On 8/22/68, Lieutenant CHARLES HIGBIE, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), advised SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, JR. as follows:

Information has been received from FRANK BURNS, JR., an attorney with offices at 650 South Grand Avenue, Suite 600, Los Angeles, California, concerning JOHN G. CHRISTIAN and former FBI Agent WILLIAM TURNER. HIGBIE explained BURNS is an attorney for JESSE UNRUH, Speaker of the California Assembly. UNRUH received information from one JOHN G. CHRISTIAN, indicating that CHRISTIAN has been collaborating with former FBI Agent WILLIAM TURNER, and both have been interviewing JERRY OWEN, about whom considerable information has previously been reported. According to HIGBIE, CHRISTIAN and TURNER have in their possession tape recorded interviews with OWEN, conducted by TURNER, in which the line of questioning suggests a conspiracy in connection with the assassination of former Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. In part, according to HIGBIE, the tape recording consists of a conversation wherein

TURNER suggests to OWEN that SIRHAN B. SIRHAN could conceivably have considered using OWEN's truck as a "getaway" vehicle following the shooting. CHRISTIAN has furnished a mailing address of Postal Drawer 2850, San Francisco, California.

HIGBIE further stated that CHRISTIAN has sought permission for him and TURNER to be "deputized" to assist the LAPD in the investigation of the shooting of Senator KENNEDY.

The LAPD is conducting investigation to discredit CHRISTIAN and TURNER, since it is obvious they have no factual information in their possession to suggest a conspiracy.

The Los Angeles Division will continue to follow this aspect of the investigation and keep the Bureau appropriately advised.

Based on limited data available, no information can be located in Los Angeles indices identifiable with JOHN G. CHRISTIAN.

Foregoing is for information and a copy is being sent to San Francisco since it appears CHRISTIAN and/or TURNER are currently within that division's territory. In addition, both TURNER and CHRISTIAN are in contact with GEORGE DAVIS, Attorney for OWEN, as previously reported by Los Angeles.

GARY MICHAEL PARIZEK, 1299 California Street, San Francisco, California, furnished the following information on 8/30/68:

On Sunday, June 2, 1968, about 1:00 or 2:00 P.M., a female acquaintance, KASS LITZENBERG, 1537 Lardner Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, called him on the telephone. During the course of conversation she mentioned she had either heard something on the radio or some rumor predicting that some political figure was going to be killed. No mention was made as to the identity of the political figure or when the killing was to occur. What she said was very vague and PARIZEK didn't pay much attention to it at the time. Two days later when Senator ROBERT KENNEDY was killed, he recalled the conversation and wondered about it. In a subsequent telephone conversation with LITZENBERG she referred to her previous conversation in regard to the prediction that a political figure was to be killed, and made a remark to the effect that she guessed whatever the rumor was she had heard must have been correct.

SUBJECT: KENSALT

On September 3, 1968, Mr. JAMES E. SMITH called this office and advised that he had just returned from Australia and had learned through a friend that the FBI in Los Angeles had indicated an interest in talking with him, regarding the above-captioned matter. SMITH stated that he holds dual citizenship in the United States and Australia and at the time of the assassination he was working for the campaign of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. He advised that he did not witness the actual shooting and at the approximate time of the assassination he was just about to enter the Ambassador Hotel.

According to SMITH, he determined that the FBI was interested in talking with him from a female acquaintance of his, Miss JOAN HULL of Los Angeles, California, who has already been questioned by the FBI. SMITH said that he did not know SIRHAN SIRHAN and did not believe he could furnish any information concerning the assassination, however, he indicated he wanted to cooperate with the FBI in any way he could.

At the present time he is residing at the Fox Plaza, Room 2715, San Francisco, telephone number 621-9848. He is currently unemployed.

Referenced airtel and letterhead memorandum from Dallas indicate the gathering and departure from Dallas of some 34 persons associated with the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) en route to Mexico City aboard American Airlines Flight 53 on 8/26/68. The group, according to information available, was en route to Cuba. Included in the group was THOMAS GOOD of San Jose, California.

THOMAS DANIEL GOOD, of 22 South Eleventh Street, San Jose, California, was one of the individuals who was located and interviewed in connection with the Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY assassination on 6/5/68, inasmuch as he had been a long-time acquaintance of SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, who is currently being held for trial in connection with the murder of Senator KENNEDY. GOOD is also acquainted with WALTER CROWE, a member of the Southern California District Communist Party (SCDCP), who has also been in contact with SIRHAN as a school acquaintance.

The Bureau is requested to have Legat, Mexico, furnish all possible information concerning THOMAS DANIEL GOOD's trip to Mexico City and possibly Cuba. Bureau sources concerning Cuba should also be alerted.

