Site involves a round, smooth, dark-colored object made of dense, not-easily-deformed material. It is made in two sections--two halves--and can be disassembled, though it is not usually done. Objects can be rotated in opposing directions, which produces a clicking sound. Object has a substantial weight for its size. Something about it is adjustable; small lights emanate from it; a LED read-out is associated with it. If not handled appropriately, it has a dangerous quality--explodability or destructability, or something similar. It is about the size that would fit in two hands. It is designed to be placed inside something to accomplish its purpose.
