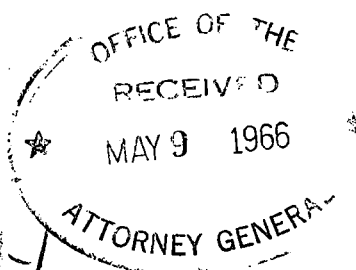

TUSCALOOSA, Ala., March 20.  
—The first confrontation between

One dime was used by Nicholas

torney general, to telephone Pres-

of Sept. 3, 1962.

As a result of that call, the  
President ordered 16,000 federal

James Meredith.

Sen. Kennedy, then attorney  
general, was at his brother's side
