

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The site has green vegetation, some water, and hills in the outlying area. The climate is cool. An image of a switchboard or musical stringed instrument came to mind. People are present in an open area engaging in festive activities. The dress is colorful robed ornamental outfits and the environment is traditional (oriental in appearance). Some people are enjoying themselves where as others are working to add to the shared activities. Examples of the activities include walking, riding bicycles, and putting wood on the fire. These people, predominantly young women, are in pairs or small family groups including children. Some of the surrounding structures within the rural area are better than others. One of the major structures has an arched doorway and a pointed roof. The other houses are small, fairly simple in design, with shingles and shutters. See sketches attached hereto.


