in background

SITE I (MOUNTAINS)

..... smooth, vertical feeling felt more
natural though.....

SITE II (RUMS IN PERU)

..... vertical up feeling definitely hard throughout
session eventually decoded signal as vertical
up, across, vertical up, across, vertical up across, etc.
..... there was some confusion in the beginning
as to whether this was a mountain or a structure
..... there seems to be a very subtle difference between
a peak and a right angle at this stage.....
