

THE TRANSFER OF CONTRABAND TAKES PLACE IN OPEN WATER, BEYOND A REEF, NEAR AN ISLAND. THE DEPTH OF WATER AT THIS LOCATION IS APPROXIMATELY 30-40 FEET (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 2). THIS ISLAND IS PART OF A CHAIN OF ISLANDS SITUATED IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN, SOMEWHERE SOUTH AND WEST OF THE UNITED STATES (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 3). THE CONTRABAND IS INTENDED TO BE OFF-LOADED ONTO, AT LEAST, TWO SMALLER VESSELS. THESE SMALLER VESSELS WOULD THEN PROCEED TO THE NEARBY ISLAND WHERE THERE IS A BASE OF OPERATIONS AND AN OLD AIRSTRIP (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 2). FROM THE BASE OF OPERATIONS THE CARGO IS THEN AIRLIFTED TO TWO DESTINATIONS; ONE NEAR THE NORTHWEST BORDER OF THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA, THE OTHER IS IN THE DIRECTION OF THE U.S./MEXICAN BORDER (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 3). SG1A

██████████ INTENDED PORT OF DESTINATION APPEARS TO BE SOME LATIN-AMERICAN COUNTRY IN THE NORTHERN HEMISPHERE, PERHAPS MEXICO.

SG1A THE ██████████ IS INVOLVED WITH THIS OPERATION, BUT IT SEEMS TO BE UNDER THE CONTROL OF "FRIENDLY FORCES". CONCEPTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS VESSEL ARE; DECOY, INFILTRATE, UNDERCOVER, LURE, TRAP, AND ENSNARE.





4/2 - there are three vessels, about the size of charter boats, in fact two look like charter boats. These two are the ones that receive the cargo. The third boat is long, sleek, and open, more like a speedboat, but larger. This vessel has 4-5 heavily armed persons on board its function is to act as a sentinal and to guard the activity.

The activity takes place in open water, the water here is rather shallow, (30-40 feet) and appears to be near something like a reef. There is an island nearby where there is a base of operations. The cargo is taken to the island and is flown out from there. There appears to be an airstrip here that was abandoned long ago. However, I'm not sure whether the airstrip is actually used for this operation, or if amphibious aircraft are involved. Perhaps both!

There is a small chain of island located somewhere west of the North American coastline. There are two flights of cargo from these island to the North American continent, one is aimed in a northerly route, the other a southerly route.

SG1A 4½ - First impression is that not all of the cargo is off loaded.
 The [REDACTED] port of destination on this voyage appears
 to be some Latin country in the northern hemisphere - getting
 a feel for the west coast of Mexico.
