SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The target structure is a multi-storied, Soviet-owned embassy or consulate located in an attractive portion of an unidentified city; the presence of children nearby was noted. The presence of television monitors were noted.

A group of persons comprised mainly of women are perceived as working on the first floor; analytical personnel appear preoccupied on the second floor. The monitoring of communications facilitated by (what appears to be) a microwave dish is the principal intelligence activity being pursued on the third floor of the structure.

In addition to the monitoring of communication traffick, additional intelligence activities related to "movements, personnel, and assignments," are being pursued on what is considered "an opportunity basis."

"Meetings of high (level) officials" <u>do not</u> take place at this establishment. The structure is an old building devoid of elevators.

The expression "hard-tack" phonetically surfaced during the session but its meaning could not be explained or described.

The structure is Sovièt owned. It is in a beautiful portion of the city and there are children nearby. There is a camera outside of the structure that can take pictures of people walking by. The structure is like an embassy or consulate.

As you enter the structure you must walk up some steps. On the first floor of the structure there are women working on personnel and administrative actions.

On the second floor, there are analyst types.

On the top floor, there are several technical types of individuals here who work on radio relay information and there is a small micro wave dish here.

The work that goes on here can be described as "all-source."

There is intelligence collection work being done here.

When moving around in the structure, one must take stairs.

There are not elevators in this structure. The structure is old.

The structure was also described as being "hidden, stow - away."

There are not top meetings going on here and high officials $\stackrel{\textstyle \backslash}{}$ do not work here.

The name "hard - tack" phonetically surfaced during this session.
