(S/NF) Thank you for your time and cooperation in helping us reconstruct the Pat Price data base. We are interested in providing an in-depth evaluation of the Price data, and your contribution to this effort has already proven invaluable.

(S/NF) In the course of our meeting on 12 June 1986, you mentioned several documents that would be useful to us. Specifically, these included:

- the original memo (written by you) outlining the protocols that were used in the PNUTS experiment
- the document provided by the NPIC analyst assessing the accuracy (using a 3 point scale) of Price's data on PNUTS
- a similar analysis document written by [Redacted] at Los Alamos
- the code word level critique authored by [Redacted] on the West Virginia site
- an analysis of [Redacted] that were carried out on a double blind basis; any audio tapes pertaining to these experiments
- any assessments of experiments in which feedback *was not* provided to Price
- any other original data and/or analyses that you consider to be useful to our mission.


