1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: Determine the present location of LTCX Higgins.

2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Determine the present location of LTC Higgins.

3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: No inclemencies noted. Viewer 003 places the location of Higgins north and five miles west off the coast of TYRE. Viewer 003 believed his efforts were a complete failure. (As did the other viewers who ended up with a location on the water.) A Second attempt to dowse a map of Beirut produced no results; 003's discouragement was more pronounced at his apparent, second, failure. Viewer 099 acted as monitor.

Session consisted of sketch of site described in previous solo session (17my88.sol), consisting of person sitting in upper room of structure in crowded urban area. No indication present whether this individual was or was not the subject of the search (Higgins). Search was then conducted using acetate overlay keyed to LB map by monitor, which produced a possible location somewhat north and west of Tyre (later assessed to be 3507E 3321N). Second search of overlay keyed to Beirut map produced no response.
