ON 12-26-64, 5:00PM, PW AGNES COSTELLO DISCOVERED A NEWSPAPER ARTICLE REVEALING THAT A MRS. COLIN JOINER HAD GIVEN BIRTH TO A CHILD ON 12-25-64 AT THE HUNTINGTON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, 100 CONGRESS STREET, PASADENA. SAID INFORMATION AROUSED THE INTEREST OF COSTELLO AND THE UNDERSIGNED DUE TO THE CURRENT INVESTIGATION BY THE PPD CONCERNING THE REAL MRS. JOINER AND TWO MISSING JUVENILES, SIRHAN AND MCANNALY.

ON 12-26-64, ABOUT 7:30PM, MISS ALLEN, NIGHT NURSING SUPERVISOR AT THE SAID HOSPITAL, WAS CONTACTED. MISS ALLEN, UNDER FIRST OBLIGATION TO HER POSITION, REFUSED TO ALLOW THE UNDERSIGNED TO SEE OR SPEAK WITH THE PATIENT KNOWN AS MRS. JOINER, BUT DID ARRANGE FOR THE UNDERSIGNED TO INTERCEPT THE VISITING HUSBAND AFTER VISITING HOURS. FURTHERMORE, MISS ALLEN SUPPLIED THE ADMITTANCE INFORMATION OFFERED BY THE JOINER COUPLE AND SAID INFORMATION INDICATED THAT MRS. JOINER WAS 17 YEARS OLD, RESIDING AT 1016 NORTH EL MOLINO AVENUE, PASADENA.

AT 8:10PM, 12-26-64, COLIN JOINER WAS OBSERVED LEAVING THE PATIO EXIT OF THE MATERNITY WARD, HMH. HE WAS CONTACTED AND QUESTIONED CONCERNING THE REPORTED INFORMATION.

JOINER ADMITTED THAT THE PATIENT USING HIS WIFE'S NAME WAS ANN MCANNALY AND THAT HE HAD REGISTERED HER UNDER HIS WIFE'S IDENTITY SO HE COULD COVER THE COST OF THE BIRTH. JOINER EMPHATICALLY DENIED BEING THE FATHER OF THE NEW CHILD, CLAIMING THAT HE IS INCAPABLE OF FATHERING ANY CHILDREN.

MISS ALLEN WAS RECONTACTED AND INFORMED OF THE SITUATION. SHE WILL MAKE THE NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS.

BEFORE CONCLUDING THE INVESTIGATION, COLIN JOINER WAS ADVISED THAT HE HAD BETTER MAKE VOLUNTARY STEPS TO CORRECT THE IDENTIFICATION AND ADDRESS INFORMATION ON THE ADMISSION FORMS. HE STATED THAT HE WOULD COMPLY WITH THE ADVICE.

ON 5-5-65, ABOUT 4:00PM, VIA A TELEPHONE CONVERSATION, THE UNDERSIGNED RECEIVED INFORMATION FROM MRS. LOIS MARLENE JOINER REVEALING THAT THE NAMED MISSING JUVENILES WERE CURRENTLY LIVING AND WORKING IN TEMPE, ARIZONA. MRS. JOINER STATED THAT THE MINORS WERE WORKING IN A PACKING PLANT COMPLEX CALLED THE "SHEDS." SHE CLAIMED THAT HER INFORMATION WAS TRUE BUT ALSO MAINTAINED THAT SHE COULD NOT OFFER ANY FURTHER PERTINENT FACTS, SUCH AS, THE YOUTHS' PRESENT PLACE OF RESIDENCE, ETC.

IN RESPONSE TO THE INFORMATION, A TELETYPE MESSAGE WAS INITIATED REQUESTING THE TEMPE, ARIZONA, PD TO INVESTIGATE THE INFORMATION. THE MESSAGE REQUESTED THAT SIRHAN, IF CONTACTED, BE DETAINED AND THAT ONLY INFORMATION CONCERNING MCANNALY BE FORWARDED. THE MESSAGE EXPLAINED THAT THE MCANNALY FAMILY NO LONGER RESIDED IN PASADENA.

MRS. SIRHAN, MOTHER OF MISSING SIRHAN, WAS CONTACTED AND INFORMED OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES. SHE STATED THAT SHE COULD NOT PERSONALLY TRANSPORT HER SON, IF HE IS FOUND, BUT SHE WILL PROVIDE FINANCING FOR HIRED TRANSPORTATION.

FURTHER ACTION SUSPENDED PENDING THE RESULTS OF THE TEMPE PD INVESTIGATION.