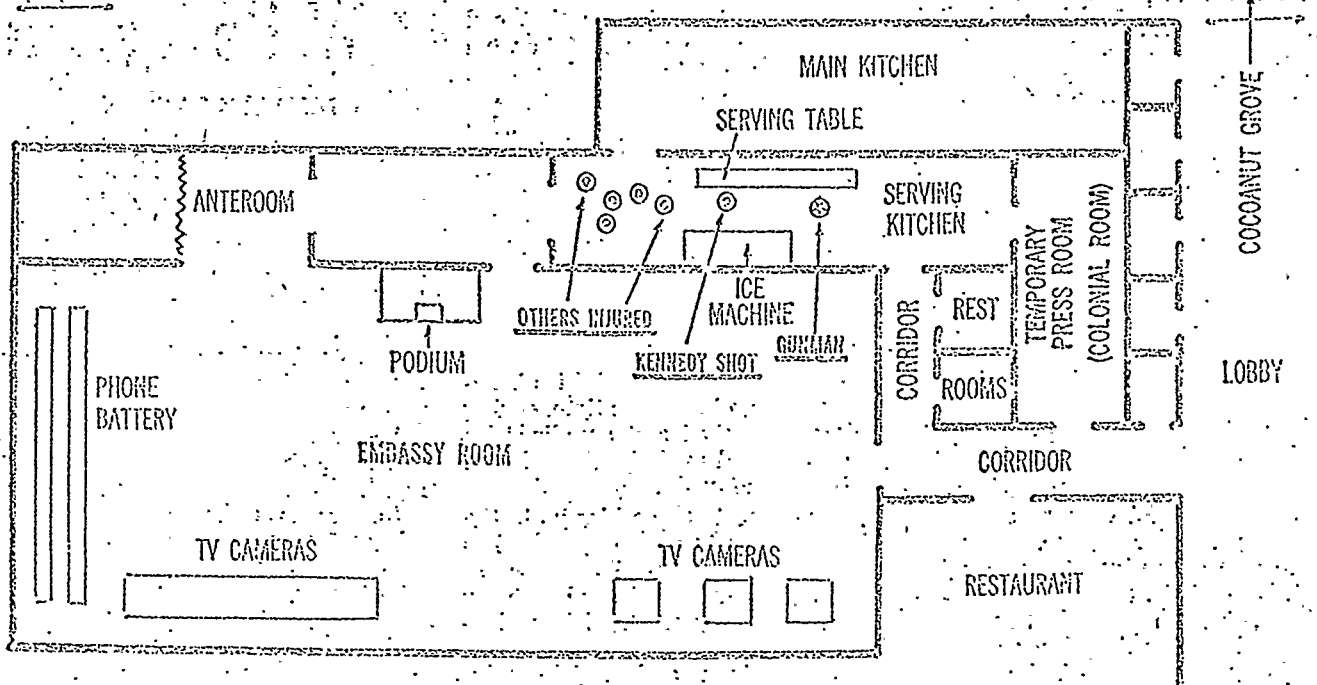


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

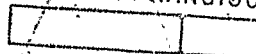

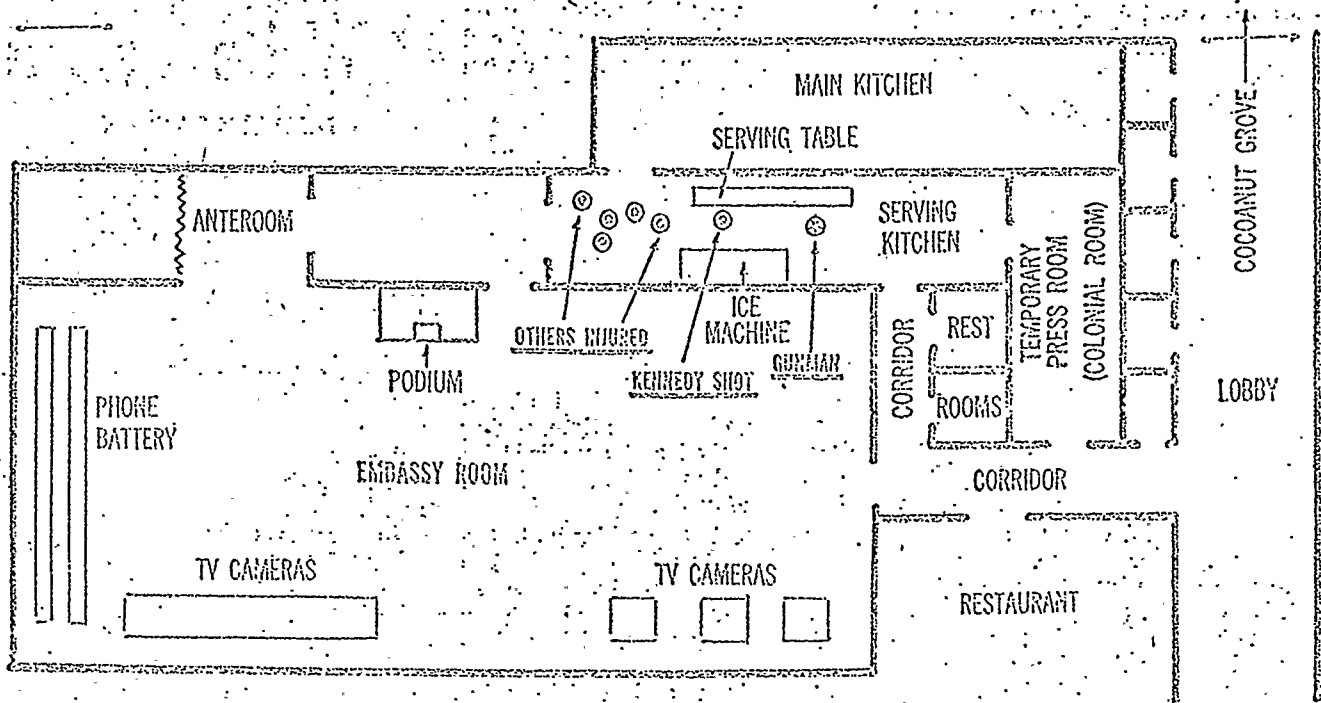


