Morning

Site 1 Great Sand Dunes Nat'l Mon. (at the foot of the Sangre De Cristo Mtns)

.... at the very beginning there were two gestalts present ... it was especially evident during the stage II's there were two opposite set of feelings, colors and textures one was cool, vertical, angular, hard, blues, grays the other was warm, flat, sandy, gritty, browns, yellows, orange, land the contrast between the mountains and sand dunes appear evident ... there was some difficulty at first trying to determine whether the verticals and angles were structures, but a feeling of naturalness persisted throughout the entire site.

Site 2 Surface of the Sun

.... lots of AOL with this one the recurring visual was a very blue, circular mass surrounded by a black void
