Directions: SEE MAP; Take Laurel Street north to Ravenswood Ave; turn left on Ravenswood Ave. and follow to El Camino Real; turn left on El Camino (South); exit right onto Palm Drive (towards the Stanford University Campus); take Roth Way right past the Rodin Sculpture Garden; turn left on Campus Drive; follow around curve and watch for the Cogeneration Plant on the left; park in a safe place; walk around.

Target: The target is the entire Cogeneration Plant. The cogeneration Plant on the Stanford University Campus has a very interesting shape and texture. The front of the building appears to be covered with a tan color metal. There seems to be three major sections to the front of the building. Each of these three sections has rounded edges at the top. At the back of the building there is both a brick and a cement section. There is also a large smoke stack coming out from the roof.


