SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

SG1A

The target vessel [REDACTED] is currently located in the immediate area of the "Yucatan Basin" at geographical coordinates 19°50' N/84°W.

The [REDACTED] is transporting a "heavy" and mixed load of illegal drugs that appears to include cocaine, heroin and hashish.

It is enroute for Beaumont, Texas, where it will unload its contraband. It may make a refueling/pit stop in New Orleans, Louisiana before proceeding to Beaumont.

(OPS CMTS: An early reference to the home of the quarter horse resulted in the identification of Beaumont, Texas, as a destination.)

The drugs will then be transported through New Mexico, Arizona and ultimately to California. The drugs will be off loaded onto a white driven van by three men dressed in western/cowboy attire. The van will be equipped with a radar detection device.

Drug dealers from Arizona are responsible for this particular operation.

The drugs are contained in brown boxes used to carry silverware associated with Western garb and commemorative spoons.
