3. (S-SS) Results:

- The site was perceived as a structure which has something "wrong" with its proportions. The exterior of the structure seems to have at least one portion with columns (see sketch, page 5). The structure, itself, feels (tactile) part natural and part manmade. There are two types of manmade portions: one of very high quality (AOL: also seems to be older, or "more original") and other portions which are very flims and cheap (AOL: feel like newer "add-ons"). (There is also at least one part of the immediate exterior of the structure open to and slightly lower than ground level.
- b. The interior is neat, clean and orderly. There are numerous, generally unassociated (with one another) people. Because of the nature of the structure, these people tend to "congregate". While there is an overall drone of talking noise, the place gives the quiet impression of a large, open space.
- c. There is a large, massive "something" sitting directly on the floor of this large, open interior space (see sketch, page 12). It has uneven tops and sides, and drove the AOL of "locomotive". People come here to view it; not as in a museum, but as in a research or testing laboratory.
