SUBJECT: SOURCE 021/UTILITY ASSESSMENT "M

- 1. (S/NF) Reference "Frontload" portion of Sessions conducted on 10 and 14 April 1987 respectively.
- 2. (S/NF) Front loading of session with the caution that "(you) will run into a little static out there", "that this target may take several sessions", "there are several intelligence questions—don't expect to answer them all on the first trip out" appears to have had a negative impact on the source. It appears the source's subconscious complied nearly literally with the frontload tasking.
- 3. (S/NF) In lieu of the cautionary frontloading, a more positive approach may be in order. For example, "This is a new target Describe the nature and purpose of the intelligence question at coordinates (or subject contained in the envelope).
