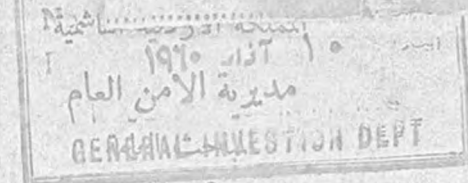

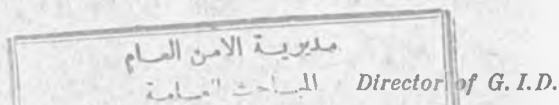

DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S INVESTIGATOR STAN ROBINSON ADVISED THE UNDERSIGNED ON THE MORNING OF 12-18-63 THAT HE HAD RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT THE VICTIM, CAROL BENNETT, WAS GOING TO PARK HER VEHICLE ON HILL AVENUE JUST SOUTH OF DEL MAR STREET AT APPROXIMATELY 11 TO 11:30 A.M., AND DUE TO PREVIOUS ACTS ON THE VEHICLE BY SUSPECT SIRHAN (SEVERING OF THE BRAKE LINE AT THE ~~REAR~~ REAR WHEEL, SEVERING OF THE GAS LINE NEAR THE CARBURETOR YKICE, AND SPRINKLING OF GUNPOWDER ON THE MANIFOLD), HE (ROBINSON) STAKED OUT ON THE AREA DUE TO THE POSSIBILITY THAT SUSPECT SIRHAN WOULD AGAIN ATTEMPT TO TAMPER WITH THE VEHICLE.

ROBINSON STATED THAT HE HAD PARKED HIS VEHICLE AT A POINT ON HILL AVENUE SOUTH OF THE VICTIM'S VEHICLE, WHERE HE COULD OBSERVE SAME. HE STATED THAT AT APPROXIMATELY 12:15 P.M. ON 12-18-63 HE OBSERVED THE SUSPECT WALKING WEST AT THE CORNER OF OAKDALE AND HILL, NORTH ON HILL TO THE VICTIM'S VEHICLE, AT WHICH TIME HE CRAWLED UNDERNEATH THE VEHICLE AND APPEARED TO BE DOING SOMETHING TO THE VEHICLE AT THE LEFT REAR WHEEL. ROBINSON STATED AT THIS TIME HE DROVE HIS VEHICLE TO THE REAR OF THE VICTIM'S VEHICLE AND THE SUSPECT CAME FROM BENEATH THE CAR AND DROPPED A SMALL HACKSAW ON THE PAVEMENT. MR. ROBINSON STATED THAT AT THIS TIME HE DETAINED THE SUSPECT AND ASKED A PERSON IN THE VICINITY TO NOTIFY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT THAT HE HAD THE SUSPECT DETAINED, AND OFFICER COSTIGAN ARRIVED AND ASSISTED HIM. LATER, INV. DUVALL AND THE UNDERSIGNED ARRIVED AT THE SCENE, WHERE THE HACK SAW WAS GIVEN TO THE UNDERSIGNED BY OFFICER COSTIGAN, WHO STATED THAT ROBINSON HAD GIVEN SAME TO HIM.

THE SUSPECT'S VEHICLE, A 1958 CHEVROLET TWO-DOOR SEDAN, WAS PARKED IN FRONT OF 1435 OAKDALE STREET, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 126 FEET FROM HILL AVENUE. THE VICTIM'S VEHICLE, A 1955 DESOTO, WAS PARKED IN FRONT OF 314 SOUTH HILL AVENUE, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 225 FEET NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF OAKDALE AND HILL. IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT THE VEHICLES WERE NOT IN A POSITION WHERE EITHER COULD BE SEEN FROM THE OTHER.

SUSPECT SIRHAN WAS INTERROGATED BY THE UNDERSIGNED, INV. DUVALL AND MR. ROBINSON. SIRHAN STATED THAT HE WAS EN ROUTE TO PASADENA CITY COLLEGE TO CONTACT A FRIEND TO WHOM HE OWED \$6. TO REPAY THE MONEY. THAT HE WAS COUNTING THE MONEY AS HE WALKED ALONG THE STREET AND A DIME HAD ROLLED OUT INTO THE STREET UNDER THE BENNETT VEHICLE. SIRHAN READILY ADMITTED THAT HE KNEW WHO THE VEHICLE BELONGED TO. HE STATED THAT THIS WAS THE REASON HE WAS UNDER THE BENNETT VEHICLE, AND HE DENIED THAT HE HAD SEVERED THE LINE. EXAMINATION OF THE LEFT REAR BRAKE LINE BY THE UNDERSIGNED AND ROBINSON DISCLOSED THAT THE LINE WAS SEVERED ALMOST IN TWO APPROXIMATELY SIX INCHES FROM THE T WHERE THE LEFT BRAKE LINE LEADS TO THE LEFT REAR WHEEL. THE UNDERSIGNED DEPRESSED THE PEDAL ON THE 1955 DESOTO WHILE ROBINSON OBSERVED THE BRAKE LINE, AND ROBINSON STATED THAT THE BRAKE FLUID SPURTED FORTH FROM THE SEVERED PORTION OF THE LINE. THIS LINE WAS PHOTOGRAPHED BY INV. CORRIGAN, REMOVED, TAGGED AS EVIDENCE AND LEFT IN THE LAB FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION.

THE UNDERSIGNED AND INV. DUVALL EXAMINED THE ENGINE OF THE 1955 DESOTO AND FOUND THAT THERE WAS A NEW UPPER GAS LINE LEADING FROM THE FUEL PUMP TO THE CARBURETOR, WHICH HAD APPARENTLY BEEN RECENTLY INSTALLED. HE ALSO NOTED WHAT APPEARED TO BE GUNPOWDER FRAGMENTS LYING ON THE MANIFOLD, WATER PUMP ASSEMBLY AND SPARK PLUGS ON THE RIGHT BANK OF THE ENGINE. THE UNDERSIGNED TOOK SOME OF WHAT APPEARED TO BE GUNPOWDER AND IGNITED SAME AND FOUND THAT SAME DID IGNITE AS GUNPOWDER. AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT WAS COLLECTED, PRESERVED AS EVIDENCE AND TAKEN TO THE LAB FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE SUSPECT'S VEHICLE. THE UNDERSIGNED FOUND A BOX OF 12-GAUGE SHOTGUN SHELLS UNDER THE RIGHT PASSENGER SEAT CUSHION IN THE FRONT. THESE WERE GIVEN TO INV.
