A middle-aged man originally from either the US or from Europe will be abducted and "tethered" by "communist radicals." He will be kept as a political prisoner on the outskirts of Barcelona, Spain but will be released between 19 and 22 June 1992. He will be moved to location west of Barcelona. Somehow "howitzers" are involved in this scenario. The countries of South Lebanon and Italy are associated with this scenario but this association was not further described. The names "Stalwart" and "Holster" phonetically surfaced as being pertinent to this problem, however they were not further identified or described.