NOTE: MRS. JOINER, WHEN ASKED, INDICATED THAT SHE WAS CALLING FROM TEMPE, ARIZONA. THE UNDERSIGNED, WHEN ANSWERING THE TELEPHONE, HEARD THE OPERATOR STATE, "GO AHEAD, THIS IS YOUR PARTY," A PHRASE USUALLY USED IN LONG DISTANCE CALLS.







SUSPECT SIRHAN WAS INTERROGATED BY THE UNDERSIGNED, INV. DUVALL AND MR. ROBINSON. SIRHAN STATED THAT HE WAS EN ROUTE TO PASADENA CITY COLLEGE TO CONTACT A FRIEND TO WHOM HE OWED \$6, TO REPAY THE MONEY. THAT HE WAS COUNTING THE MONEY AS HE WALKED ALONG THE STREET AND A DIME HAD ROLLED OUT INTO THE STREET UNDER THE BENNETT VEHICLE. SIRHAN READILY ADMITTED THAT HE KNEW WHO THE VEHICLE BELONGED TO. HE STATED THAT THIS WAS THE REASON HE WAS UNDER THE BENNETT VEHICLE, AND HE DENIED THAT HE HAD SEVERED THE LINE. EXAMINATION OF THE LEFT REAR BRAKE LINE BY THE UNDERSIGNED AND ROBINSON DISCLOSED THAT THE LINE WAS SEVERED ALMOST IN TWO APPROXIMATELY SIX INCHES FROM THE T WHERE THE LEFT BRAKE LINE LEADS TO THE LEFT REAR WHEEL. THE UNDERSIGNED DEPRESSED THE PEDAL ON THE 1955 DESOTO WHILE ROBINSON OBSERVED THE BRAKE LINE, AND ROBINSON STATED THAT THE BRAKE FLUID SPURTED FORTH FROM THE SEVERED PORTION OF THE LINE. THIS LINE WAS PHOTOGRAPHED BY INV. CORRIGAN, REMOVED, TAGGED AS EVIDENCE AND LEFT IN THE LAB FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION.

THE UNDERSIGNED AND INV. DUVALL EXAMINED THE ENGINE OF THE 1955 DESOTO AND FOUND THAT THERE WAS A NEW UPPER GAS LINE LEADING FROM THE FUEL PUMP TO THE CARBURETOR, WHICH HAD APPARENTLY BEEN RECENTLY INSTALLED. WE ALSO NOTED WHAT APPEARED TO BE GUNPOWDER FRAGMENTS LYING ON THE MANIFOLD, WATER PUMP ASSEMBLY AND SPARK PLUGS ON THE RIGHT BANK OF THE ENGINE. THE UNDERSIGNED TOOK SOME OF WHAT APPEARED TO BE GUNPOWDER AND IGNITED SAME AND FOUND THAT SAME DID IGNITE AS GUNPOWDER. 

Mr. Bennett came into the station on this date and reported that on 12-6-63 and 12-10-63 someone attempted to set his car on fire.

The car in question is a 1955 DeSoto 4dr. Sedan license number [REDACTED] and is registered to the above Mr. Bennett. On December 6th. Miss Linda M. Bennett drove the car to Pasadena and parked it at the south east corner of Rose Villa and Hill Ave. This was approximately 8:00 AM. Miss Bennett then went on to class at PCC. She returned to her car at approximately 10:30 AM and drove same away. She had not gone too far when she smelled gas, and pulled into a service station at 2390 Huntington Dr. San Marino. At this time the station attendant found the fuel line broken, and replaced same. It was felt at this time the fuel line had just worn out. Miss Bennett returned to Pasadena on December 10th, and again parked the car at the same location, only on this date she did not arrive until approximately 11:00 AM. She then went onto class and when she returned and started out in the car she again smelled gas. She went to the same service station and this time the station attendant replaced the gas line, and at this time he found where the gas line had been cut. When Miss Bennett returned to her home Mr. Bennett examined both gas lines and found that both of them had been cut.

The gas lines in question appeared to have been cut with a hack saw, approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the fuel pump.

Mr. Bennett advised this officer that his older daughter Miss Mary P. Bennett used to go with the suspect Mr. Serhan, and after some time they broke up. Mr. Bennett stated that since that time Mr. Serhan, started to call and write letters to Miss Bennett. He did not give up, until Mr. Bennett went to the DA and turned over a letter to him from Mr. Serhan. Mr. Bennett stated that after that the letters stopped coming, but the incident with the car started. Mr. Bennett stated Mr. Serhan knows the car and feels that he is trying to get back at his daughter for breaking up with him.

Investigator Dague took photos of the car, and placed the cut gas lines in the property room. See his report for further information.




