MEMORANDUM FOR CHIEF SCIENTIST, DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY

SUBJECT: SUN STREAK Operational Report - 8916 (U)

1. (S/NF/SK) During the period of 7 APR 89 to _____, 1989, inclusively, _____ sessions were conducted to determine the location of a wanted felon identified as [redacted] and to provide certain Essential Elements of Information (EEI) concerning him and his location. These EEI are addressed as tasked:

2. (S/NF/SK) "Describe [redacted] location, providing overhead sketches."

SG1A

a. 003 described the general area as one of mild climate, on a western coastal part of the Americas, with a desert-like area to the east. The local area is suburban, consisting of large estates removed from, but accesable to a dense, modern population area and major roads. The local language has a "Spanish" or "Italian" flavor. [redacted] actual location is in a large enclosed structure of this suburban area, down a winding, landscaped road. Other buildings, enclosed by wire fencing, are nearby.

b. 011 described the general area as an isolated and rural, in a warm climate, with heavy vegetation, including large, broadleaf trees. The house is on a small gravel road with a large body of water nearby.

c. 025 described the general area as a warm, tropical, coastal area frequented by young tourists, and situated in a forested area with flowers.

d. 079 described the general area as sparsely populated, within an Indian reserve.

e. 095 described the general area as sunny and warm, but not desert-like. It has rocky, rolling hills, and low vegetation. There is a large body of water far to the east, which has cyprus-like trees. There is a "foreign" (non-U.S.) flavor, with a melodious language. The local area is rural, on the outskirts of a small "town", consisting of no more than 10 buildings sitting directly on a winding and narrow two-lane road which leads away from the town, past his present residence, and on through a pass between two hills.

COMMENTS: The area is in a warm climate.
The area is rural.
There is a large body of water nearby, probably a coastline.
A narrow road passes the immediate location.

3. (S/NF/SK) "Describe [] current residence/habitat."

SG1A

a. 003 described [] present residence as a large, multi-storied, "porticoed" white building with a red roof, and surrounded by a white wall. It is roomy, dimly lit, cool, sparsely furnished, and orderly. He is here as a "guest" of the owner, for the mutual self-interest of both parties.

b. 011 described the house as a multi-storied farmhouse in run-down condition and an old barn and smokehouse adjacent to it. It is surrounded by trees and fronts on a gravel road. The front has a covered porch, and there is a cellar entrance in the rear, as well as a rear door. Furnishings are simple and austere.

c. 025 did not report a description of [] residence.

d. 079 did not report a description of [] residence.

e. 095 described [] residence as a large, long, three-storied white building with a beige-brown roof and a grimy exterior of flaking plaster. It is located on a narrow two-lane road, a few miles from a town. There are no doors on the side facing the road, and there is a set of external stairs on the end of the building nearest the town. [] lives in the rear of this building, top floor, near the external stairs.

c. 025 reported a current alias of "Wayne", but noted that [] is expected to change his name again.

e. 095 reported that [] is presently using a name which Stage 7 functioning developed as a first name sounding like, "Kuh-rah-i-(ss or th)-tuh-uh-nn" (possibly "Christian"), and a last name sounding like: "M-(er or ur)-ee-(duh or tuh)" (possibly "Meredith").


