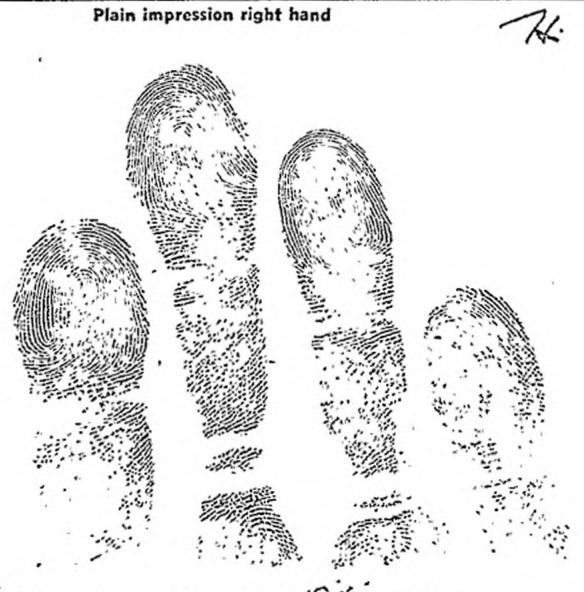

This detail was received by the undersigned officer at approximately 9:15PM this date. After receiving the detail I recontacted the informant by phone to obtain further information concerning the case.

The informant stated that the above suspect is an ex-boyfriend of her sister, Mary Pearl BENNETT FW 20. In July of this year her sister stopped going with the suspect after a two year courtship. The suspect was very upset when the BENNETT girl broke up with him. Shortly after this the suspect reportedly attempted to commit suicide.

On several occasions since that date the suspect has annoyed the BENNETT family by making phone calls, writing letters etc.

On 12-6-63 the informant found her car damaged. Some unknown suspect cut the gas line leading to the carburetor. On 12-10-63 the same thing occurred. Today she got in her car and started to drive away, after moving a short distance she applied her brake and found that she had no brake pedal at all. She managed to stop the car short of striking anything by using the handbrake.

When she called her father he came to the scene and had a nearby garage pick up the car for service. When the garage mechanic checked the brake system he found that some one had cut the metal tubing that leads to the rear brakes, permitting the brake fluid to drain out of the vehicle.

All three of these incidents occurred in the general area of Pasadena City College where the informant is a student. The suspect knows the informants car and is familiar with the areas that she parks it.

