SUBJECT : OTS Support to Research in Parapsychology

I recently saw a copy of the minutes of the twelfth meeting of the Human Resources Committee Research and Development Subcommittee of 20 September 1976. This was the meeting in which some OTS people briefed the Committee on our past support to parapsychology research. I note in paragraph three of the minutes the statement was made that "...enough empirical evidence existed to warrant further research in this area." I think you know my position on this, but just in case there is some confusion I want to make myself clear. OTS will not support any further research in parapsychology.
