1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: To access and describe the target, paying close attention to proper CRV structure.
2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: 6-digit encrypted coordinates: 198001/436968.
3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS:
  - a. Inclemencies: none reported
  - b. Viewer 025 spent quite a bit of time in Stages 1 and 2 before beginning to perceive dimensional aspects of the site. This was worked through basically, by including the prompt "dimensional aspects" with the coordinate cueing once. Immediate progress was made through the proper dimensionals, AI, and into Stage 3. Progress into Stage 4 was postponed until tomorrow's session, due to length of today's.
  - c. Observations: The following observations were made during the session:
    - 1) Every time 025 declared an AOL break and proceeded directly on without actually taking a short break, the following perceptions (in this case, Stage 2 perceptions) were directly related to the AOL. That much is normal. 025, however, added an unconscious twist to it: each time it happened, without fail, 025 would declare the AOL break, then place the pen HIGHER on the page (at a point BEFORE the break was declared), and begin filling

in space, often between the impressions which were already written there. It appeared to be an attempt to use the AOL to clarify what had gone before by going BACK and adding to previous material. I doubt that O25 should be made aware of this habit, but the monitor should be aware that O25 provides the monitor with a visual signal by unconsciously externalizing the process of AOL DRIVE.


- 2) O25 is apparently under the impression that Stage 2 MUST be performed in a proper sequence of self-cueing, only. I was reluctant to make O25 aware of the fact that passive impressions may also be gained, because I was not certain whether or not O25 had been taught self-cueing, only. This and the following observations will be discussed with the Training Officer before any comment is made.
- 3) O25 had not been taught that there are basically two phases in Stage 3; the first phase being an analytical sketch of the dimensionals gained from Stage 2, then the second phase being gaining closer contact with the site through repeated resketching of the impressions, with input from the site. That is the method I learned for Stage 3, and am not certain that it was taught to O25, so again, did not "correct" (confuse) the actions O25 was performing.
- 4) O25 repeatedly performed the IAB sequence in the following manner:  
cue  
ideogram  
write A: and the motion component(s)  
touch the ideogram to gain more impressions  
write the feeling component(s)  
write B: and the gestalt.  
The extra step of going back to the ideogram to gain a feeling component was performed every time, and appeared to be the result of training, so again, I did not attempt to "correct".
- 5) O25 performed an automatic interim summary at the bottom of each Stage 3 sketch. I was taught that the interim summary is useful for clearing and organizing the signal line, but was taught to declare it as an interim summary. With O25, it has become an automatic part of the Stage 3 sketch. Again, this appeared to be gained from training, so I did not comment on it to O25 during the session.

- b. PURPOSE:    The previous session covered only stages 1-3. The purpose of this session was to continue with the same target site into stage 4 structure.
  
- c. COMMENTS:
  - 1)    025 began the session in Stage 4, taking a few pages to "get back into the site". This attempt was largely unsuccessful until the middle of page 16, when 025 was instructed to forget about the site and concentrate on structure only. Extra measures were taken to maintain completely proper structure throughout the rest of the session. From the middle of page 16 to the end of the session, extremely pertinent perceptions were gained about the site.
  
  - 2)    The session transcript will be reviewed with 025, with detailed attention to the validity of those perceptions which were gained while in structure and those which were gained while out of structure, in an attempt to drive home the importance of maintaining proper structure.
