SUBJECT: SRV Tasking for the week of 13-17 APR 87.

- 1. The site was worked in three sessions, separated by several hours. Each session was worked in the CRV mode, while sitting at the word processor.
- 2. SUMMARY: A summary of the perceptions are as follows:

The major gestablt of the area is that of a rounded-top "peak" of very hard and jagged rocks with very sharp surfaces, almost like crystal edges. This "peak" is natural and very firmly fixed in place.

When I try to get close to the "peak", there is a strong and definite sense of a nursery, with babies, loving care, soft fabrics, fuzzy warmth, etc.

When I back off from the "peak", I get a general area which is flat land, surrounded by a circle of sharp, high rocks or mountains. In the center of the flat area is the steep, round-topped peak and jagged "peak". The entire area between this central "peak" and the jagged rocks surrounding is extremely flat and covered with loose gravel. The impression that this is a lunar crater is so strong that it returned and couldn't be shaken throughout 3 sessions.

3. RVer's CRITIQUE: Although the 3 sessions were worked at widely separated times, I had a PI of tiredness during all of them. The insistant drive of being in a lunar crater was so strong that I couldn't shake it, and I finally gave up. I would place a very low credibility rating on this one.