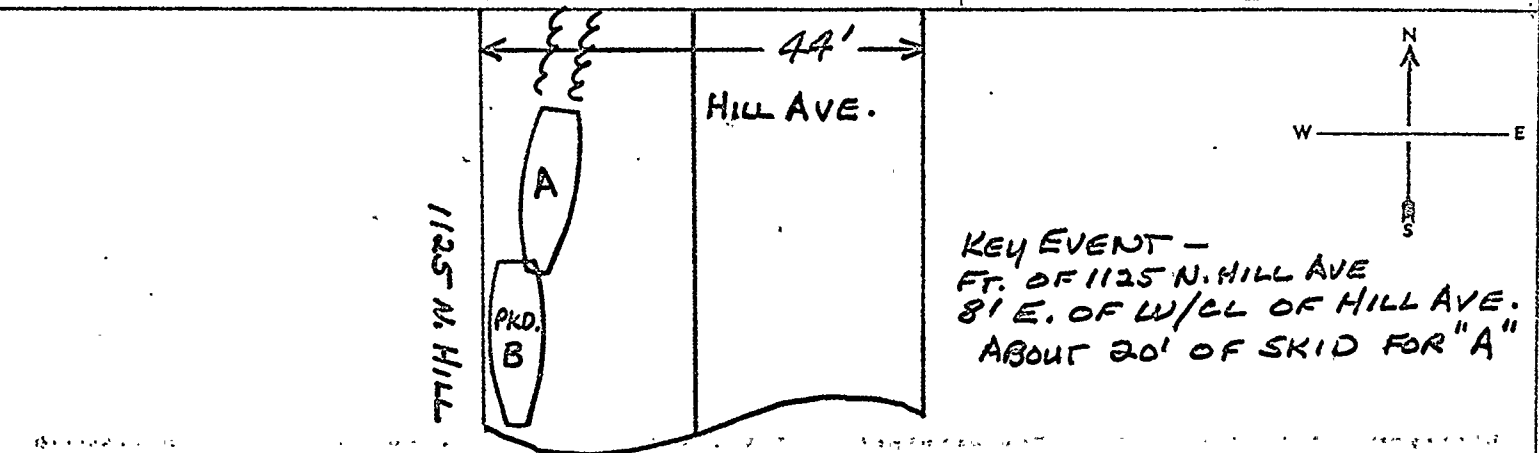

FURTHERMORE, THE MISSING MINOR HAD RECENTLY BEEN CLOSELY ASSOCIATED WITH PASADENA RESIDENTS, INCLUDING: TERRY BLACK, MW, 16; JOE SCOTT, MW, 16; WILLIE MCANALLY, MW, 16; MUNIR SIRHAN, MW, 17; AND AN ADULT, "LOIS" JOINER, FW, 19. A VEHICLE DESCRIPTION WAS ALSO INCLUDED, A GREY SEDAN WITH THE WORDS, "PASADENA INDEPENDENT," ON THE DOOR PANELS, AND THE VEHICLE WAS CONSIDERED TO BE THE MISSING GIRL'S MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION.

ACTION ON THE INFORMATION, INVESTIGATORS DAGUE AND COREY DISCOVERED THAT THE VEHICLE WAS SIMILAR IN DESCRIPTION TO ONE DRIVEN BY JOE SCOTT, YOUNGER BROTHER OF "LOIS" JOINER. SAID OFFICERS CONTACTED MRS. JOINER AT HER HOME AND QUESTIONED HER IN REGARD TO THE WHEREABOUTS OF THE MISSING GIRL. MRS. JOINER EMPHATICALLY DENIED KNOWLEDGE OF THE MISSING PARTY, CLAIMING THAT SHE DIDN'T KNOW THE GIRL NOR HAD SHE SEEN ANYONE OF THAT PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION ON THE DATE CONCERNED. LOIS JOINER, WHO DROVE THE VEHICLE USED FOR TRANSPORTING DEBORAH SPRAGUE TO PASADENA FROM WEST COVINA; TERRY BLACK, WHO ENCOURAGED THE AFFAIR AND ARRANGED FOR MRS. JOINER TO ACT AS TRANSPORTATION AND TEMPORARY "KEEPER;" WILLIE MCANALLY, WHO AIDED TERRY BLACK AND WAS PRESENT ON 10-30-64, 3:00AM, WHEN MRS. JOINER DROVE TO WEST COVINA FOR THE PURPOSE OF PICKING UP DEBORAH SPRAGUE. FURTHERMORE, MR. AND MRS. SPRAGUE COMPLAINED THAT THEY HAD PERSONALLY CALLED MRS. JOINER AND PLEADED WITH HER TO REVEAL DEBORAH'S WHEREABOUTS AND MRS. JOINER RESPONDED, "DEBORAH WHO? I DON'T KNOW ANY DEBORAH SPRAGUE." THE SAID CALL TOOK PLACE DURING THE MORNING OF 10-30-64 AND BOTH MR. AND MRS. SPRAGUE WITNESSED MRS. JOINER'S RESPONSE.

DUE TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES, THE UNDERSIGNED MADE PERSONAL CONTACT WITH DEBORAH MARLENE SPRAGUE, IN THE COMPANY OF HER PARENTS, AT 426 NORTH OAK AVENUE, PASADENA, THE HOME OF THE RELATIVE RESPONSIBLE FOR FINDING DEBORAH.

DEBORAH WAS UNWILLING TO RELATE ANY CIRCUMSTANCES CONCERNING HER WHEREABOUTS DURING HER ABSENCE FROM HOME. HOWEVER, THROUGH INDIRECT QUESTIONING, VIA MRS. SPRAGUE, DEBORAH ADMITTED THAT MRS. DEBORAH RELATED THAT THE ARRANGEMENTS HAD BEEN MADE A WEEK PRIOR TO THE INCIDENT BY TERRY BLACK. ACCORDING TO DEBORAH, BLACK ASKED MRS. JOINER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AFFAIR AND MRS. JOINER, AWARE OF RUNAWAY SITUATION, CONSENTED TO DRIVE THE CAR.

