SUMMARY - 079

LTC Higgins will be released from captivity as a hostage in the near future. He is being held in a small space (room) associated with a religious temple. The presence of a black metal fence, a small cramped area, and nearby road and torches burning in the temple are associated with the target site. Three captors are normally assigned to guard LTC Higgins. He will be released upon receipt of instructions from an Iranian-based terrorist group as opposed to instructions received from the head of the "local" group who took him captive. The captors/guards appear desirous that a determination be made in his (LTC Higgins) case. Some time following his release from captivity, LTC Higgins will lecture on the details of his captivity; eventually, he will be used/employed as an instructor at the university level.
