- 1. (S/NF/SK) TASKING: The tasking as referenced in the above cited SPR remained in effect with no additional data provided to the Interviewer. Source was told only that She had apparently been successful in acquiring the proper site and that the Extended Remote Viewing (ERV) technology would be utilized in an attempt to clarify some of the previously reported data. Source was again told that the main target of this mission was to, "sequentially report on a special occurrence at the site in a given period of time which would be provided during the session". Source was provided the same encrypted coordinates as the previous session, 642178/171131. No other cuing or descriptive data was provided to Source prior to this session except that which is cited above.
- 2. (S/NF/SK) SESSION: In the previous session, Source was tasked utilizing the Coordinate Remote Viewing (CRV) technology. The undersigned also functioned as the Monitor in that session. It was decided to utilize the ERV technology in this session to attempt to gain a more fluid and detailed accounting of the event in question at the site. During the actual session there were no reportable anomalies or incidents which may have affected or influenced the data provided by Source except that which is cited above. The session was conducted in its entirety utilizing ERV protocols.
- 3. (S/NF/SK) SUMMARY: The following narrative, contained within quotation marks, is an abridged copy of Source's post-session written summary. This summary has been editorialized, (as indicated), by the undersigned for clarity, grammar and structure. The actual unabridged summary is maintained in the mission field dossier at this location along with any other material produced during the session,

"(The) site is a large, windowless, flat-roofed building of concrete construction. (The) location is isolated, flat, dry land with tall hills as a back drop. There seems to be only one small dirt road leading to (this) building. The building is quite large but not much over one tall story or possibly two. A large portion of the building is below ground. There is one large room perceived with one male person monitoring equipment. One piece (of equipment) is like a printer with manifold paper (and) numbers instead of letters. Another is like a seismograph/polygraph (with) a needle printing a line with peaks and valleys. A third piece of equipment has small colored round lights and a rectangular button that is flashing red. At this point the man begins paying particular attention to the "frantic" (Source quotation marks) activity of the needled equipment. There is the sound of a low, deep rumbling from the depths of the building, a piercing whine and then a loud, "oogah oogah" horn blaring sound (klaxon horn?). There is also an almost imperceptible shifting feeling like a gentle swaying the intensifies to a bone jarring shaking. Large slabs of concrete are breaking apart and falling and there is a jagged split in the roof. A small, compact explosive device (magnetic) (Source parenthesis) has been attached to a high pressure pipe that caused the pipe to release its pressure. The pressure continues to build and causes a chain reaction of destruction (which is) impossible to stop or contain. There doesn't seem to be anyone else in the structure. Others, dressed in silvery suits, like spacesuits, rush with emergency equipment from another building and then realize that there is nothing to be done. destruction has been) too fast moving and too total. There is a strong perception of internal sabotage rather than (an) outside attack". END SUMMARY

- b. (S/NF/SK) During the actual session, Source reported other data which may impact on the final assessment of this target. That data is listed below in raw unevaluated form:
- (1) (S/NF/SK) When describing Her perceptions of a destructive occurrence, Source reported, "a hissing, escape of vapors of some kind, a bright flashing glow...a fissure of some type, a viscous liquid, black and orangy "AOL" hot lava, but it's not that texture, not lumpy, it glows...crumbling, dust, like a big hand shaking it to pieces...".
- (2) (S/NF/SK) When describing the event cause, Source reported on the release of pressure from a pipe. In the actual session Source reported that, "(the explosive force) not natural causes, manmade...releasing of the pressure (from the pipes) sets a chain of events (with) no emergency measures to stop it, you can't get down there to stop it, (the) heat is so intense...".
