- 2. (S-SS) Cuing: 6 digit encrypted coordinates: 179010/864892.
- 3. (S-SS) Tasking: Access the target activity. Describe the overall area, the immediate vicinity, the nature of the activity, and principal personalities involved.
- 4. (S-SS) Results:
- a. The distant area surrounding the activity is a city on a flat "plains" area which has hard-rock hills on the west and northwest side and what appears to be water on the east side (see sketch, page 15 of the transcript).
- b. The location of the activity is in an area of the city which has low— and medium—height buildings in abundance, with some taller buildings in the distance, but almost no very tall buildings are visible (see sketch, page 16). The buildings cast long (early evening) shadows.
- c. The activity in question involves a large crowd of people filling the streets. The density of the crowd lessens evenly in all directions. The crowd consists of 3 types of people:
- 1) A main person (male), who is lying on the pavement, apparently dead. This man is stockily built, wearing very expensive, but somewhat out-of-fashion clothing. He has grey or greying hair, and a distinguished appearance.
- 2) Lots of uniformed men in "purplish drab" uniforms, with short club-type hand weapons (see sketch, page 15), but seemingly no firearms.

- 3) Lots of people in random dress, but most of whom are wearing black clothes with white clothing showing from under them.
- d. The nature of the activity was confusing and unclear. The uniformed people are involved in crowd control, but are almost evenly distributed among the other people (not "herding" the crowd). There is lots of pushing, shoving, elbowing, etc. going on, but seemingly no violence, as such. The randomly dressed people are not all that mindful of the uniformed people. There is a lot of activity, motion, and excitement (mainly curiosity) in the crowd, but no strong violence was detected.
- e. Other perceptions located two other individuals who were not perceived as being at the above-described location:
- 1) A young, tall, very slender woman, wearing leather-like pants w/ diamond-shaped holes in the legs. She was perceived in a room of a building with what appeared to be large pieces of electronic equipment.
- 2) A young, slender, dark-skinned, curly haired man in dark brown shirt and slacks. He was located alone in a quiet outside relaxation area.
