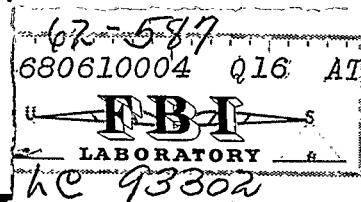

Dear Sirs:

We are forwarding this note to you as the Kennedy Headquarters said they had no committee for 'crack pots'.

My husband has put a picture of Senator Kennedy in our living room window, on arriving home the following day this terrible note was stuck on our mail box. The woman next door has asked to use my sewing machine and apparently saw another picture of Kennedy in our work room. We don't associate, nor do we want to with this couple, as three plain cloths men questioned us about them two weeks after we moved to this address. A woman living with them was involved in narcotics. Mr. X was on business in the Southern States and attended Dr. King's funeral. Mrs. X said Dr. King's death & the funeral delayed his business.

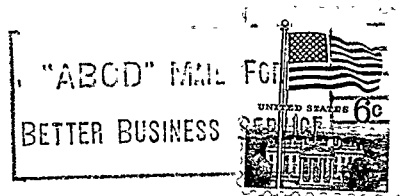
