66	<u>Random target generator</u> Some slight statistical confirmation but not nearly so good as remote viewing results
76	<u>Medical evaluation</u> All normal
79	<u>Psychological evaluation</u> No real differences
94	<u>Neuropsychological</u> Information received is processed piecemeal in pattern form and is subject to error when integrated into a larger pattern or verbalized
97-103	<u>Remote strobe experiment or Evoked Potential</u> EEG monitoring of Subject shows alpha rhythm blocking indicating signals received (even though they are not consciously perceived). Confirmed previous work showing involvement of right hemisphere.
103	<u>Polygraph</u> No correlation between the "hit" and "miss" periods of experiments
106	<u>Geiger counter</u> No correlation
107	<u>Torsion pendulum</u> Experiment results inconclusive
108-113	<u>Magnetometer</u> Significant with Subject P/1 but not others
