MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: SRI Paranormal Investigation Trip Report  
23 - 25 January 1974

1. Most of the details of the trip are summarized in the attached memorandum by [redacted] ORD/LS. There are a few additions to be made concerning the applications oriented experiments. Four general types of experiments are described in the work statement. These four general statements are an attempt to summarize our interest in innocuous terms.

2. The two areas of immediate interest are the possibility of detecting SW and the remote viewing capability. Exemplars of SW are now being prepared and will be delivered to SRI for their experiments. First they will determine if the presence of SW can be detected, then if SW can be read as well as typed or written information. Almost all aspects of the remote viewing ability is of interest. Initially determination of the characteristics of long range remote viewing will be first priority. Direction will evolve depending upon the results obtained.
