The second largest falls in South America is located in the Pakaraima Mountains near the junction of the borders of Venezuela, Brazil and Guyana. The water descends 2,000 feet down the face of a flat topped mountain in the Guiana Highlands. It flows west as Venezuela's Cuquenán tributary of the north flowing Caoní River.