DEBORAH EXPLAINED THAT AFTER BEING PICKED UP NEAR HER HOME, SHE WAS DRIVEN BY MRS. JOINER TO THE JOINER HOME, 1016 NORTH EL MOLINO AVENUE, PASADENA, WHERE SHE STAYED UNTIL ABOUT 8:00AM, 10-30-64. IT WAS AT THAT TIME, AND DATE, ACCORDING TO DEBORAH, THAT HER MOTHER, MRS. SPRAGUE, CALLED THE JOINER HOME AND HAD CONVERSATION WITH MRS. JOINER ABOUT DEBORAH'S WHEREABOUTS. DEBORAH WAS A FEW FEET FROM MRS. JOINER WHEN JOINER MADE THE STATEMENT TO MRS. SPRAGUE CONCERNING NOT KNOWING A GIRL BY THE NAME OF DEBORAH SPRAGUE. THE FEAR OF POLICE INVOLVEMENT ENCOURAGED DEBORAH TO LEAVE THE JOINER HOME AND MAKE A TELEPHONE CALL TO HER PARENTS. (THE CALL INVOLVED DEBORAH'S DEMANDS FOR GREATER FREEDOM AT HOME, MORE DATING AND DATING OF BOYS SHE DESIRED NOT THOSE ACCEPTED BY HER PARENTS.) WHEN THE CALL FAILED TO MEET DEBORAH'S APPROVAL, SHE HUNG UP THE RECEIVER AND SOUGHT ASSISTANCE FROM ANOTHER FRIEND, SUE ERIS, 1200 BLOCK BREESE AVENUE, PASADENA. HE HAD HIS HIGH BEAMS ON & FAILED TO DIM THEM WHEN I REQUESTED HIM TO DO SO BY BLINKING THOSE ON THE PATROL VEH. SUB. THEN TURNED N. ON WESLEY AND I SWUNG A "U" ON WASHINGTON AND WENT N/B ON WESLEY BEHIND THE SUB. VEH. I TURNED ON MY RED LIGHT AND THE SUB. REFUSED TO STOP. CONCLUSION: APPARENTLY THIS COLLISION OCCURRED AS DRIVER "A" SIRHAN LOST CONTROL OF HIS VEHICLE WHILE TURNING LEFT FROM HOWARD ST. TO HILL AVE. AT AN UNSAFE SPEED AND CRASHED INTO THE CURB AND JUMPED SAME AND STRUCK A TREE IN THE PARKWAY. SIRHAN WAS APPARENTLY ATTEMPTING TO EVADE APPREHENSION BY THE C.O.P. OFFICERS WHO WERE IN DIRECT PURSUIT.

