Site involves several structures in an area that is relatively barren, earthy, superficially excavated in some sense, with piles and berms of dirt here and there. Several structures are present, and seem to be in some state of "unassembly"--either not yet fully assembled, or in some way disassembled. Interiors are open to view, and components stick out, and some edges are rough. Site evinces sense of either a war zone or a building site. There is some sort intensive activity that takes place here, but it is in abeyance or in temporary respite at present, and will resume not too far in the future.

There are people present--apparently all male--who are not supposed to be here. They're looking for something and want to find it before they're discovered and before the activity that takes place here is resumed. They have a quasi- or paramilitary sense about them.

They may be looking for a person.
