The rest of the picture is blue and open on the upper part; jumbled, blue and black on the lower part. A man may be in the picture, too, but he is not significant to the picture's main purpose.
- 2. Subject matter: In several sessions I came up with a number of subject matters, but the one which FELT most important was that of a female astronaut in some underwater situation. AUL: discovery of remains of shuttle disaster.
- 3. Viewer's critique: Although the feeling of water and female person wearing a jump suit was strong, and FELI correct, there were a great deal of non-related impressions and "noise all throughout all the sessions done. I would frankly give little credence to the results.
