SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

SG1A [ ] was perceived as a middle-aged (forties), dark-skinned individual of slender built and medium height, about 5'7". His ethnic origins could not be readily perceived; he appeared to be a Lebanese moderate, but the product of a mixture of races with roots based (partially) in Zaire. He is currently located at the "Daytime Hotel" (Days Inn?) located in Beirut in the immediate vicinity of a site identified as Mesrobian School. See copy of a partial map of Beirut at ENCLOSURE 2. On several

SG1A occasions, [ ] can be found in the northwest Israeli town of "Liman" located immediately south of "Beze" an Israeli city/town located near the Israeli/Lebanese border. See ENCLOSURE 3.

SG1A [ ] has served as an Israeli source of intelligence information. Although he is a "country man" by origin, he possesses excellent battlefield expertise and he has a keen, perceptive mind. He has had no direct, contact with the kidnappers or the hostages. His [ ] current knowledge of the hostage situation is derived from indirect sources in

SG1A Lebanon. It appeared as if [ ] was more knowledgeable than he professes to be. It was perceived that he could be used to advantage at a later date as negotiations for the release of the hostage have developed further. Noted that [ ] current superior, described as a somewhat older gentleman, will be amenable to exploitation at a future date. [ ] current or former military affiliation could not be determined.
