Senator Kennedy will make 2 campaign trips next week. The first will originate from New York City in the late afternoon, Monday, and go to Delaware County, Pennsylvania; Camden, New Jersey; and Philadelphia, Pa., ending in Washington late Tuesday night.

The second trip will originate in Washington, D. C. on Friday, April 5th, and will go to Ohio, La., Kentucky; Alaska and South Dakota. It is possible that this schedule will be extended, but these stops will cover the days Friday, April 5th, through Tuesday, April 9th.

Reporters wishing to accompany the Senator on the New York-Philadelphia-Washington trip, should indicate their desire to travel with the Senator by 10:00 A.M. Monday, April 1st.
