**SUBJECT:** SUNSTREAK Program (U)

(S/NF) As a result of discussions and decisions at the 7 September 1990 MIB, I am terminating today the previous agreements (references above) that transferred operational control of the SUNSTREAK Program to ODCSINT for a special test/evaluation period. I appreciate your staff's efforts, particularly those of [redacted] USA, and accept your offer to have [redacted] available to assist DIA in follow-on actions regarding the program. However, with the special test/evaluation period over, administrative and operational control of the SUNSTREAK Program and its fiscal and personnel resources reverts to DIA. I have asked the DIA Executive Director, [redacted] to oversee our subsequent SUNSTREAK Program actions on my behalf. Questions regarding the program and our courses of action may be directed to Mr. Nagy, or to Mr. John T. Berbrich, Assistant Deputy Director for Scientific and Technical Intelligence.
