He had also just received the message and had little to add other than that [redacted] (DC/OST) had told him that Both Colby & Shlesinger had decided that, because of the publicity SRI & Swann & Geller had received, it would be too dangerous for the Agency to stay involved with them. Allegedly, their decision was not made on substantive issues & there may be some chance that research with and through other facilities might be favorably considered.

[redacted] is going to call SRI today to let them know & I offered to call as well if he feels that it will be useful. There will be no continuation of their project, either; the irony is that by our kicking it over [redacted] we invoked the higher authority review.
