Dear Judge Spradlin:

I have seen this young man for 4 hours professionally. The content of his remarks for these hours has been essentially the same whether his judgments have truth or fantasy, he has a highly systematized feeling of persecution. He is not conducive to adaptive behavior in our society. He does not comprehend this one bit. Because of his resistant behavior in these hours, & because he has no viable means of support & since he has not paid the previous psychologist he consulted, I terminated his conferences with me. I did this on the condition that he attend his probation hearing with you & obtain funds with which to pay me before I could or would see him again.

Unk. he comprehends his severe & acute need of treatment I see very little hope that he will become a productive member of our society.

SUSPECT SIRHAN WAS INTERVIEWED BY TWO INVESTIGATORS, INV. DWYER AND MR. SCHINDLER. SIRHAN STATED THAT HE WAS ON THE ST. PASADENA PARK COLLEGE TO MEET A FRIEND TO WHOM HE WENT TO, TO BORROW THE MONEY. THAT HE WAS DRIVING THE MONEY IN HE WALKED ALONG THE STREET AND A GIRL WENT BY HIM AND SPARKED UNDER THE STREET VEHICLE. SIRHAN READILY ADMITTED THAT HE KNEW WHO THE GIRL HE WENT TO. HE STATED THAT IT IS AT THE LOCATION HE WAS UNDER THE STREET VEHICLE, AND HE REALIZED THAT HE HAD STRUCK THE LINE. EXAMINATION OF THE LEFT FRONT BRAKE LINE ON THE UNDERGROUND WAS FOUND TO BE DISCONNECTED INTO THE LINE BAG BECAUSE ALMOST IN THE DISCONNECTED SIX INCHES FROM THE T WERE THE LEFT BRAKE LINE LEADS TO THE LEFT STEER WHEEL. THE UNDERGROUND WAS DISCONNECTED THE PEDAL ON THE FOOT DESKETS WHILE POSITION CHANGING THE BRAKE LINE. MR. SCHINDLER STATED THAT THE BRAKE LINE HE WENT FROM THE UNDERGROUND TO THE LINE. SIRHAN HAD PHOTOGRAPHED BY INV. SCHINDLER, REPRODUCED, TAKEN AS EVIDENCE AND LEFT IN THE CAR FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION.

THE UNDERGROUND AND INV. DWYER EXAMINED THE INTERIOR OF THE TRUCK DESKETS AND TO SEE THAT THERE WAS A NEW LINE BAG LEADING FROM THE FUEL PUMP TO THE CARBURETOR, WHICH WAS APPARENTLY NEW, RECENTLY INSTALLED. HE ALSO NOTED WHAT APPEARED TO BE DISCONNECTED PARTS OF THE LINE ON THE UNDERGROUND, WATER PUMP, AIRPUMP AND SPRAY BLISS ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE ENGINE. MR. SCHINDLER TOOK SOME OF WHAT APPEARED TO BE DISCONNECTED AND INSTALLED PARTS AND PLACED THEM IN THE TRUCK AS EVIDENCE. AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT WAS DISCONNECTED INSTALLED AS EVIDENCE AND TAKEN TO THE CAR FOR FURTHER EXAMINATION.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE UNDERGROUND RECORDS. THE UNDERGROUND FOUND A CAR OF FORD 1961 SHOOTING TRUCK ON THE END BEING A SHOOTING SEAT WHICH IN THE FRONT. THREE REEL GIVEN TO INV. SCHINDLER AND SCHINDLER. MR. SCHINDLER WAS LOCATED IN THE VEHICLE OF AT THE UNDERGROUND. MR. SCHINDLER STATED THAT HE DID NOT SEE A SHOOTING, NOR DID HE HAVE WITH THE UNDERGROUND PARTS FROM.

WHEN QUESTIONED BY INV. DWYER, SIRHAN STATED THAT HE HAD TAKEN THE TRUCK CAR WITH HIM AS HE DID NOT WANT TO LEAVE FROM HIS CAR. IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT THE DISCONNECTED VEHICLE WAS NOT DRIVEN, THE KEYS WERE IN THE IGNITION, THERE WAS A PACKAGE ON THE BACK SEAT WHICH WAS THE NEW COVERS OF CHRISTMAS CARDS. SIRHAN ADVISED INV. DWYER THAT HE HAD TAKEN THE TRUCK CAR FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHANGING THE FROZEN FOOD. HE FURTHER STATED TO MR. SCHINDLER AND INV. DWYER LATER THAT HE HAD USED THE TRUCK CAR IN GETTING HIS CAR PARTS FOR HIS AUTOMOBILE. WHEN ASKED TO SPECIFY WHAT PARTS OF THE CAR HE HAD LEFT, SIRHAN REPLYED THAT HE DID NOT KNOW.

SIRHAN WAS RELEASED TO THE STATION AND HE WENT AS ABOVE.
