On arrival, contacted the above complainant. He advised that he had purchased the above residence approximately two months ago. Since that time, he has had constant trouble with the above suspects, who rent the first floor. He stated that he asked the suspects to move in one month as he planned on moving into the ground floor for health purposes. Further, that the suspects park in an area on the grounds that he is trying to clean up and that he has asked them not to park there any longer. The suspects continue to park in the area.

After talking to the informant, I contacted the suspects. They advised that they rented the apartment approximately four years ago and at that time, were advised by the previous owners to park in this area. They further stated that they could not understand the feelings of the new owner as they had never had trouble before.

After talking with both parties, I found that the suspects are in the process of buying a home, but that it is not out of escrow and will not be for two to three weeks. At this time, they stated that they would be more than happy to leave. It was agreed by both parties, that the suspect would continue to live in the residence for two or three more weeks and would continue to park in the area.

It was found that the suspects were most co-operative and by no means appeared to be people who would cause any disturbance. It is felt that the situation is mutually acceptable to both parties for the time being & no further action was felt necessary

[REDACTED] STATED THAT HE HAD REMOVED THE PHOTOGRAPHS FROM THE CAR OF A FRIEND OF HIS [REDACTED] THAT HE HAD KNOWN THE [REDACTED] BROTHERS FOR SOME TIME, AND HAD RIDDEN IN [REDACTED]S CAR ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON, AND AT THAT TIME HAD LEFT HIS NEWSPAPER ROUTE BOOK IN THE CAR. WHEN HE RETURNED TO [REDACTED] HOUSE TO PICK UP HIS BOOK, HE SAW THE PHOTO'S AND REMOVED THEM AT THE SAME TIME. THAT HE AND [REDACTED] HAD TRIED TO RE-PRODUCE THEM, RUN OUT OF CHEMICALS, AND HAD TAKEN HIS BROTHERS CAR WITH-OUT PERMISSION TO GO TO A DRUG STORE FOR MORE CHEMICALS. WHILE DOING SO HE HAD THE ACCIDENT (CASE# 390461).

WE QUESTIONED [REDACTED] AS TO HOW HE HAD OBTAINED THE PHOTOGRAPHS, HE STATED THAT SOME TIME BACK A FRIEND OF HIS WAS BURGLARIZING CARS, HE HAD GIVEN THE PHOTOGRAPHS TO [REDACTED] WHEN IT APPEARED THAT HE WAS GOING TO BE CAUGHT. [REDACTED] AT FIRST REFUSED TO IDENTIFY THIS "FRIEND", BUT LATER SAID IT WAS [REDACTED] WHO HE BELIEVES IS PRESENTLY IN CUSTODY IN SOME JUVENILE DETENTION LOCATION. THE ABOVE CONVERSATION TOOK PLACE IN THE PRESENCE OF [REDACTED] MOTHER. IT WAS APPARENT TO THESE OFFICERS THAT [REDACTED] VERSION WAS NOT TRUE, BUT IN HIS MOTHERS PRESENCE HE WAS RELUCTANT TO TALK AT LENGTH.

IT WAS LEARNED TODAY THAT [REDACTED] WAS BEATEN BY [REDACTED] AT 10:30PM ON 11-12-63 PRESUMABLY AS A RESULT OF THE AFORE MENTIONED EVENTS. THIS INCIDENT WAS NOT REPORTED FORMALLY TO THE POLICE BY THE VICTIM, BUT BY [REDACTED] SISTER.

SO FAR AS THIS OFFICE CAN DETERMINE THIS INCIDENT INVOLVES ONLY JUVENILES AS MENTIONED IN THE REPORT, THEREFORE THE MATTER IS REFERRED TO JUVENILE BUREAU FOR ADDITIONAL FOLLOW-UP. IT WOULD BE VICE BUREAU'S RECOMMENDATION THAT ALL SUSPECTS LISTED BE CITED TO THE JUVENILE BUREAU TO RESOLVE THE MATTERS OF POSSIBLE STOLEN BICYCLES, THEFT OR BURGLARY OF THE CIGARETTES, REPRODUCING AND DISPLAYING LEWD PHOTOGRAPHS, AND THE ALLEGED BEATING OF [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] invited the officers in and when entry was made, policewoman McIntyre went into the bedroom where subject [REDACTED] stated that two females would be found. Upon entry into the bedroom, the policewoman found one girl under the bed & one in the closet.

Subject [REDACTED] stated that he was living at this address with his uncle Robert GREEN and that his true parents lived in Phoenix Arizona. An attempt was made to contact the parents of [REDACTED] via telephone, but it was not successful. An attempt was also made to contact the uncle of [REDACTED], but this also met with negative results.

In view of the age of the subjects involved and the total lack of supervision, all of the subjects were transported to the Pasadena Police Department in an effort to contact the parents of the subjects involved.
