


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embossy




DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind pedium at Embossy




DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE-Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embossy





DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind pedium at Embessy





DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE-Sketch shows the doors leading from behind pedium at Embessy