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

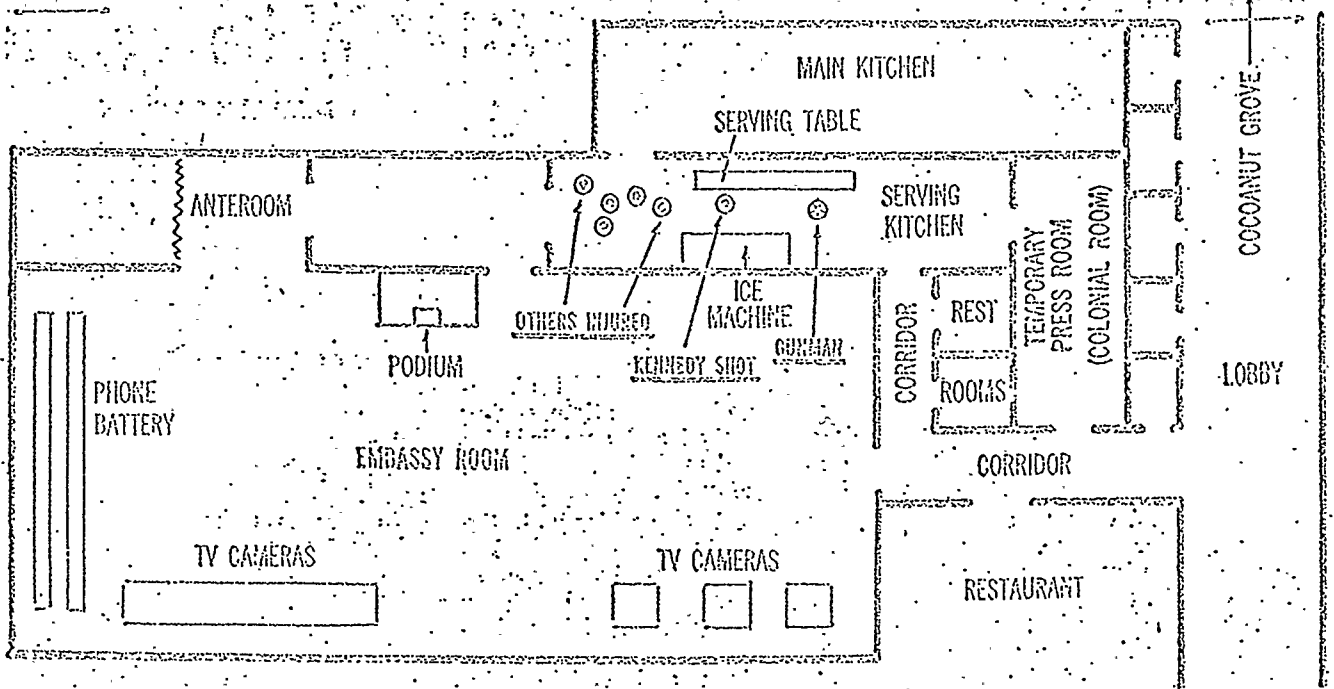


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

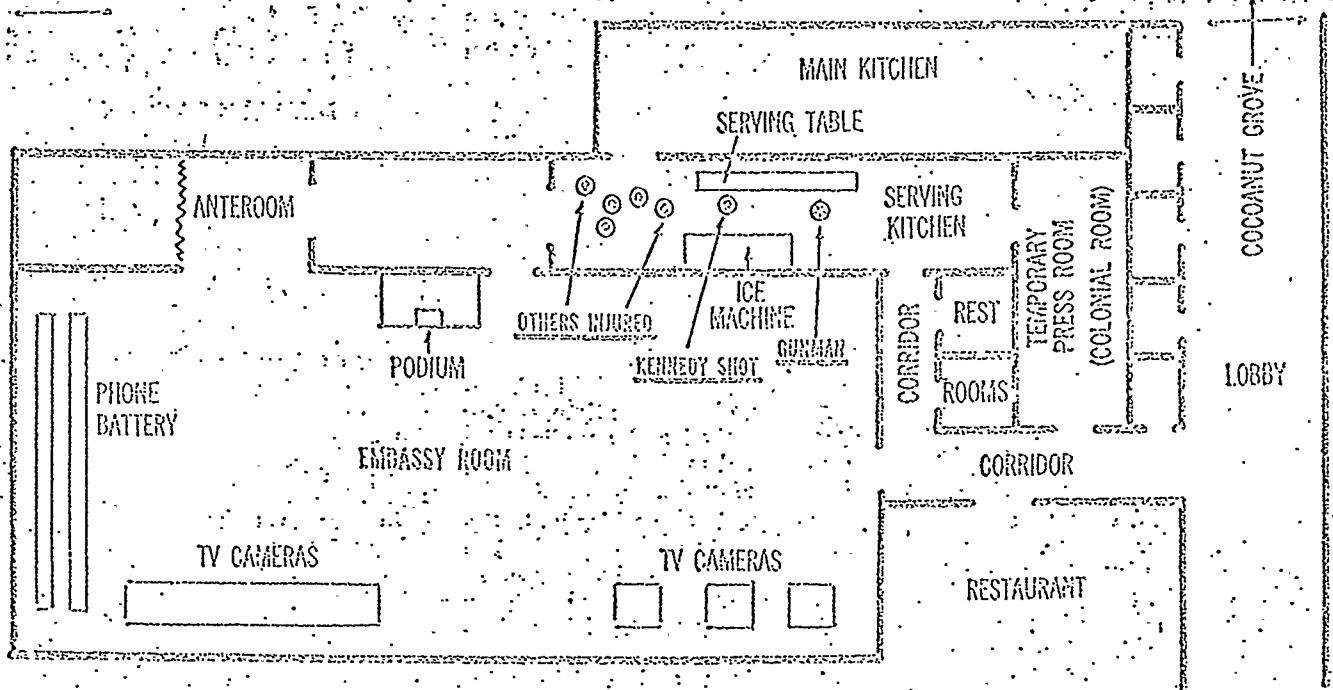


