Also appear to be having a great deal of difficulty recognizing holes or depressions in the ground..... even one as large as the Grand Canyon. Large bodies of water still come through as flat, wavy, fluids, in motion. However, with the Lake Titicaca site the wavy motion was absent, but the flat, fluid motion was very strong. It was interesting to note that after repeating itself several times, the ideogram changed significantly once the correct interpretation was reached. Even though the ideogram changed, the feeling/motion of the site remained the same.