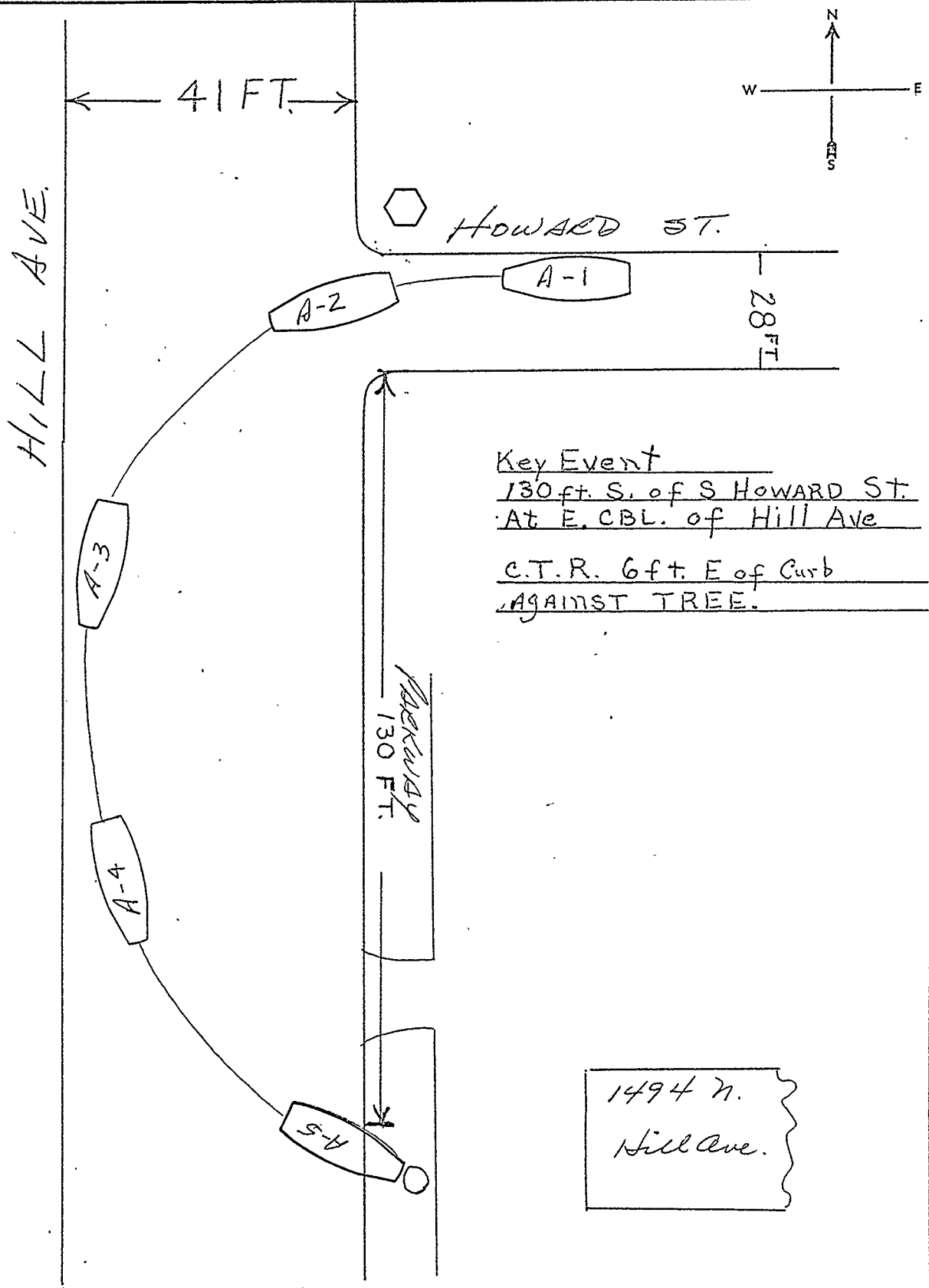

Upon my arrival at the above location I contacted GREEN, and she related the following: At approx. 12:10 PM this date GREEN was standing in front of her home, when she heard the sound of breaking glass. GREEN then observed SIRHAN standing on the sidewalk in front of 1250 N. Sierra Bonita. Upon investigating GREEN found ROACH in the house at that location.

I contacted SIRHAN who stated that he, and ROACH were on their way to school when ROACH wanted to go into the "Haunted house". SIRHAN stated that he did not want to go with ROACH so he waited for him on the sidewalk.

I contacted ROACH who stated that "All the kids at school told him the house was haunted, and that no-one lived there". ROACH stated that he found an open window, and climbed in. As he entered the building his foot struck a panel of glass in a bookcase door breaking it.

I again contacted GREEN, and she stated that it is very common for children to enter the building.

At this time I had SIRHAN return to school, and I accompanied ROACH home. I contacted MC REYNOLDS who is ROACH'S grandmother, and I advised her of the incident. MC REYNOLDS stated that she would see that ROACH did not enter the house again, and that she would take the necessary disciplinary action.

It is my opinion that this building should be inspected by the Building Department, and the Fire Department, as there are several open windows that juveniles could climb in.

It is also my opinion that no follow-up action need be taken towards ROACH, and SIRHAN due to their co-operative attitude, and the attitude of MC REYNOLDS.
