



Dear Judge Spangler:

I have seen this young man for 4 hours professionally. The content of his remarks for these hours has been essentially the same whether his judgments have truth or fantasy, he has a highly stabilized feeling of persecution. This is not conducive to adaptive behavior in our society. He does not comprehend this one bit.

Because of his resistant behavior in these hours, & because he has no visible means of support & since he has not paid the previous psychologist he consulted, I terminated his conference with me. I did this on the condition that he attend his probate hearing with you & obtain funds with which to pay me before I could or would see him again.

Unless he comprehends his severe & acute need of treatment I see very little hope that he will become a productive member of our society.





SIRHAN SIRHAN WAS EXAMINED IN A WORKSHOP, TONY DUVAL AND MR.
BROWN. SIRHAN STATED THAT HE HAD DRIVEN HIS PLYMOUTH DARK GREEN TO THE
PLACE WHERE HE WANTED ALICE DAY DAVIS AND AT SAME HAD DRIVEN UP INTO THE

TRUSS ADVISED THE UNDERSIGNED IN THE MORNING OF NOVEMBER 19, 1968, THAT HE HAD RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT THE VICTIM, GENELETTI, JR., WAS KILLED IN HIS OWN VEHICLE ON HILL AVENUE JUST SOUTH OF DEL MAR STREET AT APPROXIMATELY 11:30 PM ON NOVEMBER 18, DUE TO PREVIOUS ACTS ON THE VEHICLE BY ANOTHER CITIZEN.
