



Kennedy Dixie Trip: Story of Dimes

TUSCALOOSA, Ala., March 20. -The first confrontation between Sen, Robert Kennedy, D., N.Y., and the students of Alabama and Mississippi might be called "The Story of Two Dimes."

One dime was used by Nicholas deB. Katzenbach, the present attorney general, to telephone President John F. Kennedy from a pay station on the campus of the University of Mississippi after an elaborate military communications system broke down on the night of Sept. 3, 1962-

As a result of that call, the President ordered 16,000 federal troops and National Guardsmen to the Ole Miss campus before dawn to quell a bloody desegregation riot precipitated by the entrance of the first Negro student, James Meredith.

Sen. Kennedy, then attorney general, was at his brother's side in the White House cabinet room while the line to the Oxford campus was kept open all night. By morning, two men were dead and