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

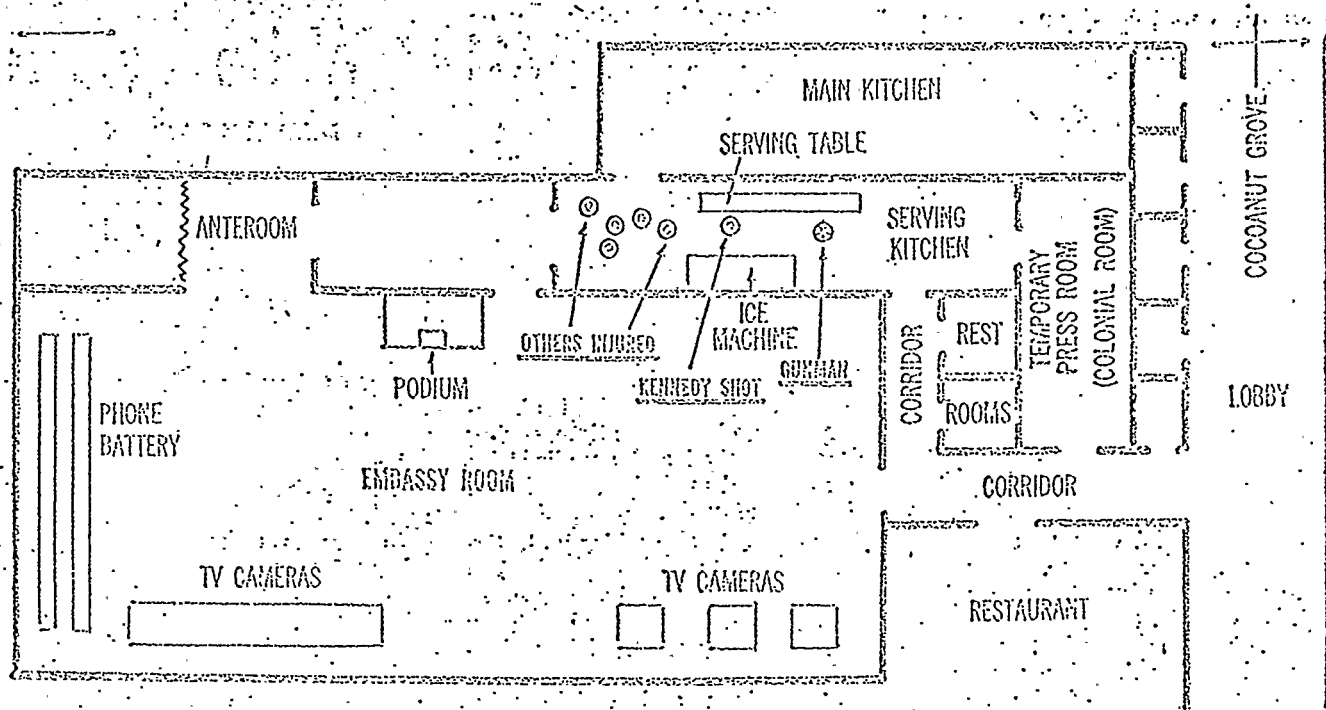


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

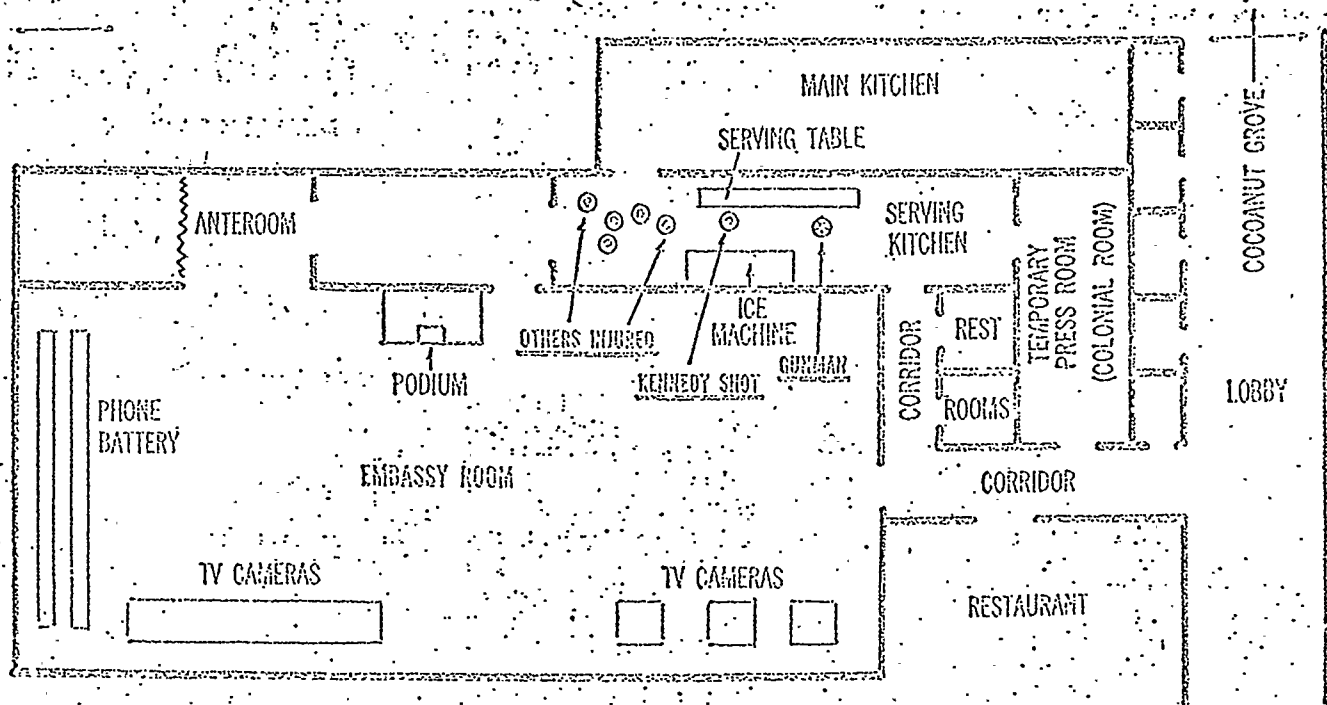


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

