNINGS or ELDUAYEN. The complainants were of the opinion there were three Arab groups in existence in San Francisco, namely, Palestine-Arab organization, United Arab Students Organization or similar names, and an Egyptian Order of Lycottes located near 18th Avenue and Geary Streets, San Francisco, south of Geary.

On 6/18/68, REX NEVINS, Reporter for the Riverside Press-Enterprise, Indio, California, advised that REX WESTERFIELD, Public Relations Director for Western Division, John Birch Society, held a press conference in Indio that afternoon concerning CAESAR CHAVEZ, Director of United Farm Workers Organizing Committee, AFL-CIO, who is in Indio Area attempting to organize grape workers. WESTERFIELD identified various persons connected with CHAVEZ movement as communists or communist sympathizers. He distributed an article entitled "The Grapes", concerning the Delano GrapeStrike, which appeared in the June, 1966, issued of "American Opinion", Page 4. There is a picture in this article of over twenty persons, among whom was SAM KUSHNER, whom WESTERFIELD identified as communist. At press conference, WESTERFIELD pointed to young man in photograph, who was wearing light colored sweater, and commented that "The FBI was investigating this man as SIRHAN SIRHAN." NEVINS compared a newspaper photograph of SIRHAN with picture of man in light colored sweater and said there was close resemblance.

KUSHNER is a member of the Southern California District Communist Party and was active in covering Delano Grape Strike for Daily People's World.
