SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

USMC LTC William (Rich) Higgins will be released from captivity on 4 August 1988 at 1900 hours mainly as a result of the efforts negotiated by the US State Department representative (Undersecretary of State?) and Lebanese representative. In accordance with terms of the negotiations, and because LTC Higgins is first and foremost a member assigned to a United Nations Unit (UN) he will be transported by ship to Tunisia and Egypt. This is a negotiated and accepted condition governing the release of LTC Higgins.

As an added item to this summary, the CI team should be advised that the old regime (in Lebanon) will not/repeat/not remain in power as a result of the elections in Lebanon. A conservative element that will favor closer and more sympathetic relations with Syria will come into power.

As a last item to this summary it should be noted that mutual visits between the US and the USSR notwithstanding, the implementation of the INF treaty is a "sham".