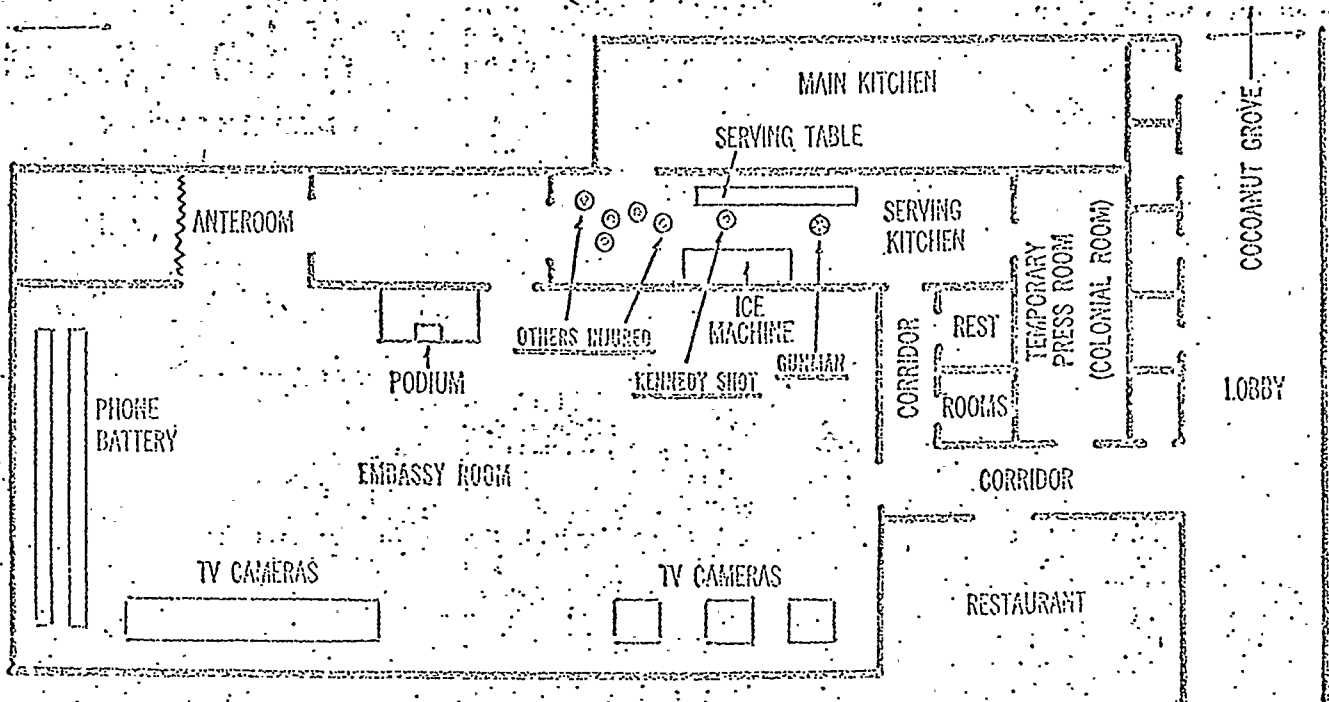


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

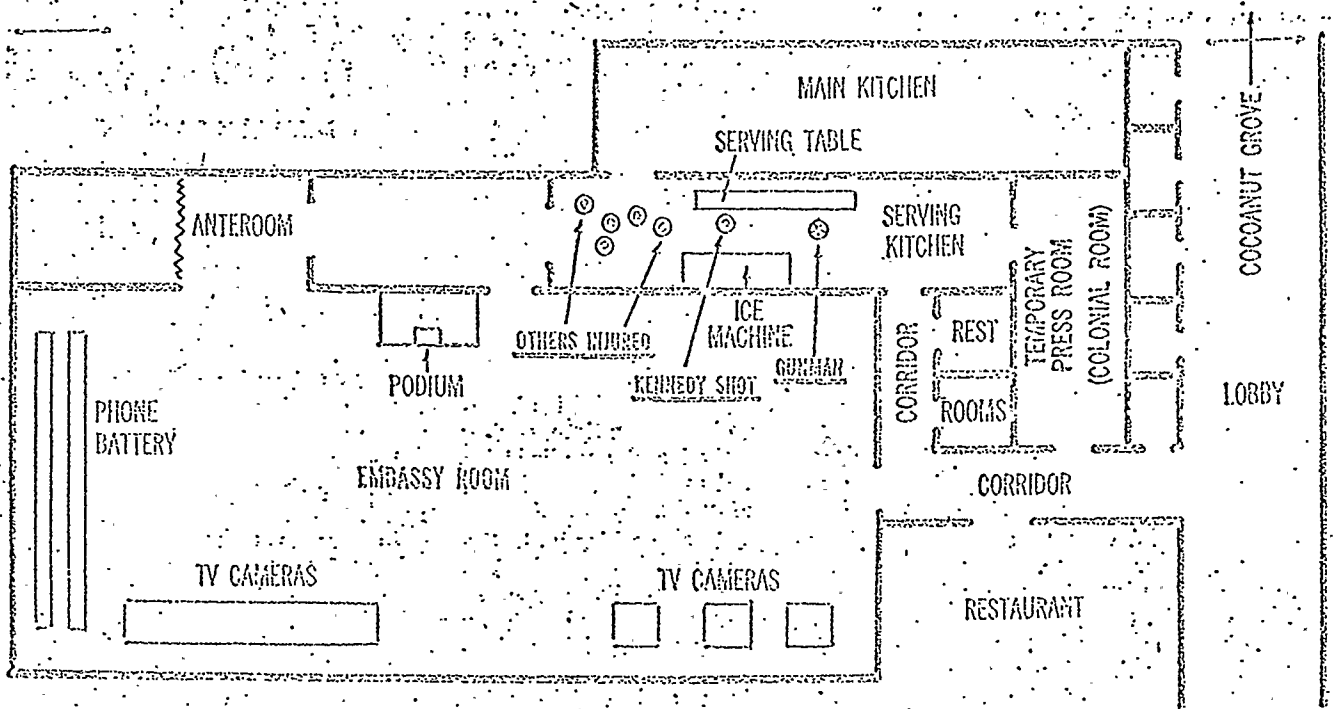


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

