E. SESSION SUMMARY:

The target is currently in the vicinity of Jericho. He is currently in a structure/compound with a fountain or artesian well. There is a microwave dish nearby; it's most prominent attribute is that it is pointing straight up. There is a narrow foot path which is used to climb upwards along a steep stone/rock or canyon wall. There is a ladder which leads from a passage way or access tunnel up a square well or tower to a level, open area.

There is a small group of individuals who are desperate and expensive to hire. They have been following the target for 5 or 6 days. The impression is that they are from within the target's main group.

There is an association between some stone ruins and a birthday-like celebration of some female relative of the target, i.e. daughter, niece or sister, that the target will attend. The target will be present at this celebration when an attempt will be made by those individuals previously mentioned above. The individuals will be in place and waiting. They will be extremely careful to only hit the target and none of his family.

The target also has plans to be involved with a gathering of people at a place reminiscent of the ruins in Petra, Jordan. There are plans for a much larger operation to occur there as well.

AGREEMENT HIGHLIGHTS	WHAT'S UNSETTLED
<p>▶ SELF-RULE: Five-year period of limited self-rule for Palestinians in the occupied territories, beginning in Gaza Strip and Jericho. Before the third year begins, both sides are to start negotiating a permanent accord, leading to Palestinian autonomy.</p> <p>▶ ISRAELI TROOP WITHDRAWAL: Within four months, Israeli forces will withdraw from Palestinian areas of Gaza Strip, Jericho.</p> <p>▶ PALESTINIAN ELECTIONS: Within nine months, Palestinians will elect a municipal council to oversee administrative affairs.</p> <p>▶ SECURITY: Palestinian police force will protect internal security. Israeli troops will control external borders, protect Jewish settlers.</p> <p>▶ DISPUTES: Joint committee will settle disputes between Israel, Palestinians.</p> <p>▶ ECONOMIC AID: Joint Israeli-Palestinian Economic Cooperation Committee will oversee development in Gaza Strip, West Bank.</p>	<p>▶ PALESTINIAN POLICE FORCE: Its responsibilities, relationship to Israeli forces must be defined.</p> <p>▶ ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL: Extent of troop withdrawal and spheres of control between Israel, Palestinians are uncertain.</p> <p>▶ ISRAELI SETTLEMENTS: Unclear how Israel will protect settlers, especially when they are outside the settlements.</p>

ISRAEL, ITS NEIGHBORS
 Issues to be settled:
Lebanon: Wants Israel to withdraw from "security zone." Israel says zone protects it from terrorists.
Syria: Wants return of Golan Heights; Israel says not until trade, diplomatic relations established.
Jordan: Both nations want to finalize tentative accord setting their borders.
