SITE I. (Washington, D.C.)

SITE II. (Everglades Swamp, FL)

This site felt a little better. There seemed to be a bit of confusion with this site. I was perceiving a feeling of solid and fluid within the ideogram, also sharp upward motion with sharp angles. The sharp angles could have been tall trees or even a possible structure at the site. It was of interest to note that when probing above the ideogram there was a feeling of airiness, when probing below there was a feeling of cool and damp.

SITE III. (Lake near Mexico City)

A very definite feeling of a flat surface in motion. I find that whenever I perceive a site in motion it is a good indication that it is most likely a body of water.