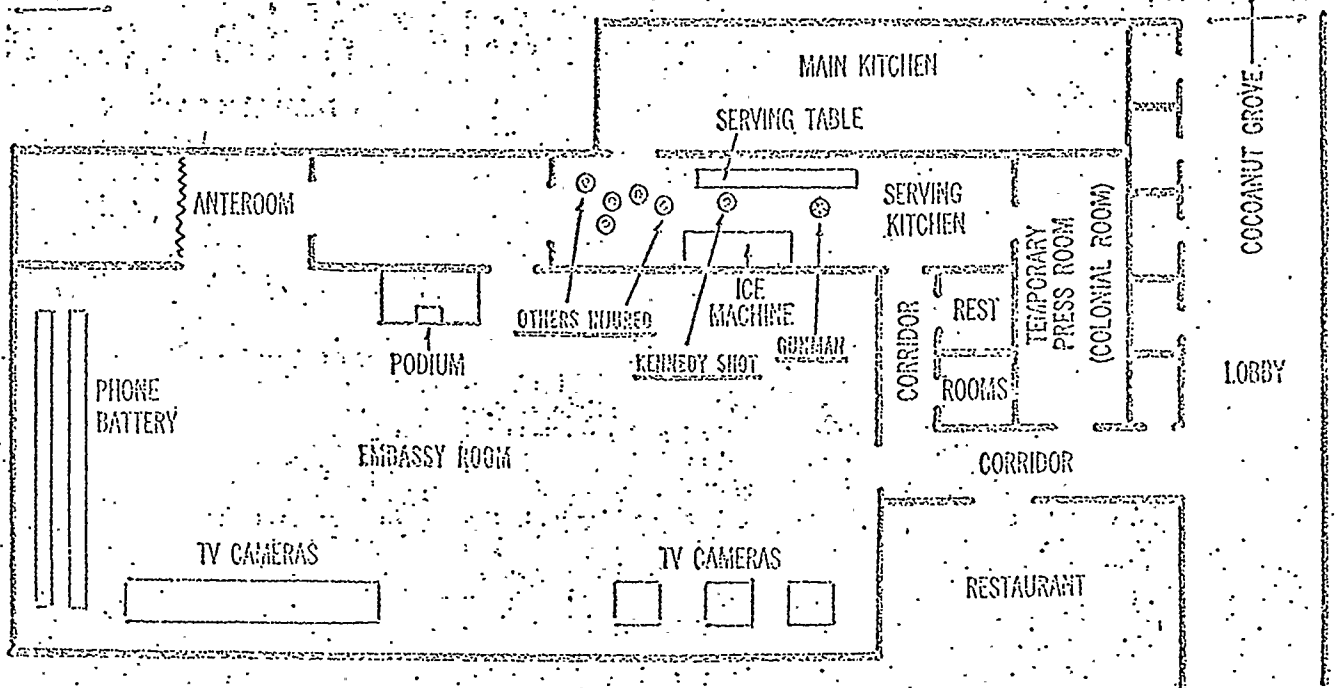


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

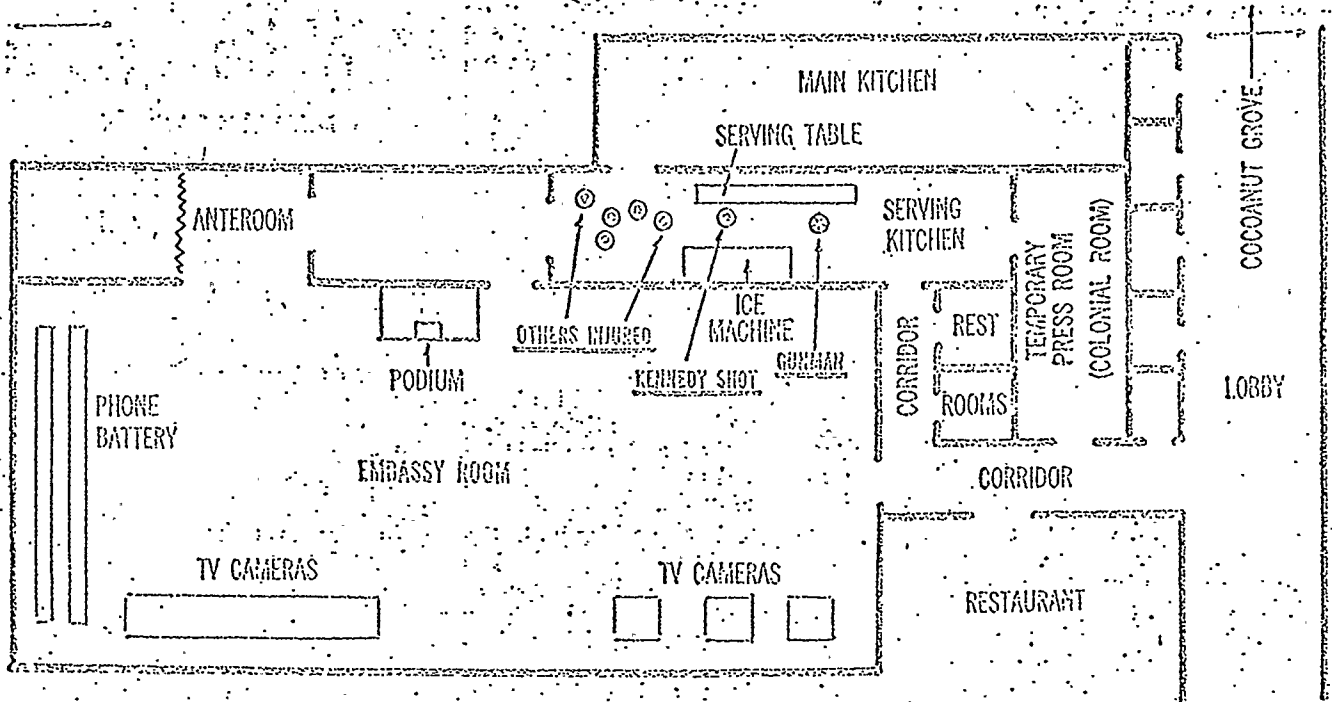


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

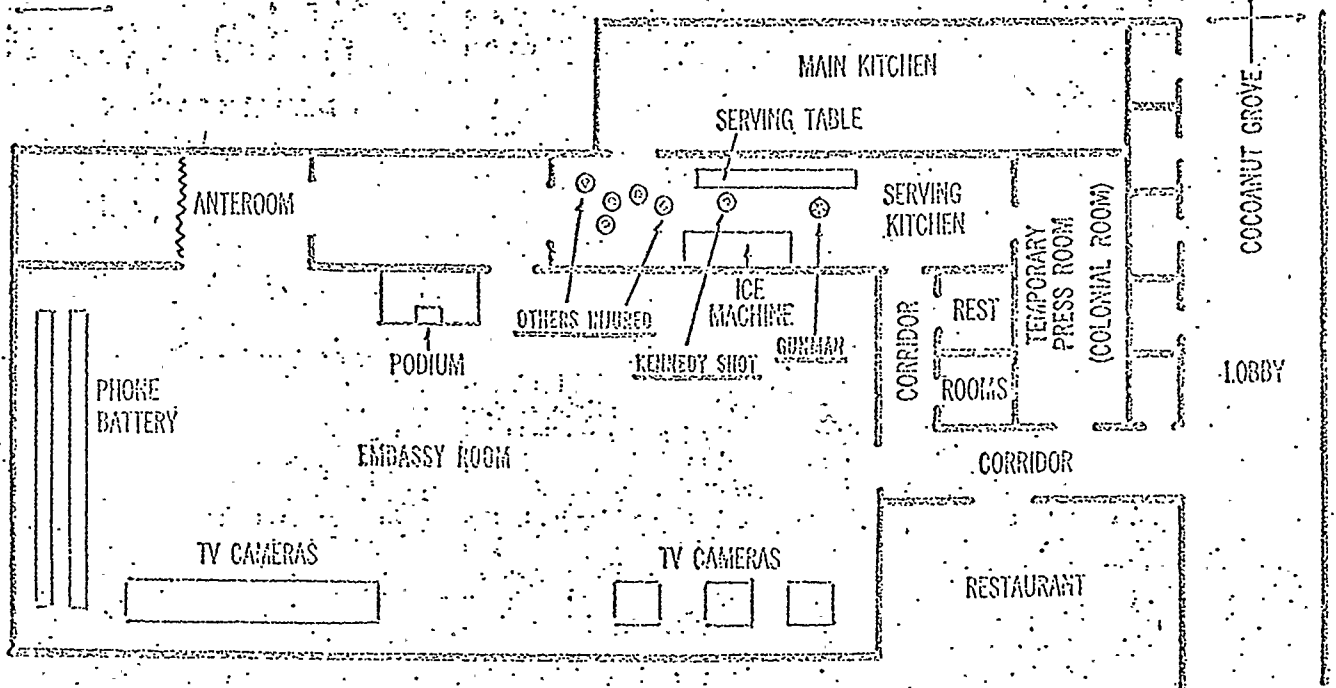


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

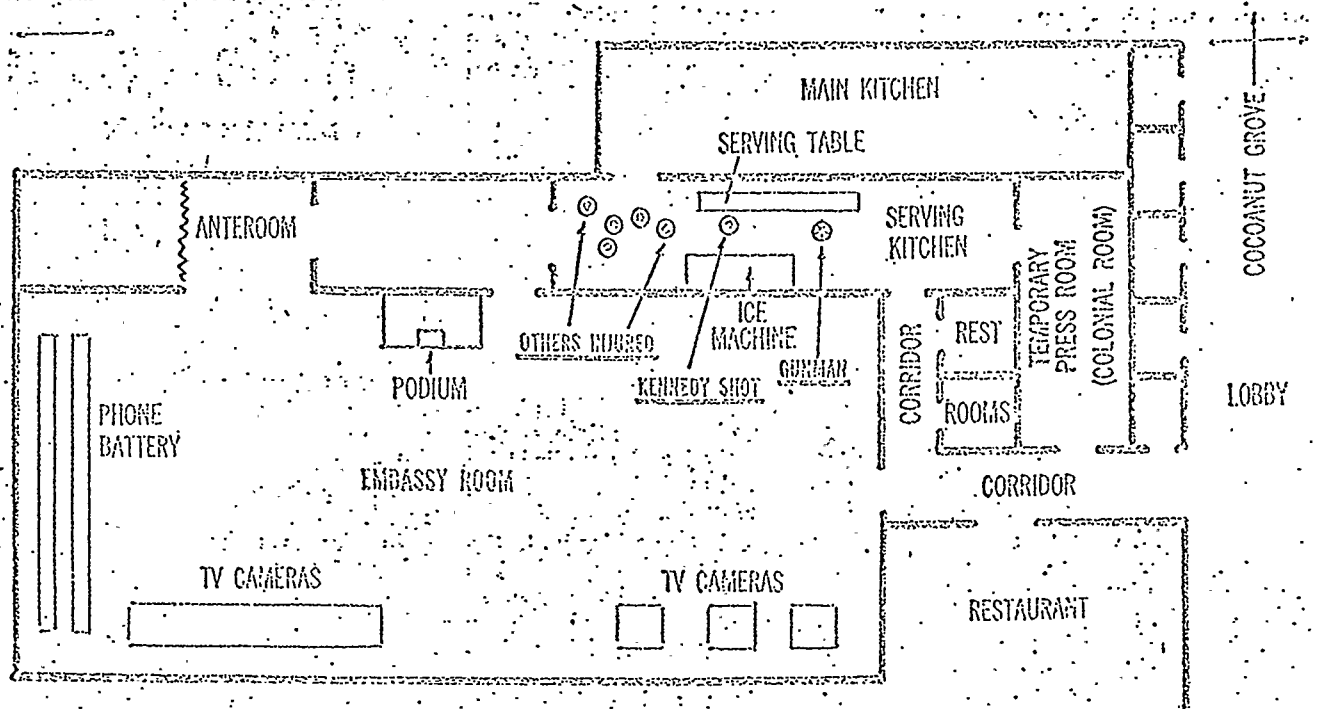


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

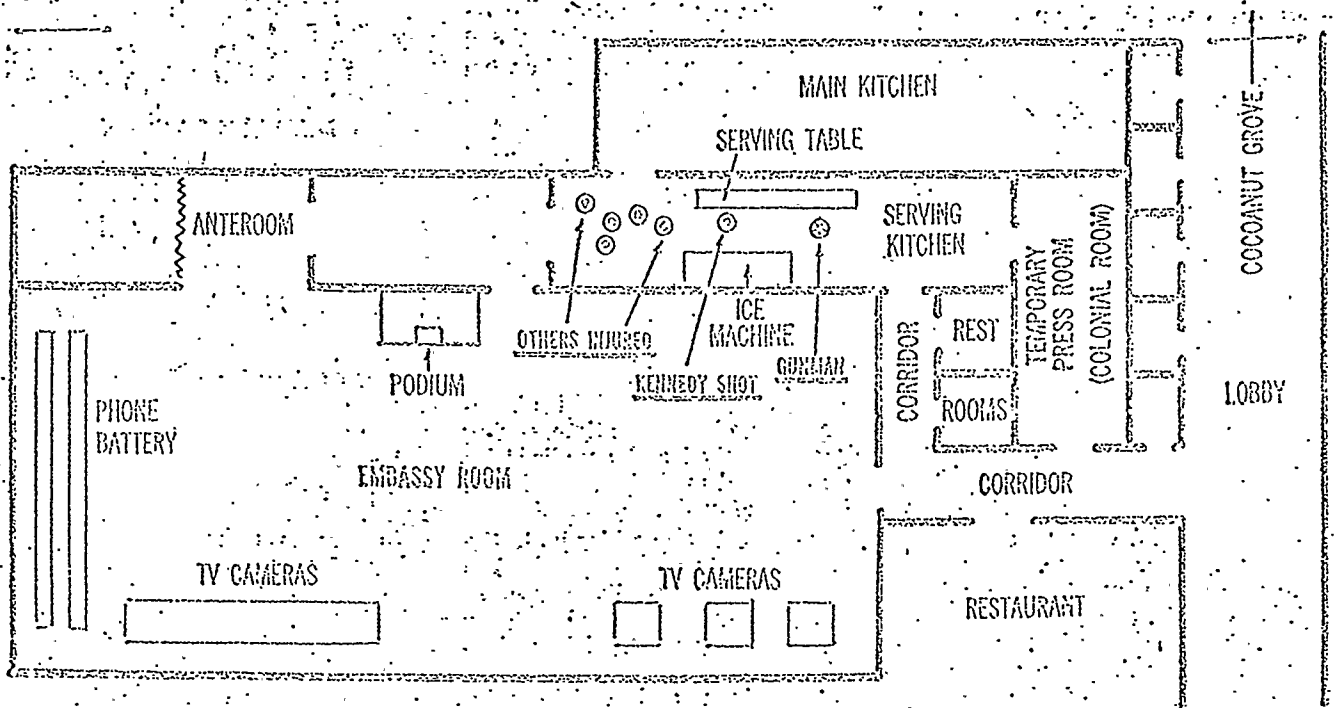


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

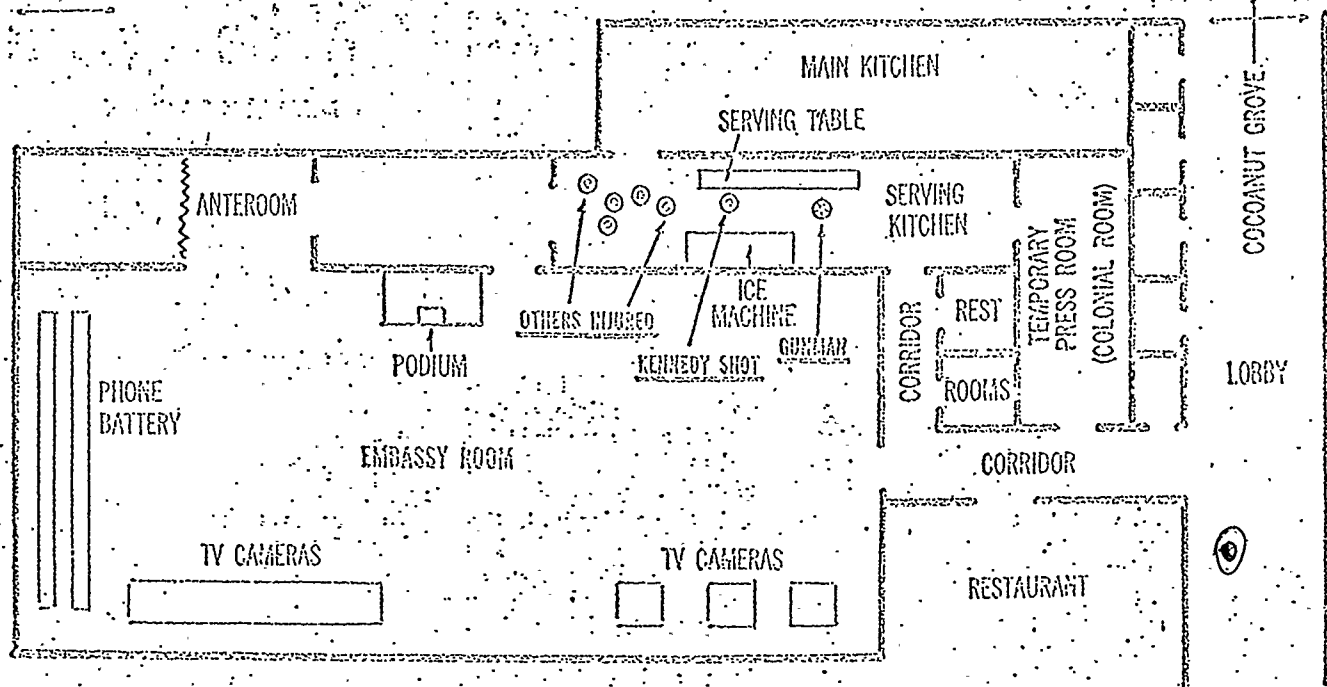


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy
